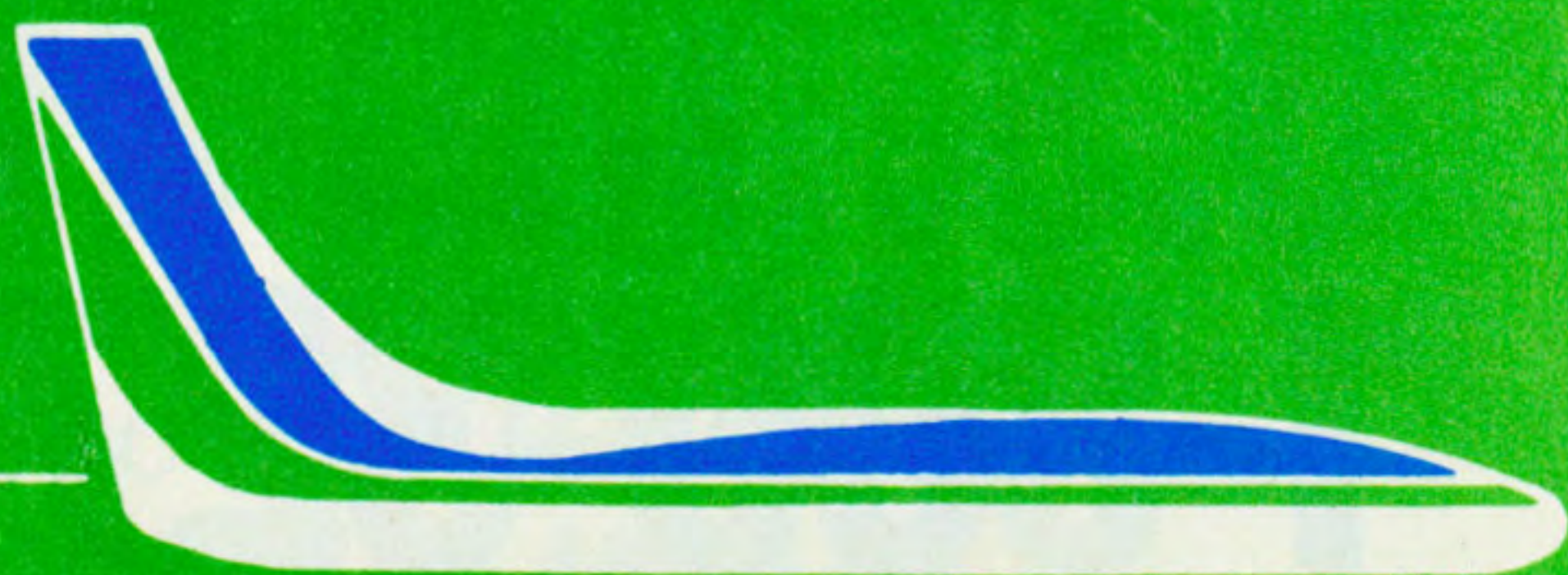

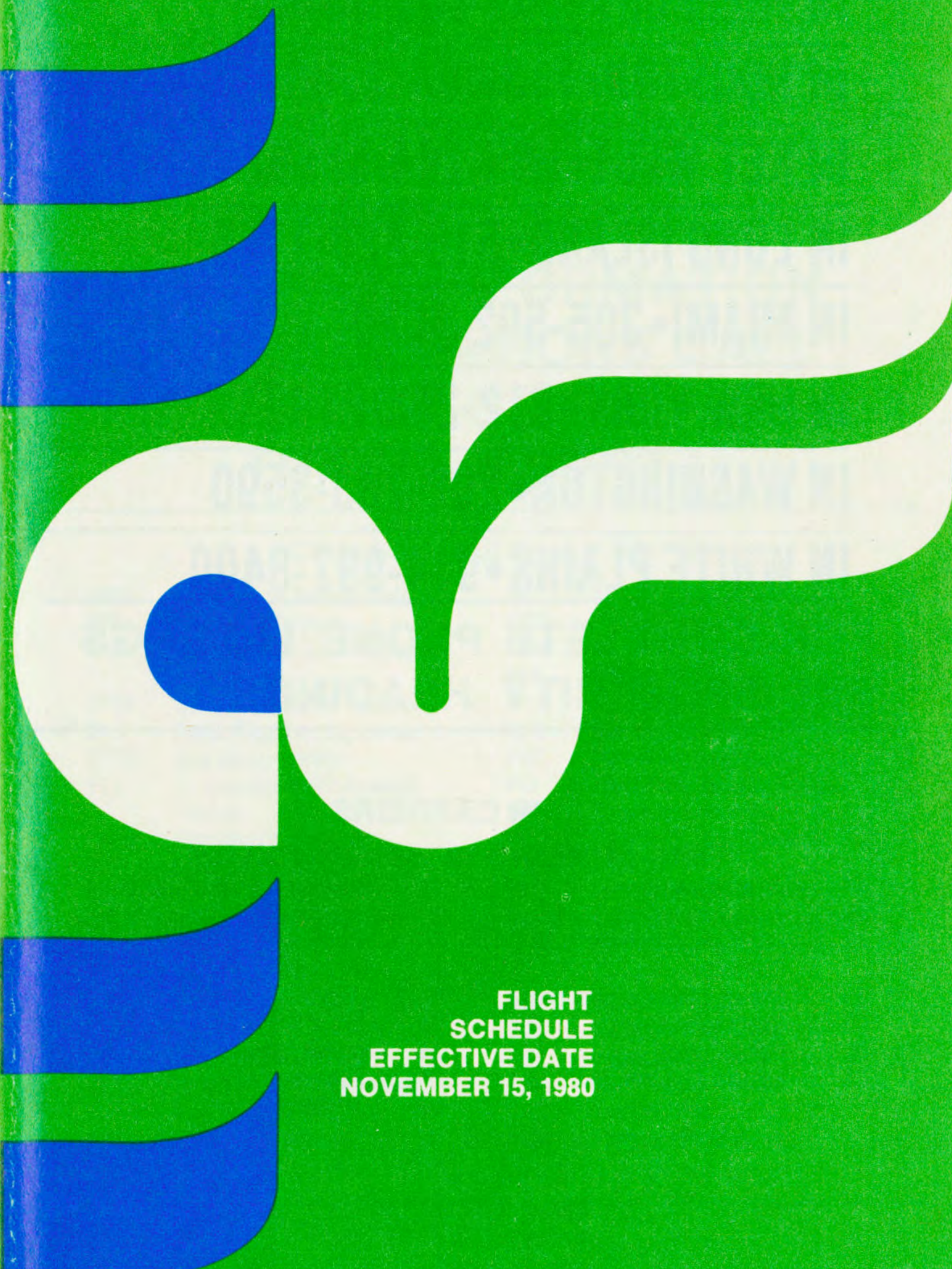

GENERAL INFORMATION

RECONFIRMATION

International—Passengers holding continuing or return reservations must confirm their reservations at least *72 hours before scheduled departure time whenever a stopover or break in travel of *72 hours or more occurs. *48 hours in the Bahamas.

SMOKING AREAS

All Air Florida aircraft have no-smoking areas for passengers who do not wish to smoke. When checking in, please advise your preference.

PASSPORTS AND VISAS

Most countries require a passport or proof of citizenship and visas to travel across their borders. While we have available the latest information, we urge you to contact the nearest consulate of the country you wish to visit to obtain official advice.

BAGGAGE INFORMATION

Domestic—Each passenger is permitted one piece of carry-on baggage as long as it fits beneath the seat. Two other bags may be checked but must not exceed 62 and 55 dimensional inches respectively in over-all length, height, and width. The maximum weight per piece cannot exceed 70 pounds.

International—excluding Europe

Free Baggage Allowance

Checked-in—2 pieces.
Carry-on—1 piece (must fit under seat).
Weight limit—70 lbs. total for the above three pieces.

Excess Baggage

4th thru 7th piece—\$10.00 per piece; \$7.00 per piece for Bahamas.
8th piece and thereafter—\$24.00 per piece.

Europe

Free Baggage Allowance

Checked-in—2 pieces; maximum weight 70 lbs. per piece, maximum dimensions 62 inches in outside linear dimensions. (sum of height, width and depth).
Carry-on—1 or more pieces provided that combined they do not exceed 45 inches in outside linear dimensions. Must fit under seat.
No free baggage allowance for infants.

Excess Baggage

\$43.00 per piece; maximum weight 70 lbs. per piece.

Limits of Liability—Excess valuation may not be declared on certain types of valuable articles. Carriers assume no liability for fragile or perishable articles. Further information may be obtained from the carrier. Liability for loss, delay or damage to baggage is limited as follows unless a higher value is declared in advance and additional charges are paid:

- For most international travel (including the domestic portions of international journeys) to approximately \$9.07 per pound (\$20.00 per kilo) for checked baggage and \$400.00 per passenger for unchecked baggage.
- For travel wholly between U.S. points, to \$750.00 per passenger.

CHECK-IN POLICY

Customers are required to present their tickets at the Air Florida departure gate at least 10 minutes on domestic flights and 45 minutes on international flights prior to scheduled departure time, otherwise reservations may be cancelled.

SECURITY NOTICE

U.S. Government security regulations require the search of all passengers and articles carried on board aircraft. Please limit carry-on articles to only those items necessary for your inflight needs and allow sufficient time prior to departure to comply with these regulations.

DISCLOSURE NOTICE— DELIBERATE OVERBOOKING

No-Shows are an industry wide problem. Invariably a number of passengers who hold confirmed reservations become "no-shows" at flight departure time. This number can be quite accurately predicted based on historical data. To avoid this wasteful practice and to enable thousands of additional passengers to fly each year, airline flights may be overbooked. There is a slight chance that a seat will not be available on a flight for which a person has a confirmed reservation. A person denied boarding for this reason may be entitled to compensation. Liability rules are available at all airport counters.
