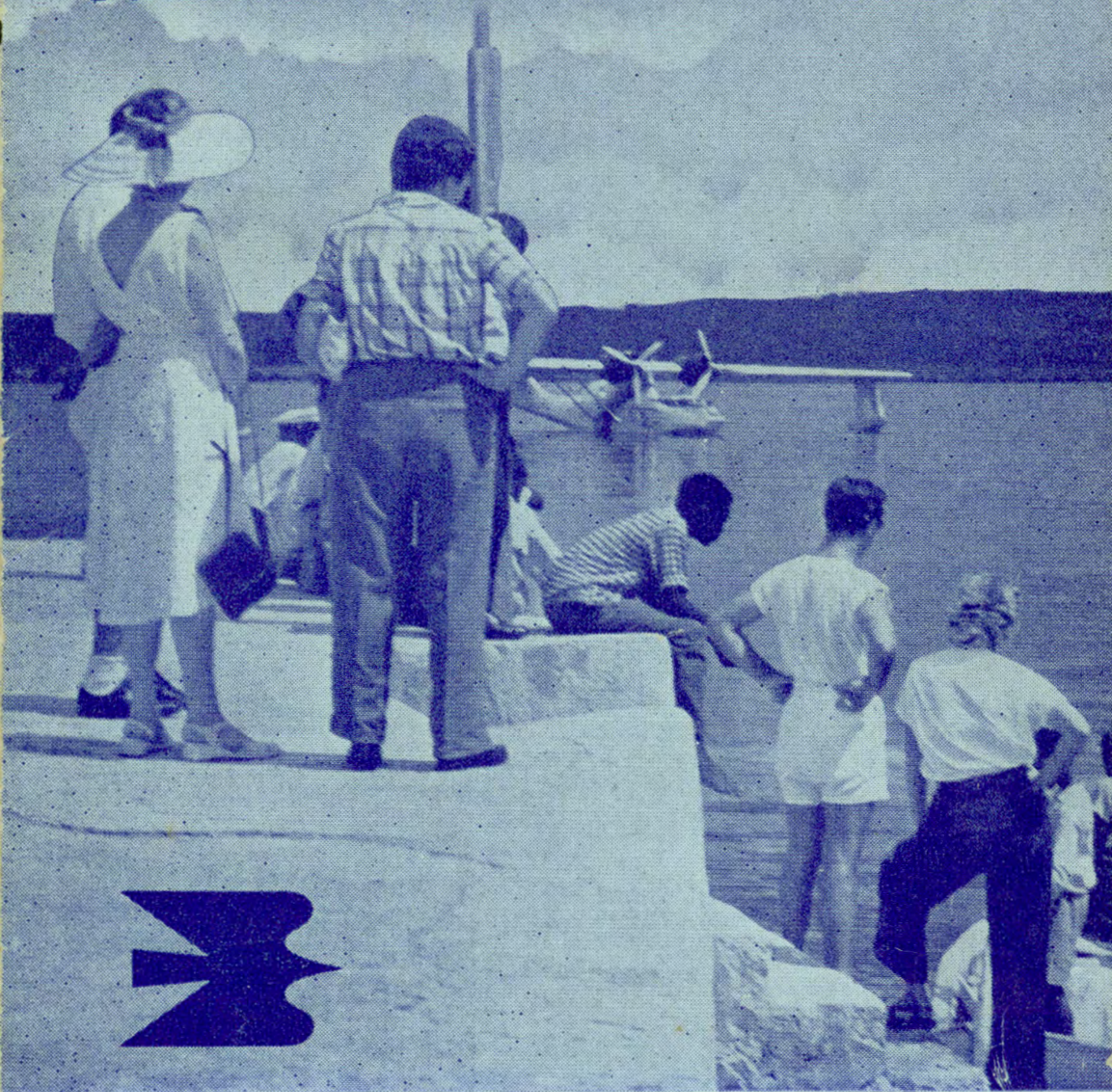

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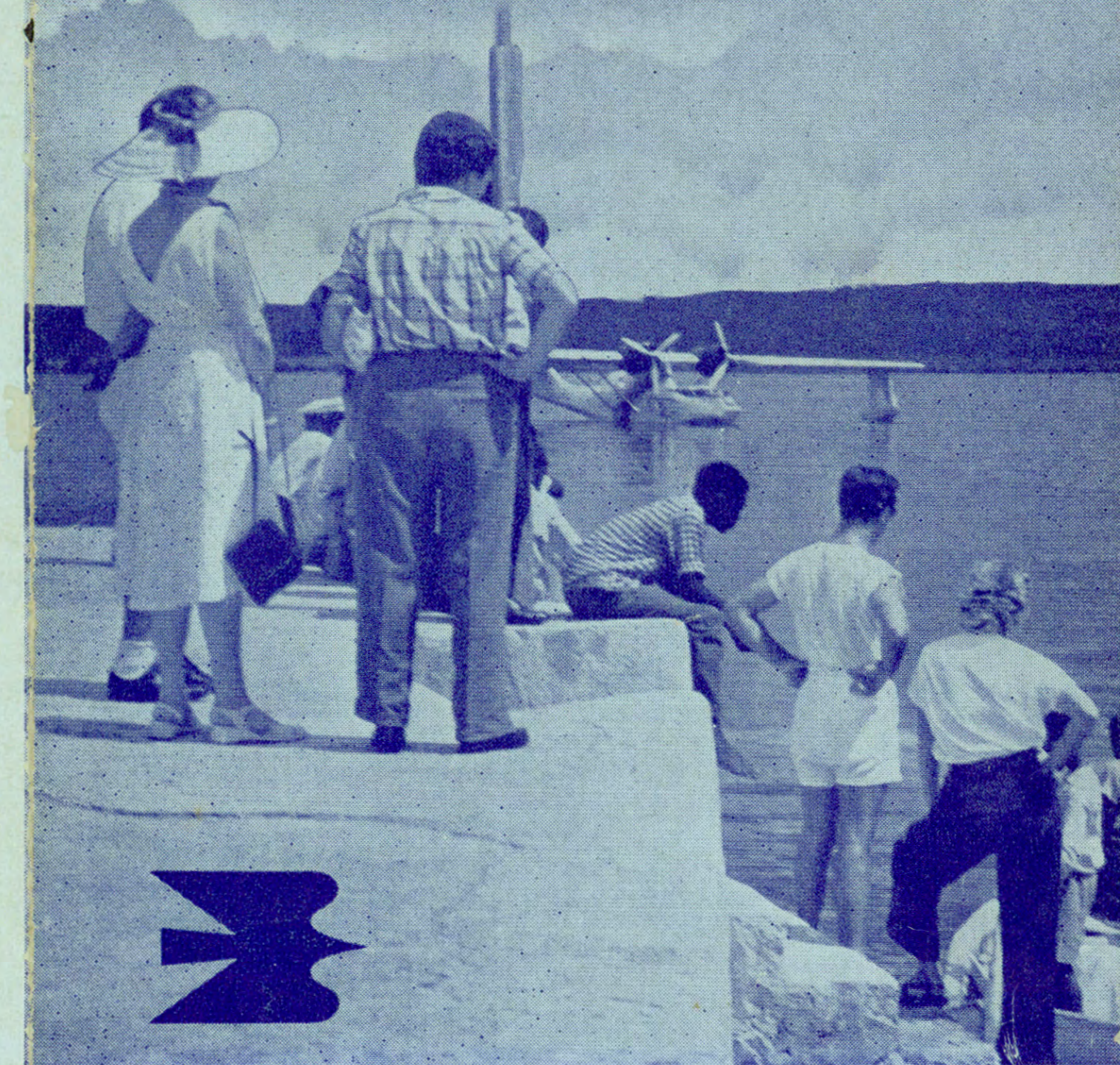
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Beachcombing in GOVERNOR'S HARBOUR



"Freedom" is the catchword in this carefree Eleutheran beauty spot. First settled in 1648 by a group from London who called themselves the Eleutheran Adventurers, they named the island after themselves and the Greek word "Eleutheros" meaning "free," and established at Governor's Harbour the capital of what is believed to be the first Republic of the New World. Later, schooners from New England and Baltimore clippers from Chesapeake Bay, loading and unloading cargoes, anchored in the bay on the west coast where your amphibian will land. Once ashore you will be driven — or you may walk — across the Island to French Leave, a modern guest house with an excellent cuisine, situated on a mile long beach, where you will enjoy your freedom to bathe and beachcomb at your leisure. Or you may lunch at the Buccaneer Club recently opened by the author Hellweg-Larsen.

Beachcombing in ROCK SOUND

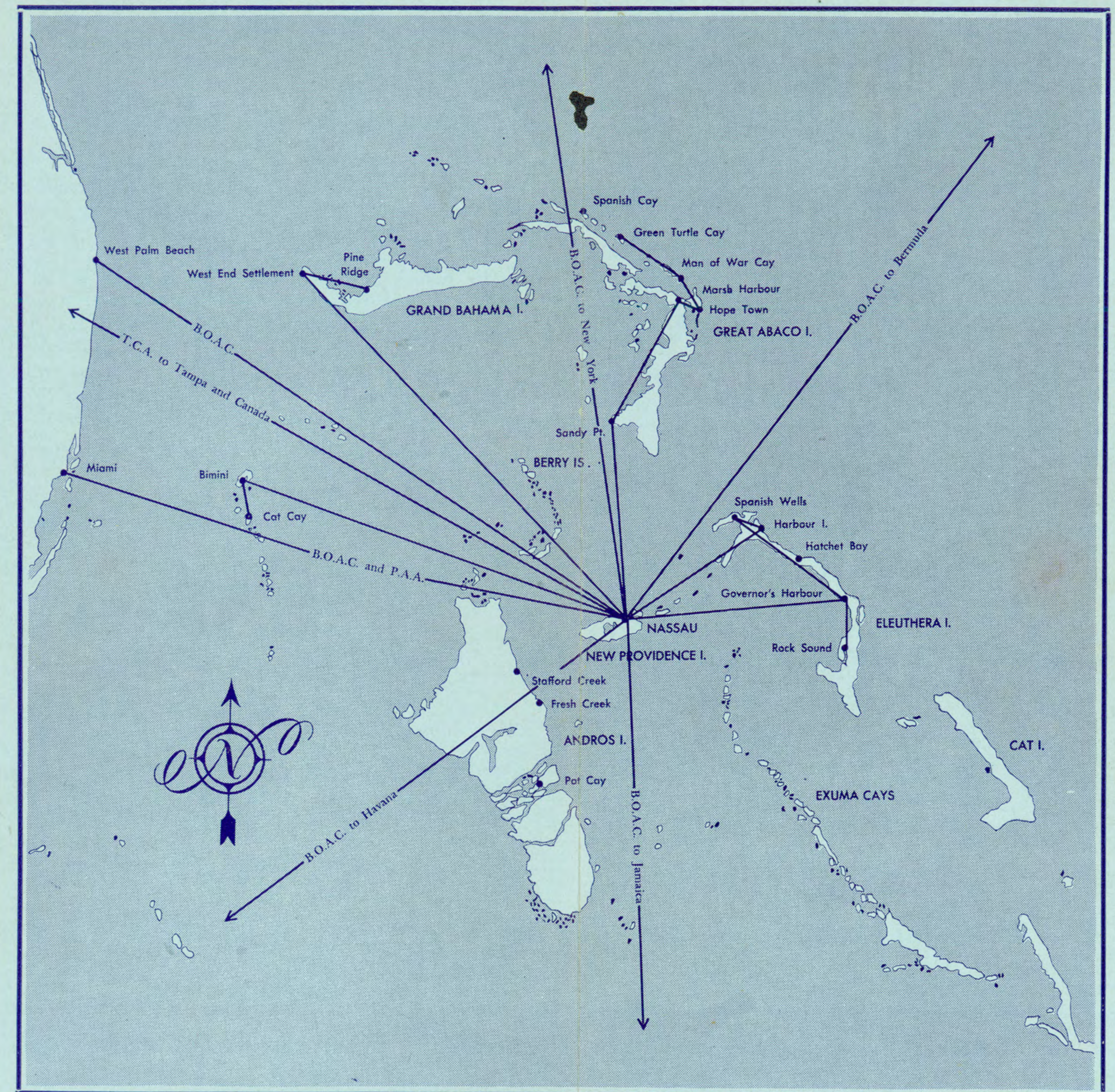
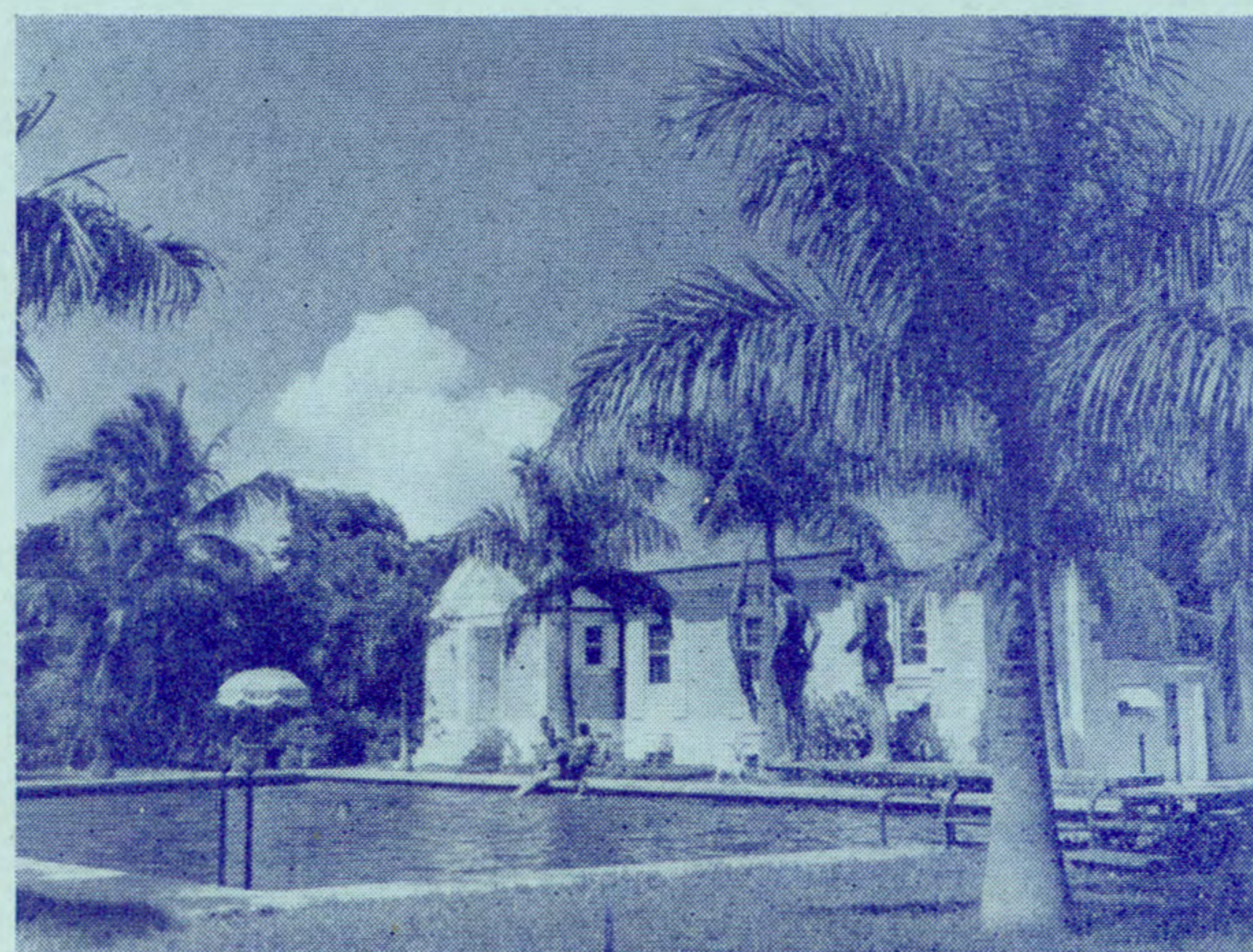
"Wreck Sound" as it was previously known, is said to have obtained its name in the days of the pirates, because of the nefarious occupation of its one-time inhabitants of wrecking vessels. Today, Rock Sound presents a very different picture with its peace-loving and law-abiding citizens. Here you will land on the only airstrip in Eleuthera, the property of the Rock Sound Farm which was purchased in 1950 by the British Government's Colonial Development Corporation from the American aluminum millionaire, Mr. A. V. Davis. In the heart of the farm area is the Rock Sound Club, where you will lunch. You can bathe in the Club pool, or on any of the three adjacent beaches, or you may play tennis on the club courts, beachcombing in a modern setting.

Beachcombing in HARBOUR ISLAND

This enchanting spot, off the northern shore of Eleuthera, has one of the most picturesque settlements in the Outer Islands. Dunmore Town is named after Lord Dunmore, Governor of the Bahamas from 1786 to 1797, previously the last Royal Governor of the States of New York and Virginia. Your amphibian will land in one of the finest harbours in the Bahamas, on the west side of the Island, and once ashore, it is but a short walk to the glorious mile long "pink" sands beach, after which is named the Pink Sands Lodge where you will have lunch. When not eating you can bathe on the almost deserted beach, you can wander through the town, or you can hire a boat and go fishing. But do not become so enchanted that you miss your flight home to Nassau into the setting sun.
