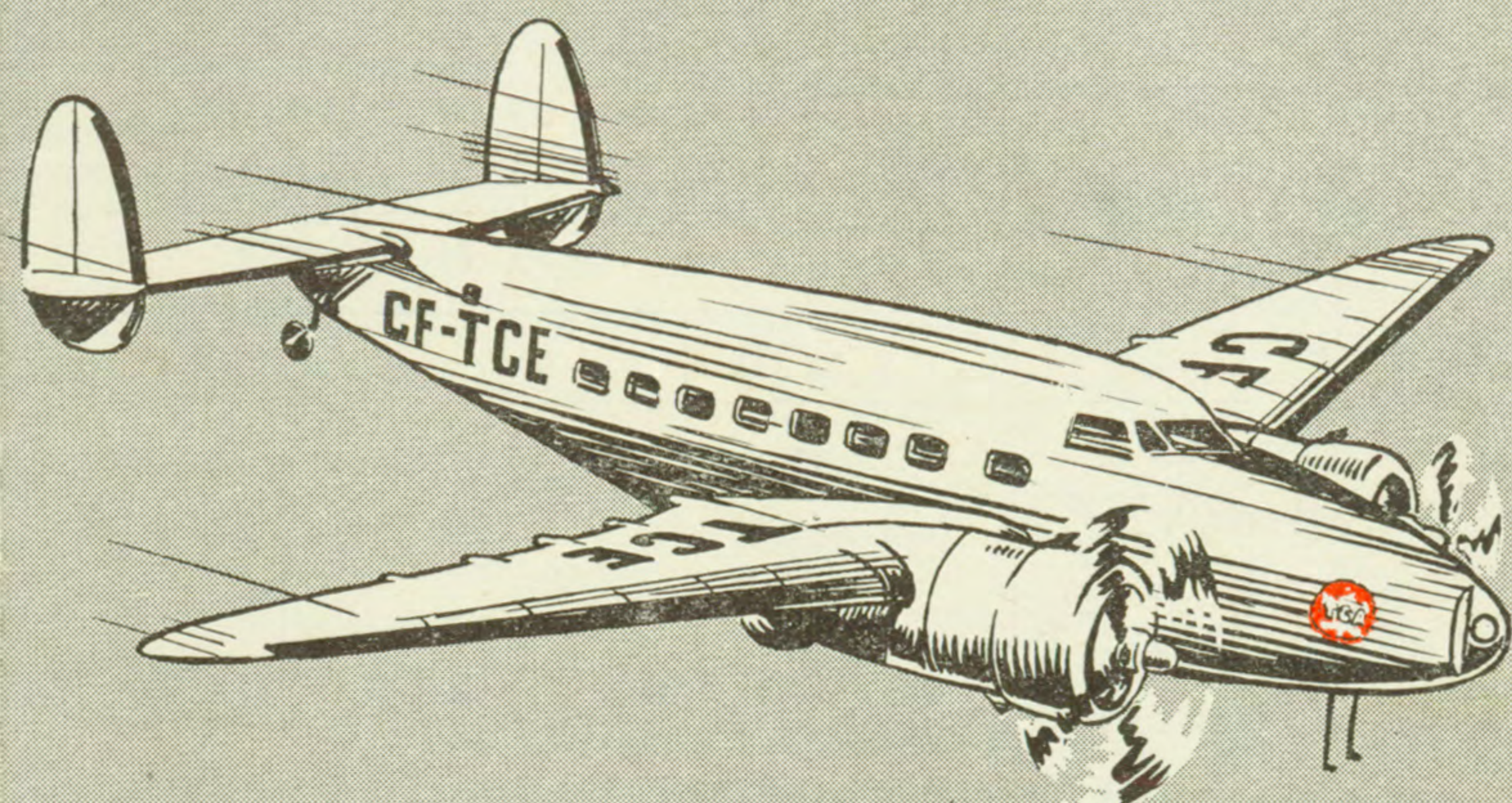

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TRANS-CANADA AIR LINES — GENERAL INFORMATION

TIMETABLES — The schedules are subject to change without notice to the public. Trans-Canada Air Lines reserve the right to delay departures and postpone or cancel flights. Arrival time and connections with other transportation services cannot be guaranteed.

TIME — Time listed for schedule is Standard Time in the district concerned.

FARES — Fares, rates and charges shown in this folder are not guaranteed to be in effect at the present time, and are furnished as a matter of information only. All fares, rates and charges quoted are subject to change without notice.

Tariffs quoting fares, baggage charges and general rules and regulations, to destinations in Canada, the United States and abroad, are maintained at all Traffic Offices of Trans-Canada Air Lines. These tariffs are open to public inspection at all times, and passengers desiring correct information as to fares, rates and charges, etc., are requested to consult the nearest Traffic Office of Trans-Canada Air Lines.

Children — Children under two years of age will be transported free only if carried in arms of parent or guardian. Children two years and under twelve years of age will be carried at one half the published one way or return fares over Trans-Canada Air Lines and certain associated carriers.

Round Trip Fares — A substantial saving is obtained by the purchase of a round trip ticket before commencement of original trip. Return tickets are good for ninety (90) days from date of going trip, and may be extended without charge for a further thirty (30) days upon application at a Trans-Canada Air Lines office. Tickets are non-transferable.

Stopovers and Limits — Stopover is permitted on both one way and return tickets within the limit of the ticket. Reservations must be arranged accordingly. Consult Company Agent for further details. One way, round trip and circle tickets are good for ninety (90) days from date of commencement of trip, and may be extended without charge for a further thirty (30) days upon application at a Trans-Canada Air Lines' office.

Cancellation — By the Company — The Company reserves the right, at its sole discretion, to cancel bookings before passage or enroute whenever it deems such action advisable or necessary; in all such cases the passenger's sole recourse shall be the recovery of the value of the unused portion of the fare paid.

By the passenger — The Company will make prompt refund of fare paid on surrender of any unused ticket issued by the Company, conditional that the passenger has notified Company's reservation office to cancel all reservations at least three hours prior to schedule departure of the initial journey. Refunds of tickets that concern reservations on lines of associate or connecting Air Line carriers, or refunds on partly used tickets, will be made only upon the condition that passenger has complied with the respective Companies' regulations, and only in accordance with such regulations.

Refunds — Application for refund should be made to the issuing Agent or at any Traffic Office of Trans-Canada Air Lines.

Lost Tickets — Should be reported immediately to the nearest Trans-Canada Air Lines' office.

RESERVATIONS — Reservation must be made and accepted in advance. Seat space is reserved, although no specific seat assignment is made. Ticket must be purchased, or endorsed when reservation is confirmed.

BAGGAGE — The term baggage means personal belongings necessary and appropriate for the comfort and convenience of the passenger for the purposes of the journey and not intended for other persons or for sale, and may include brief cases, portfolios, packages, parcels, typewriters, camera equipment and accessories, and similar articles. (Individual books, magazines, binoculars, pocket size cameras and coats, will not be considered as baggage when carried by passenger in the cabin). The carrying of inflammable, explosive or dangerous articles of any nature whatsoever, in either checked or hand baggage, is a violation of the law. Forty (40) pounds of baggage will be carried free on any ticket. Maximum dimensions for any single piece of baggage acceptable are 15" x 20" x 36".

Baggage in excess of the free forty (40) pound limit may be carried at the carrier's option, when space is available, at ½ of 1% of the published one way fare per pound. The carriage of excess baggage on any specific flight is anticipated but cannot be guaranteed.

On tickets of Trans-Oceanic passengers, fifty-five (55) pounds of baggage will be carried free by airplane, or forty (40) pounds will be carried by airplane free and one hundred (100) pounds additional transported at the expense of the Company and forwarded by railway express service.

The liability of the Carrier for loss of, or damage to, baggage and/or personal property is limited to the amount of One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) unless a higher valuation is declared and insurance paid therefor. Excess valuation is limited to Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) on each full fare ticket.

Animals — Animals, birds and reptiles will not be carried.

TRANSPORTATION TO AND FROM AIRPORTS — Taxi-cab service charges between Airports and urban centres are independent of Air Line fares, and therefore, at passenger's option. Taxi service and fares between certain designated downtown points and airports have been arranged and passengers may make arrangements for this service through Company offices when booking Air Line reservation, or through stewardess enroute.

HOTELS — Traffic Offices of Trans-Canada Air Lines will be pleased to assist passengers in arranging any hotel reservations required.

INSURANCE — Consult the Company's Agent for Air Travel Insurance.

LOST ARTICLES — Enquiries about articles left in the aircraft should be addressed to Lost and Found Department, Trans-Canada Air Lines, Operations, Winnipeg, Man., and for articles lost at airports, direct enquiry to respective Airport Manager.

FOUNTAIN PENS — The change in atmospheric pressure at certain altitudes may cause some types of fountain pens to leak. It is advisable to wrap the pen in cloth to avoid damage to clothes or contents of baggage or hand bags.

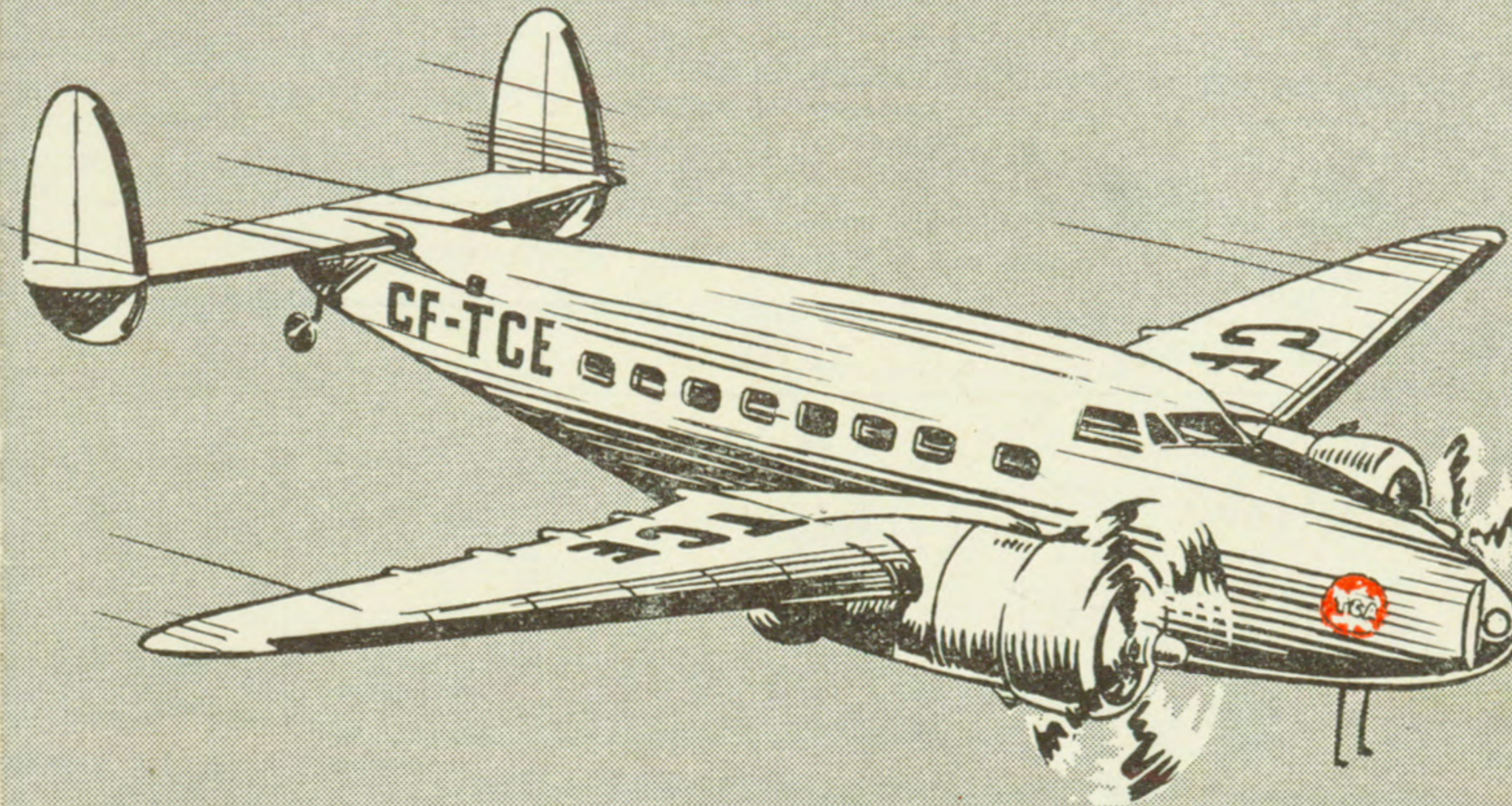


