# PASSENGER INFORMATION

**GENERAL** — Fares, schedules and all other information published herein are subject to tariff regulations and change without notice. Current tariffs are maintained in all ticket offices of the Company and are available for public inspection. **TIMES SHOWN IN TIMETABLES AND ELSEWHERE ARE APPROXIMATE AND NOT GUARANTEED, AND FORM NO PART OF THE CONTRACT OF CARRIAGE.** Fares are for transportation only between airports named on the ticket.

**VALIDITY OF TICKETS** — Except as otherwise provided in carrier's tariffs, tickets are valid for a period of one year from date of issue.

**STOPOVERS** — Stopovers within limits of the ticket are permitted at any point of call provided that the passenger complies with regulations for reservation or release of space.

**CHILDREN** — One child, under two years of age and not occupying a seat, will be carried free with each accompanying passenger twelve years of age or over, provided that, at its own absolute discretion, carrier may restrict the number of such infants to be carried on any flight. Children under two years of age, for whom seats are reserved, and children two years of age and under twelve years of age, accompanied or unaccompanied, will be charged one half the applicable adult fare.

**BAGGAGE** — Except as otherwise provided in carrier's tariffs, the free baggage allowance on any full fare or half fare is forty-four (44) pounds. Baggage in excess of the free baggage allowance is charged for at the rate on 1/2 of 1% of the normal, adult, one way fare per pound subject to a minimum charge of twenty-five cents (25c).

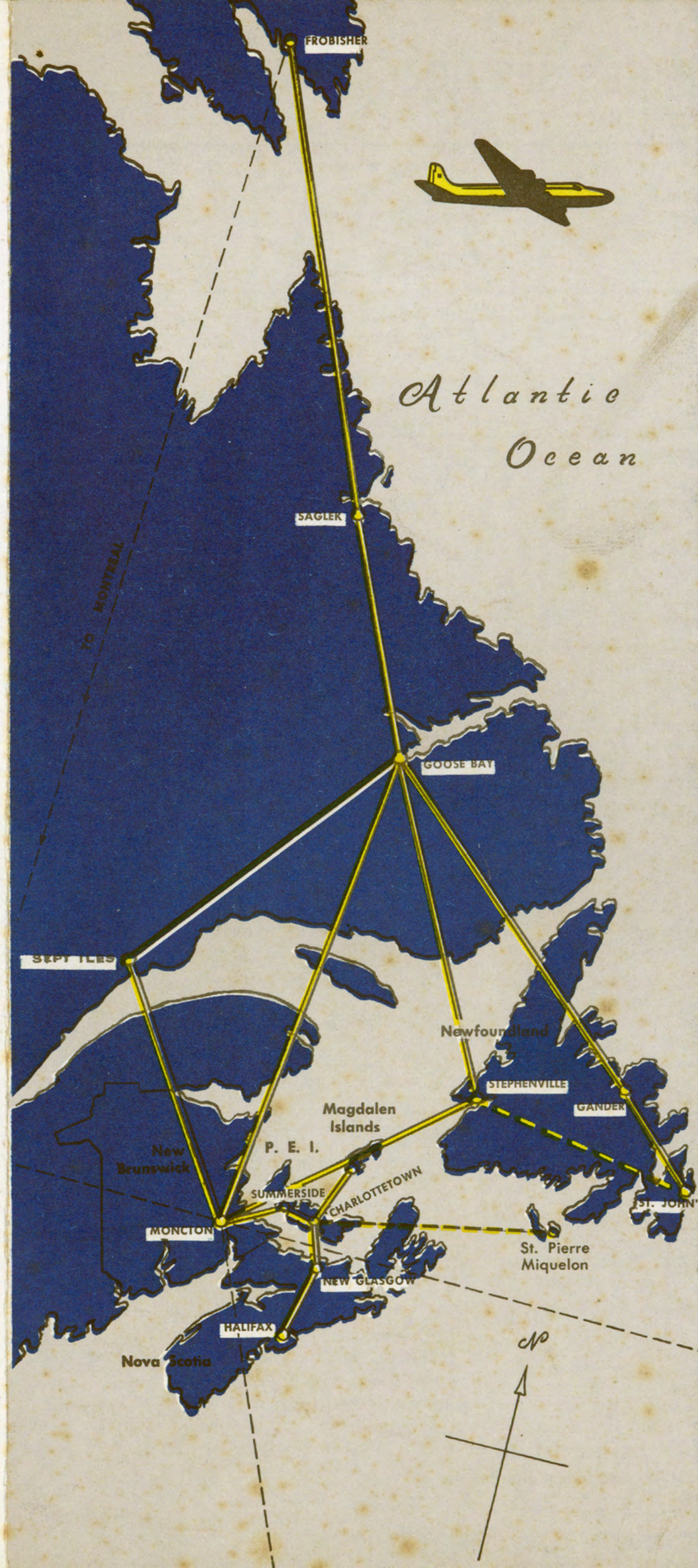
**LIABILITY** — Carrier assumes no liability other than that specified in its tariffs, published and filed pursuant to law.

**CANCELLATION OF PASSAGE** (by the Passenger) — If your travel plans change and you will not be able to use your reservation, please cancel your space immediately so that someone else may be accommodated.
