

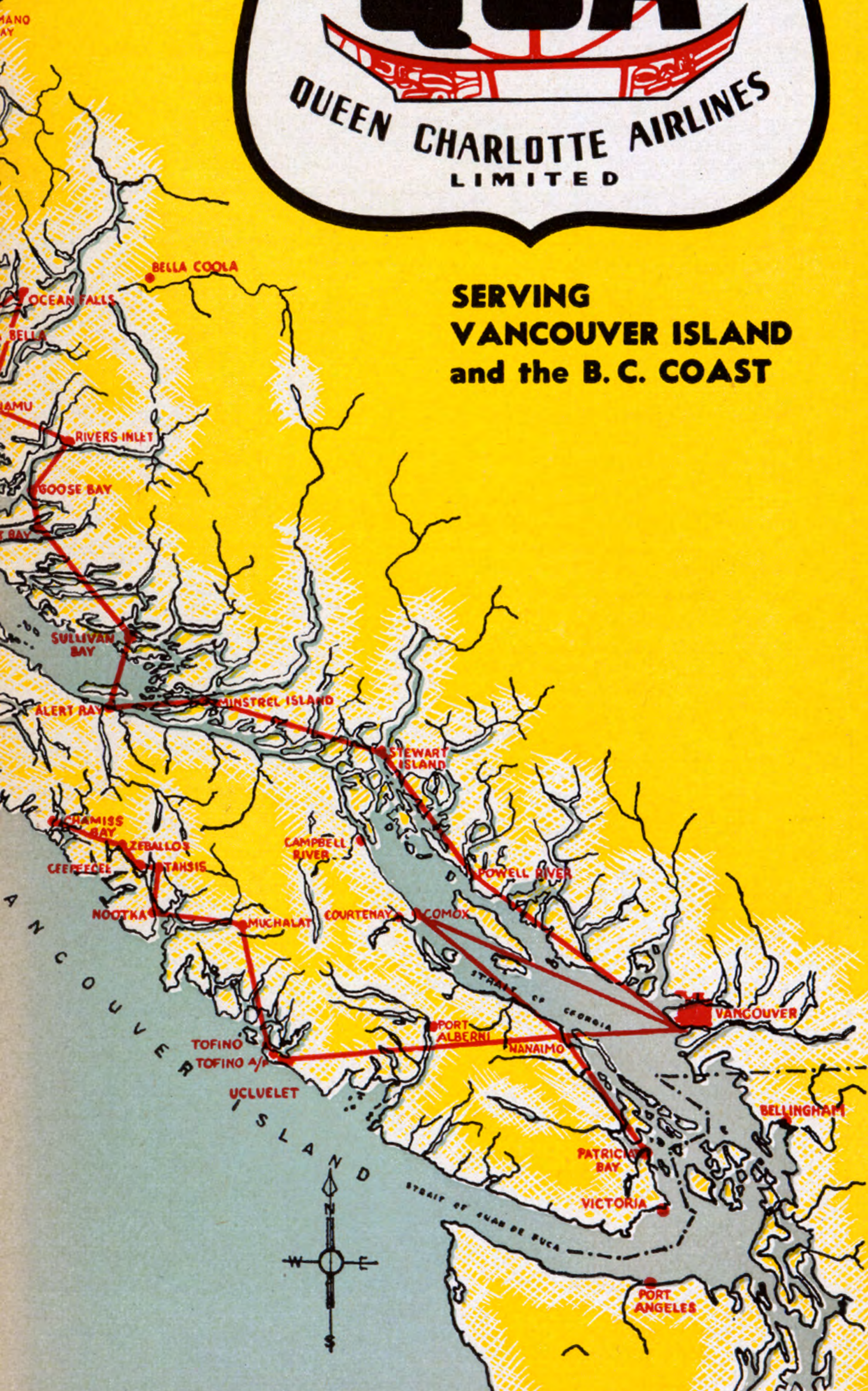

GENERAL INFORMATION

- BAGGAGE** Baggage will be carried on any full fare or half fare ticket up to a maximum of 40 pounds. Baggage or other personal property in excess of 40 pounds will be charged for at current tariff rates. Excess baggage will be accepted subject to aircraft weight and space limitations.
- LIABILITY** Liability of the carrier for loss of, or damage to, or any delay in the delivery of personal property, including baggage, is limited to the amount of \$50.00 per ticket.
- FARES** Fares and other information published herein are subject to Tariff regulations and change without notice. Current tariffs are maintained in all ticket offices of the Company, and are open to public inspection.
- CHILDREN** Children under two years of age for whom seats are reserved and children two years of age and under twelve years of age, will be charged one-half of the full normal adult fare. ONE child under two years of age and not occupying a seat, will be carried free with each adult fare.
- LIMITS AND STOPOVERS** Tickets are valid for a period of one month from date of issue. Tickets are non-transferable. Stopovers are permitted at any point en route within the limit of the ticket in accordance with Company Tariffs.
- LIQUOR** Any passenger considered to be under the influence of liquor will be refused passage, and any passenger considered to be so effected en route will be deplaned.
- GROUND TRANSPORTATION** Limousine services are not operated by Q.C.A., and are therefore at passengers' option.
- RESERVATIONS** Must be made in advance and tickets purchased within time limits specified by the Company.

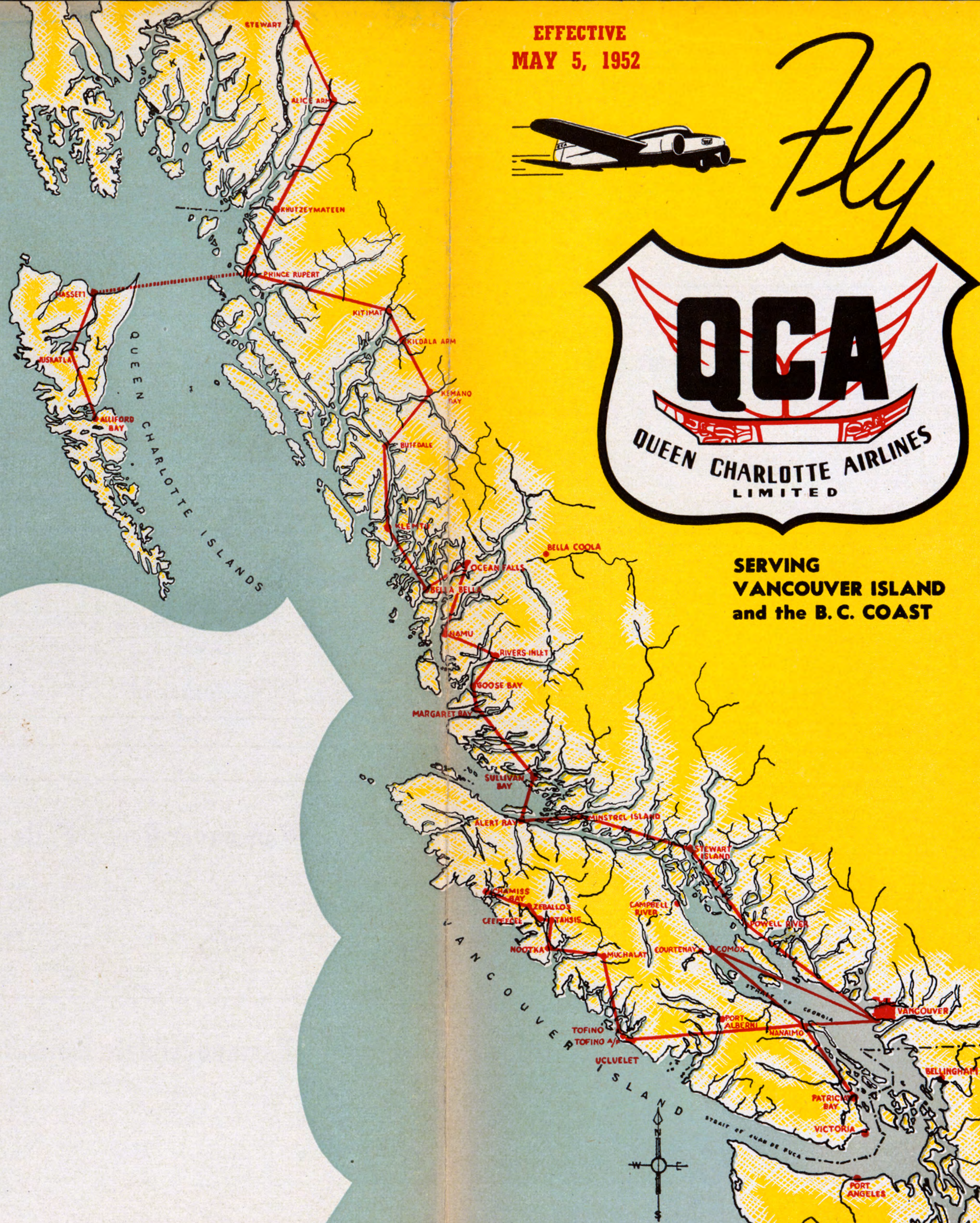
