AIRPORT SERVICE CHARGE : GREAT BRITAIN

An Airport Service Charge of 5s. per head is imposed by the Ministry of Civil Aviation, or by local authorities, on passengers embarking on international flights at airports in Great Britain. The only exceptions are children under two years of age and passengers in transit. The charge will be collected in cash at departure and passengers should have this sum available.

CONDITIONS OF CARRIAGE AND REGULATIONS

Carriage of Passengers and Baggage and of Cargo is performed in accordance with Aer Lingus General Conditions of Carriage and Regulations, which are available for inspection at all terminals and booking offices of the Company.

BAGGAGE. (a) **Free Allowance. Standard Class Services.** The free allowance for adults and children paying half fare is:

20 kilograms (44 lbs.) where the normal adult one-way fare is less than £50.

30 kilograms (66 lbs.) where the normal adult one-way fare is £50 or over.

40 kilograms (88 lbs.) for round-the-world journeys.

Tourist Class Services in Europe—The free allowance for adults and children paying half fare is:

15 kilograms (33 lbs.) where the first-class adult one-way fare is less than £50.

20 kilograms (44 lbs.) where the first-class adult one-way fare is £50 or over.

(b) **Personal Items.** In addition to the free allowance you may carry free of charge, only the following:—

a lady's handbag or pocketbook; an overcoat or wrap; a foot rug; an umbrella or walking stick; a pair of binoculars; a small camera; a reasonable amount of reading matter for the flight; infant's food for consumption en route, and infant's carrying basket.

Other articles such as brief cases, typewriters, heavy cameras, overnight bags, parcels or similar articles will be weighed and included in the total baggage weight.

(c) **Excess.** Subject to space being available, you may carry baggage in excess of the free allowance at the rates shown in this Timetable.

(d) **Prohibited Articles.** Please do not carry in your baggage, articles which ignite easily, such as cigarette lighter fluid, matches, etc.

(e) **Commercial Samples.** Baggage should contain personal effects only, but you may carry samples provided you comply with Customs regulations.

BOOKINGS. Please book your seat as far in advance as you can, and if possible, make onward and return reservations at the same time, or, at the latest, before you commence your outward journey. You are advised to confirm your onward and return reservations at each stop-over point, and when you arrive at your destination. If you must cancel, please give us as much notice as possible as there is a large demand for seats.

CHECK-IN TIMES are published in this Timetable. It is necessary for you to be at the City Air Terminal or Airport Check-in Counter not later than the time shown for the flight on which you are booked. If you arrive late you will not be allowed to travel on that flight.

CHILDREN AND INFANTS. Unaccompanied children under eight years of age will be carried only by advance special arrangement. Unaccompanied children between eight and twelve years of age must be accompanied to the airport and met on arrival by an adult.

Children's and Infants' Fares. Children two years of age and under twelve will be charged half the adult fare. One infant under two years of age accompanied by an adult will be charged 10 per cent. of the adult fare and each additional infant will be charged half the adult fare. Ages as at commencement of journey.

COACH SERVICES. Special coach services between City Terminals and Airports are normally available at the fares shown on page 9.

COMMON INTEREST GROUP TRAVEL. A reduction of ten per cent. per ticket will be granted to bona-fide groups of 15 or more adults making the same journey, who travel together in the same aircraft. This discount does not apply to student fares.

CYCLES. Special flat rates are available for accompanied pedal cycles on routes between Ireland and the United Kingdom. For details see page 6.

GARAGE FACILITIES. You can arrange to have your car stored and serviced at Dublin Airport by the Airport Management.

GOVERNMENT REQUIREMENTS FOR FOREIGN TRAVEL. Aer Lingus or its Agents will be pleased to provide you with all available information to assist you in planning your journey, but you must personally ensure that you comply with all passport, visa, health, currency, immigration or other government regulations, and Aer Lingus cannot accept responsibility if you are inconvenienced because of any irregularity in these matters. You will need your travel documents on your journey, so remember not to pack them in your baggage.

GRATUITIES. Aer Lingus Staff are not permitted to accept tips.

INSURANCE. If you require personal accident or baggage insurance, Aer Lingus will be pleased to arrange it for you.

LIVE ANIMALS. We regret that we cannot carry animals in the passenger cabin, but when special arrangements are made they may be carried in the freight holds.

PUNCTUALITY. Every effort is made to ensure the punctuality of our flights, but we cannot guarantee that departures or arrivals will be made at the exact times stated in this Timetable, or that connections with other services will be made, nor can we accept responsibility for the consequences of a delay to or cancellation of any flight. In the event of your service being cancelled, every effort will be made to accommodate you on another flight, or, if you so request, a refund of the unused value of your ticket will be made.

REFRESHMENTS. Light refreshments are served free of charge on many routes. Full meals are not served. There is an excellent restaurant at Dublin Airport and good buffet and restaurant facilities at most other Airports. Drinks, cigarettes and chocolates may be purchased on Aer Lingus flights.

REFUNDS. You should send your application for refund on an unused ticket to your travel agent or to any Aer Lingus Booking Office, not later than 30 days after the expiry date of the ticket. If you apply for refund on the return portion of a round-trip or excursion ticket, you will be refunded only the difference between the fare paid and the applicable one-way fare.

ROUND-TRIP DISCOUNT AND EXCURSION TICKETS. To secure the reduction you must purchase the round-trip or excursion ticket before you commence your journey.

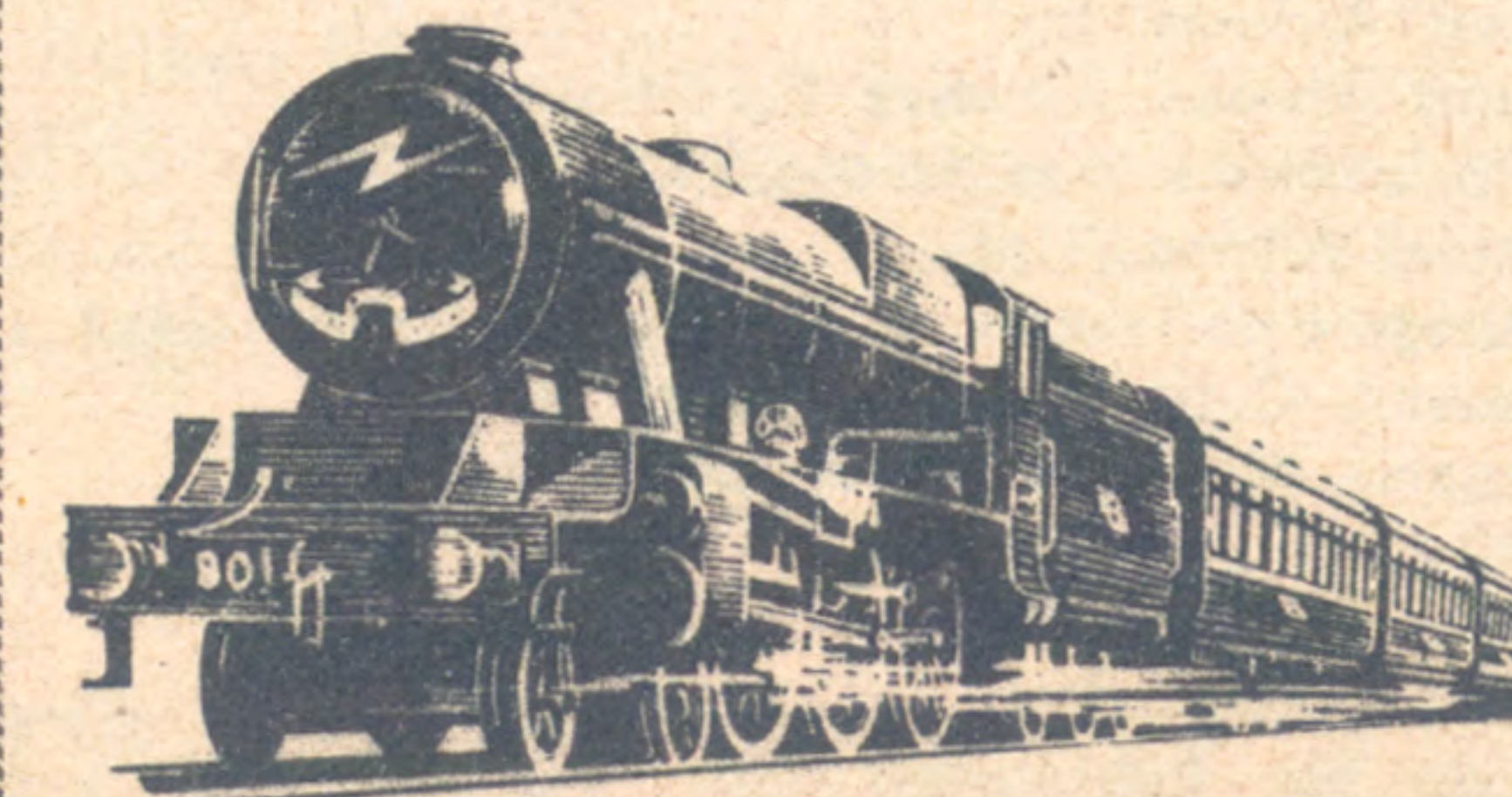
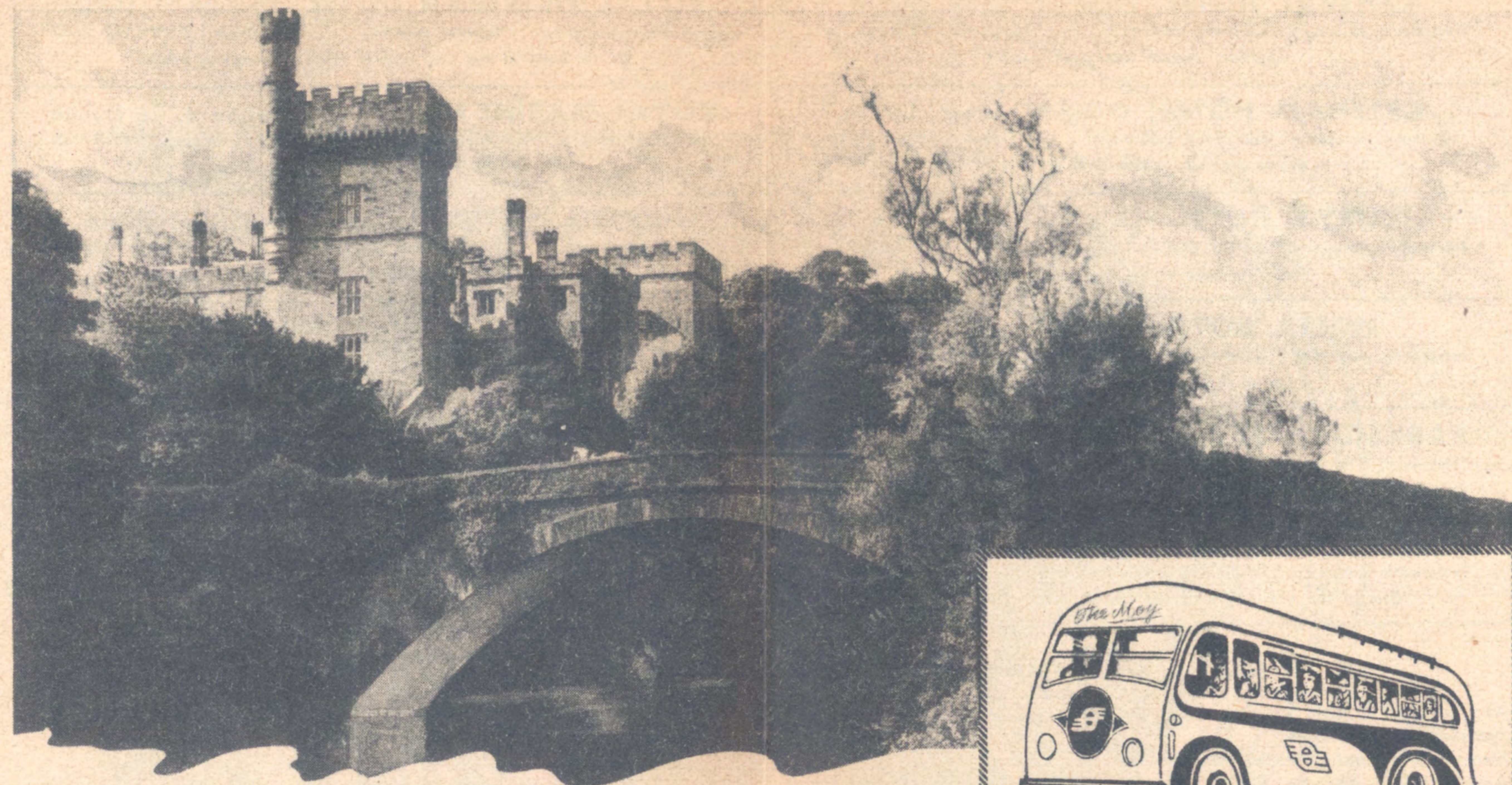
STOPOVERS. Provided you give notice at time of booking you may break your journey at scheduled stopping places en route without losing the benefit of the through fare.

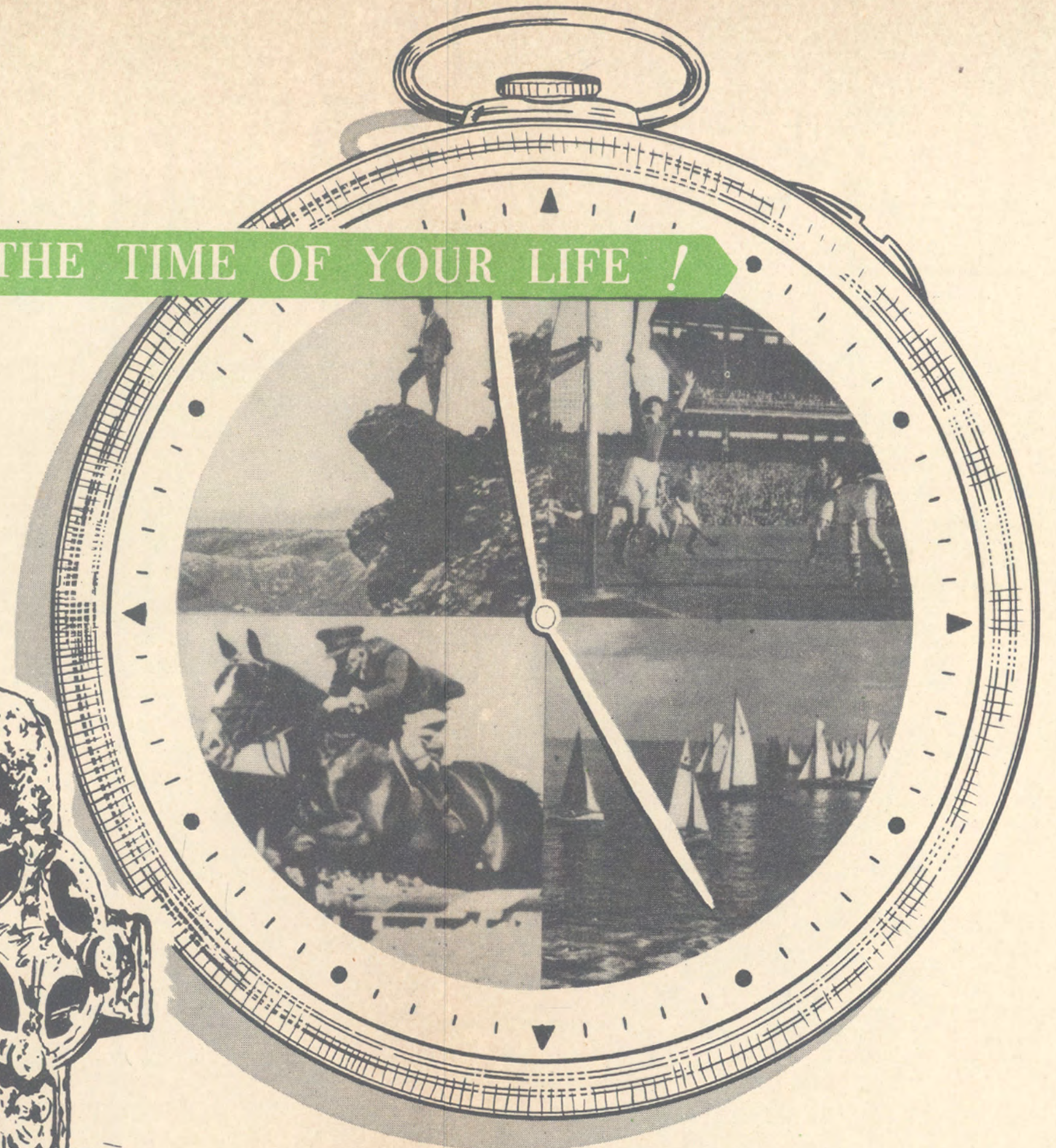
