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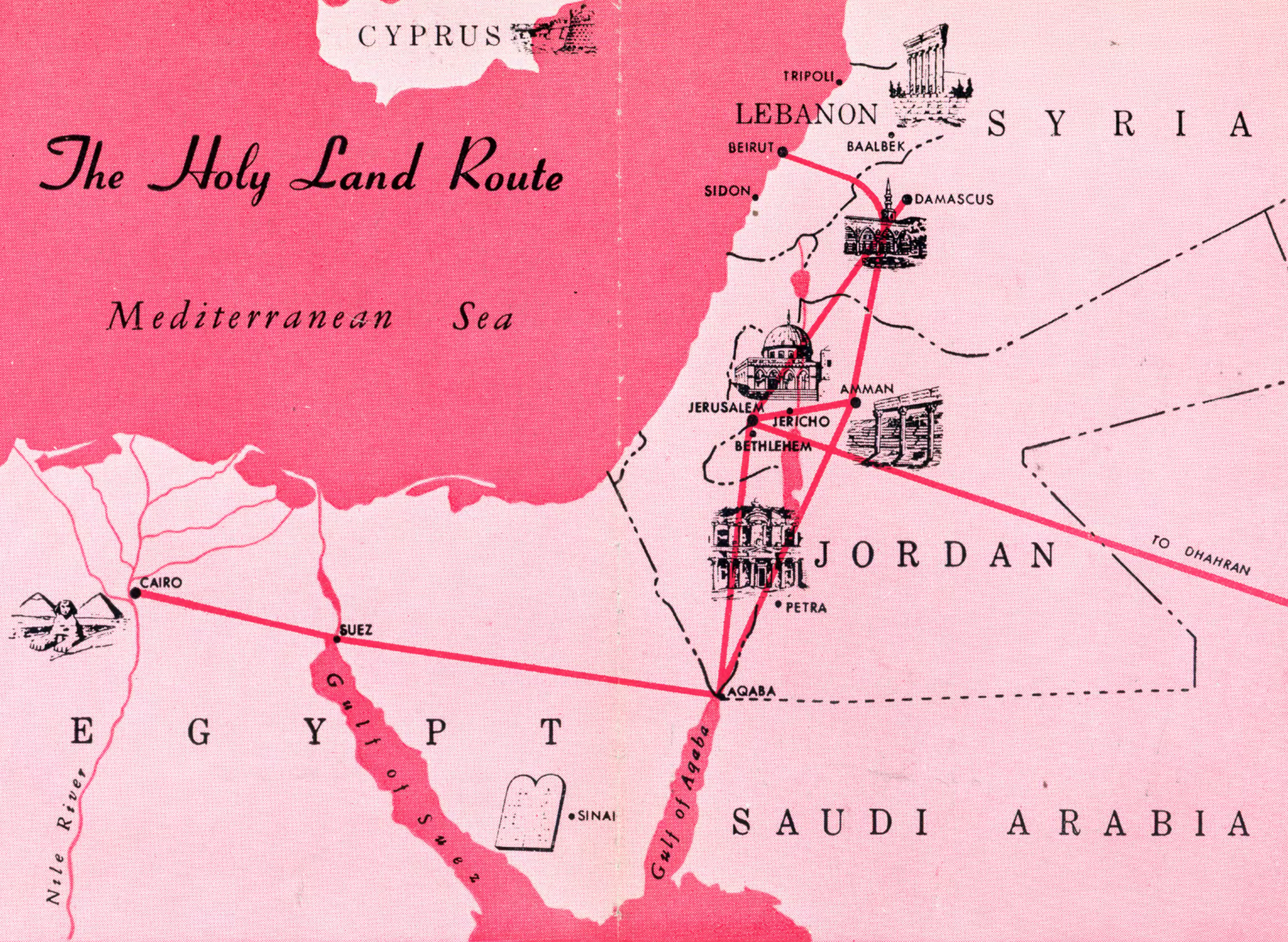

THIS IS THE HOLY LAND ROUTE

The 581 miles between Cairo and Beirut re-sounds 5000 years of history and countless millenia of pre-history. Thousands of storied battlefields and dozens of crumbled capitals of kingdoms now forsaken further dramatize some of the most spectacular topography the earth exhibits, in this, the womb of history, the eternal Holy Land.

CAIRO - SUEZ - MT. SINAI - AQABA - PETRA

Out of the fertile Nile Valley you cross desert Egypt to Suez, along an ancient camel caravan route (look for the black Bedouin tents), past Mt. Sinai, scene of Moses' revelation. At Aqaba, Palestine, Egypt, Jordan, and Saudi Arabia meet; Africa becomes Asia; and you are in the Holy Land. North to Petra, "the rose-red city half as old as time", carved out

of the living rock by the mysterious Nabateans and now, for 1500 years, abandoned but for tourists who flock here from every corner of the world in spring and fall.

PETRA - DEAD SEA - JERICO - JERUSALEM

Beyond Petra the bleak hills of Moab lead to the Dead Sea—at 1300 feet below sea-level the lowest feature on the surface of the earth. The supposed sites of Sodom and Gomorrah are on the west bank. Five minutes before landing in Jerusalem you see Jericho, where the "walls came tumblin' down", the lowest city in the world at 850 feet below sea-level. In Jerusalem you are in the city of holy memories... venerated as such by three great religions, by most of the human race.

JERUSALEM - MT. HERMON - DAMASCUS - BEIRUT

Just after Jerusalem airport the River Jordan

within your view twists its tortuous way into the bitter waters of the Dead Sea. The hills of Trans-Jordan rise to the East, the Sea of Galilee glimmers to the west, and as you round majestic Mt. Hermon, the fabled oasis of Damascus comes into view. Damascus is the oldest continuously-inhabited city in the world, the site of St. Paul's conversion, and the legendary home of Abraham. The bare Anti-Lebanons (the ancient region of Abilene) are crossed, and give way to the greenness of the Biqaa Valley. Look directly below you for the ruined Graeco-Roman temple which was used by the Crusaders as a watch-tower. Baalbek is just barely visible to the north. Now you surmount Lebanon, and descend slowly over the peaceful red-roofed villages

on its seaward slopes to Beirut, framed by the blue Mediterranean and by red sands washed all the way from the mouth of the Nile.
