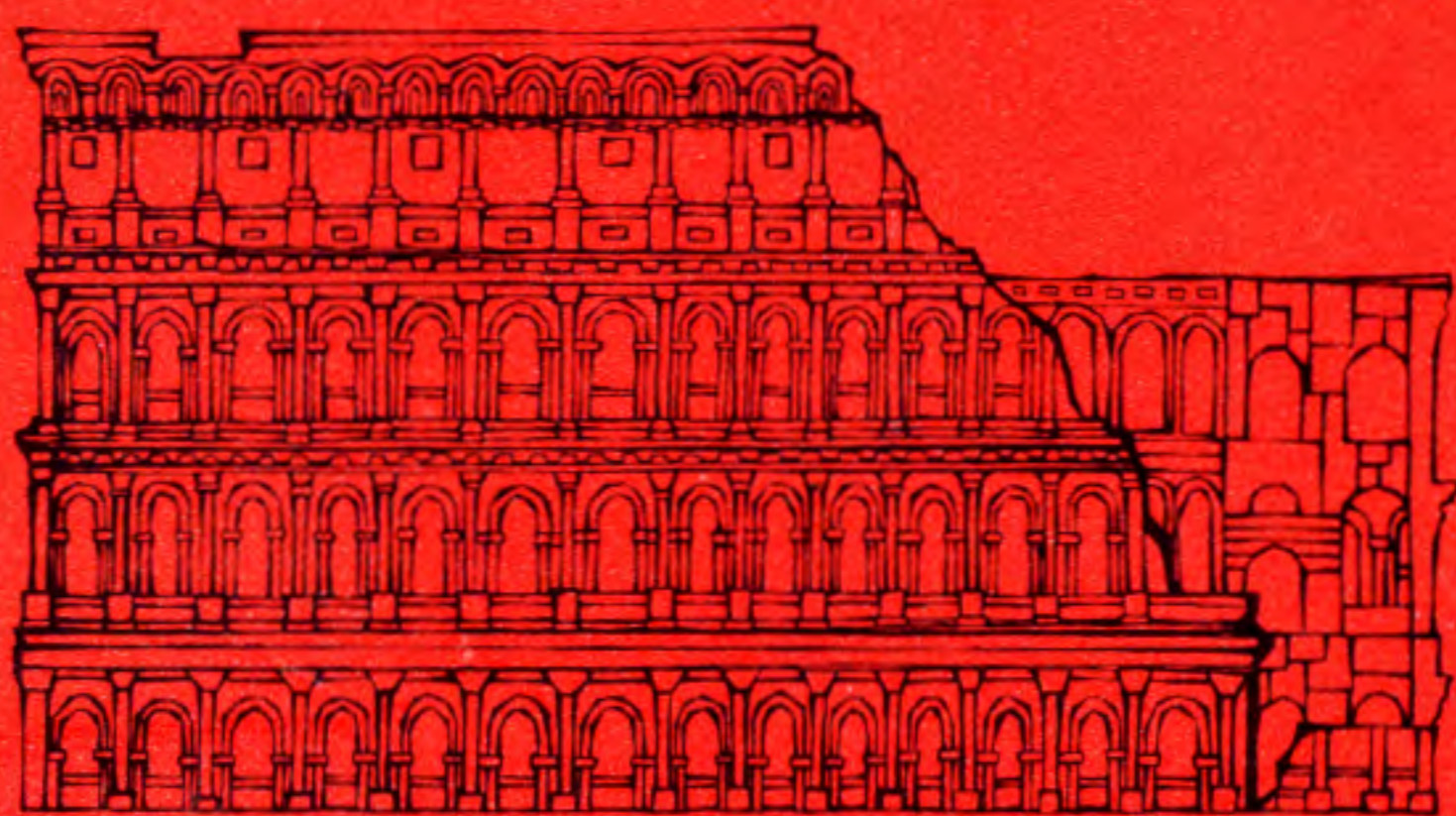

GENERAL INFORMATION

CONDITION OF CARRIAGE. The conditions of contract under which passengers and baggage are carried by Air Jordan will be found in every air ticket. A copy of the General Conditions of Carriage may be inspected at any Air Jordan office.

RESERVATIONS. The demand for accomodation is usually heavy and seats should be booked well in advance, either through a travel agent or at any office of Air Jordan. In no case will a firm booking be made without payment of the full fare. The cost of any telegrams or telephone calls will be charged to passengers.

DEPARTURES. Passengers should enquire locally for the assembly time at the town terminal or at the airport (by prior arrangement only) to complete baggage registration and other formalities. No Service can be delayed for passengers whose arrival leaves insufficient time for these formalities to be completed. The airport departure times shown are those at which aircraft are due to move away from the embarkation point and not the "take off" times from the runway.

CONNECTIONS. Although every effort is made to ensure the punctuality of all services, Air Jordan cannot accept responsibility for any delay to or suspension of its services, and does not guarantee making connections.

BREAK OF JOURNEY. A journey may be broken at most intermediate stops without charge on condition that the entire journey is completed within the validity of the ticket and provided the passengers express at the time of booking the wish to break the journey, and purchase the entire through ticket. The passenger is responsible for reserving accomodations for the succeeding stages.

CURRENCY RESTRICTIONS. The movement of money into and out of many countries is restricted by law and passengers should consult their bankers well before the date of their journey.

CHILDREN. One child under two years of age accompanied by an adult and not occupying a separate seat is carried at 10 per cent of the adult fare. Additional children under two years and children of two years and under twelve years of age are carried at half the adult fare. Reduced fares are also available on certain routes for school children and students travelling between home and school: particulars on application.

PASSPORTS. Passengers are reminded that passports should be carried with them and not packed in their baggage. They are advised to verify the validity and accuracy of their passports, endorsements and visas, as Air Jordan cannot accept any responsibility for the consequences of noncompliance with the regulations.

FREE BAGGAGE ALLOWANCE. (a) Passengers paying Tourist Class fare are allowed 20 Kilograms (44 pounds) free baggage. (b) Passengers paying B Class fare are allowed 30 Kilograms (66 pounds) free baggage.

EXCESS BAGGAGE. Baggage in excess of the free allowance will be charged for at 1% of the normal adult one way first class fare per kilo.

NOTES

- 1 - Direct connection from Beirut to Cairo on Monday, Wednesday, Thursday, and Friday.
- 2 - Direct connection from Cairo to Beirut on Tuesday, Friday, and Saturday.
- 3 - Direct connection from Nicosia to Cairo on Thursday.
- 4 - Direct connection from Dhahran and Kuwait to Cairo on Wednesday.
- 5 - Direct connection from Jeddah and Aqaba to Cairo on Thursday.
- 6 - Direct connection from Kuwait to Cairo on Friday.
- 7 - All times are local times except Jeddah and Dhahran which are GMT and local time is variable.
- 8 - No local traffic between Beirut/Nicosia and Nicosia/Beirut; also no local traffic between Beirut/Damascus and Damascus/Beirut and between Kuwait/Dhahran and Dhahran/Kuwait.
- 9 - *Service AJ 212/213 of Sunday is primarily a cargo service, however four passenger seats are available. No hostess service will be provided.
- 10 - Direct connections from Amman to New York and London at Rome on AJ/706.
- 11 - § denotes flag stop only.

THIS IS THE HOLY LAND ROUTE

Cairo to Suez - 71 miles - 22 minutes

Leaving the fertile Nile Valley you cross desert Egypt to Suez. The Suez Canal will be on the left and the Gulf of Suez on the right.

Suez to Mt. Sinai - 107 miles - 32 minutes

Look for the black bedouin tents as you fly along a famous camel caravan route. Mt. Sinai will be off the right wing-tip.

Mt. Sinai to Aqaba - 25 miles - 8 minutes

Jordan, Egypt, and Saudi Arabia meet at the Gulf of Aqaba. Africa becomes Asia here. Excellent sport fishing in the Gulf.

Aqaba to Petra - 71 miles - 21 minutes

This is the secret, technicolor stronghold of the ancient Nabataeans. Ask the hostess about Air Jordan's special flights to Petra.

Petra to Dead Sea - 63 miles - 19 minutes

Lowest and saltiest place in all the world - 1290 feet below sea level and about 45 miles long. Have you heard about our Below-Sea-Level Flying Club?

Dead Sea to Jericho - 40 miles - 12 minutes

Jericho is one of the oldest cities in the world and is the lowest, about 850 feet below sea level. Oranges and bananas are plentiful.

Jericho to Jerusalem - 12 miles - 4 minutes

Bethlehem will be off the left wing-tip. Jerusalem has an elevation of 2500 feet. The wonders of Jerusalem are here for you to discover! Our office will be pleased to assist you. Drop in - if only to rest, or for a refreshing cup of tea or coffee.

Jerusalem to Amman - 47 miles - 14 minutes

Leaving Jerusalem you cross the Jericho valley, flying over the Mount of Temptation. Jerusalem and Amman are at 2500 feet elevation while the Jericho valley is 1000 feet below sea level!

Amman to Damascus - 144 miles - 43 minutes

Your air routes are in corridors, so slight turns will be noticed and you will fly over Mafraq and later H-5, a pumping station on the IPC pipeline. The fabled Oasis of Damascus is magnificent from the air - the site of St. Paul's conversion and legendary home of Abraham.

Damascus to Beirut - 50 miles - 15 minutes

Rounding majestic Mt. Hermon and above the ancient region of Abilene you'll marvel at the greenness of the Bakaa Valley. Descending over Lebanon to Beirut, framed by the blue Mediterranean and red sands washed up from the mouth of the Nile, you'll appreciate this tremendous aerial view of one of the most modern cities of the Middle East.

Beirut to Nicosia - 148 miles - 46 minutes

Climbing away from Beirut the beauty of the city on its promontory is breath taking. Fifty minutes later you approach the coast of Cyprus, the land of Venus where mythology states she sprang to life from the sea foam off the coast of Paphos.

Nicosia to Athens - 570 miles - 2 hours 55 minutes

You will fly right over the island of Rhodes, famous as the Isle of Roses. Athens will be off the right wing and you will see the Parthenon on the Acropolis.

Athens to Rome - 700 miles - 3 hours 35 minutes

Between Athens and Rome lies the Ionian Sea. From the annals of the ancient Romans come stories of feats performed by valorous sailors on this stretch of water. Climbing slowly up the Italian boot you will thrill at sights read of and now to be treasured. Rome, the Eternal City, lies before you.
