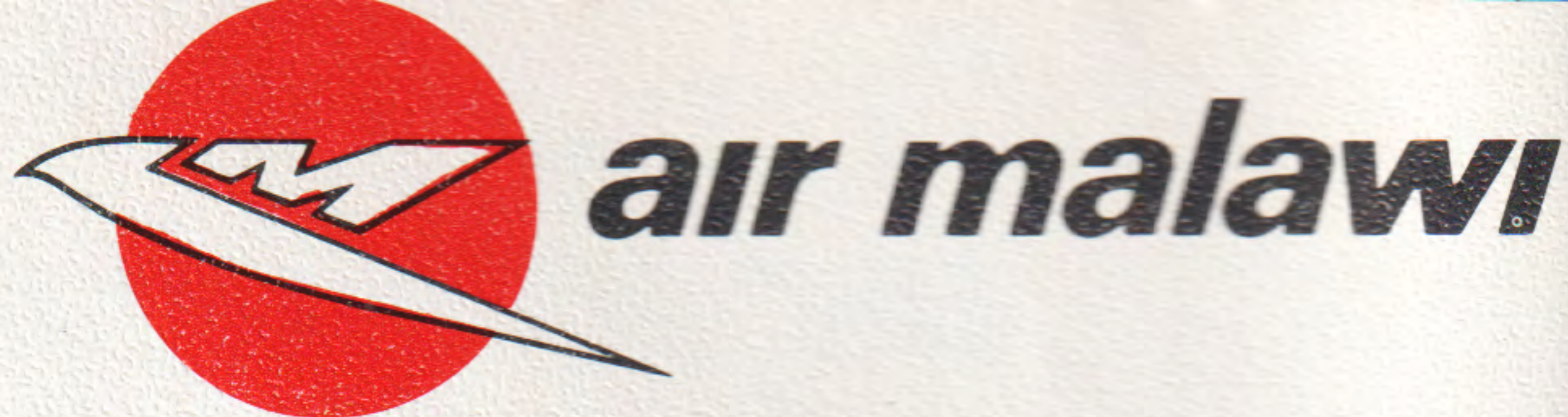

## Dress Code

Malaŵi is well known for its informality. For men, sports shirts, shorts or slacks, and light dresses for the ladies are ideal daytime dress.

There are certain dress limitations which apply to residents and visitors alike; ladies may not wear slacks (except in game parks) and must wear dresses/skirts that completely cover the knee. These regulations do not apply to the lakeshore resorts.

Gentlemen must not wear trousers of the "bell bottom" variety and long hair (defined as hair in bulk falling to the collar) is illegal. To avoid embarrassment on arrival, visitors are requested to ensure that they conform to these requirements.

## Connections

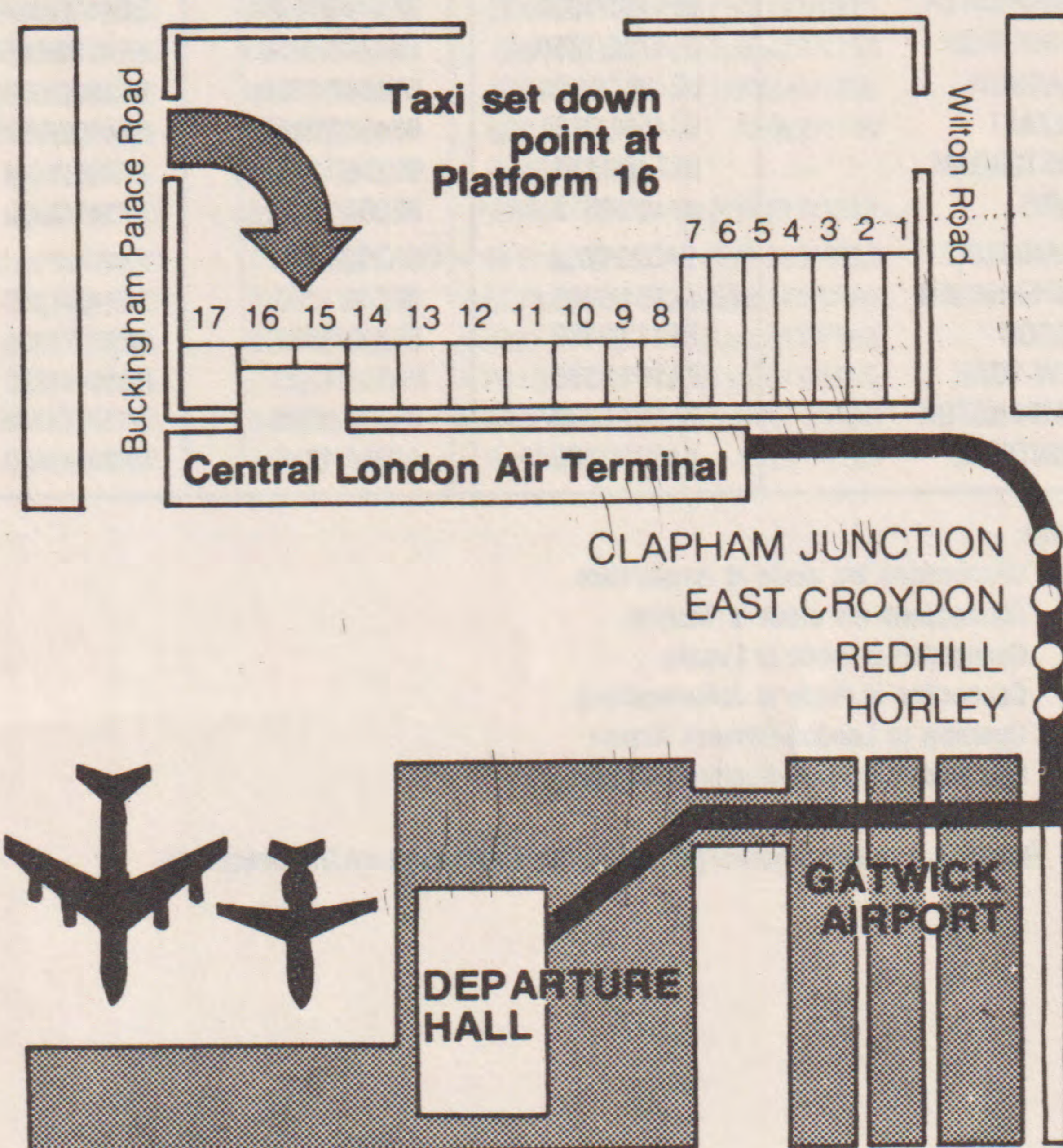

# The terminal in the centre of London

One of the biggest plus points of London Airport-Gatwick is the round-the-clock rail service between the airport's own station and Victoria Station in central London. Passengers arriving at Gatwick can enjoy an easy, relaxed journey into London by means of this fast, efficient service.

Your baggage is checked in and is in our care until you reach your final destination. 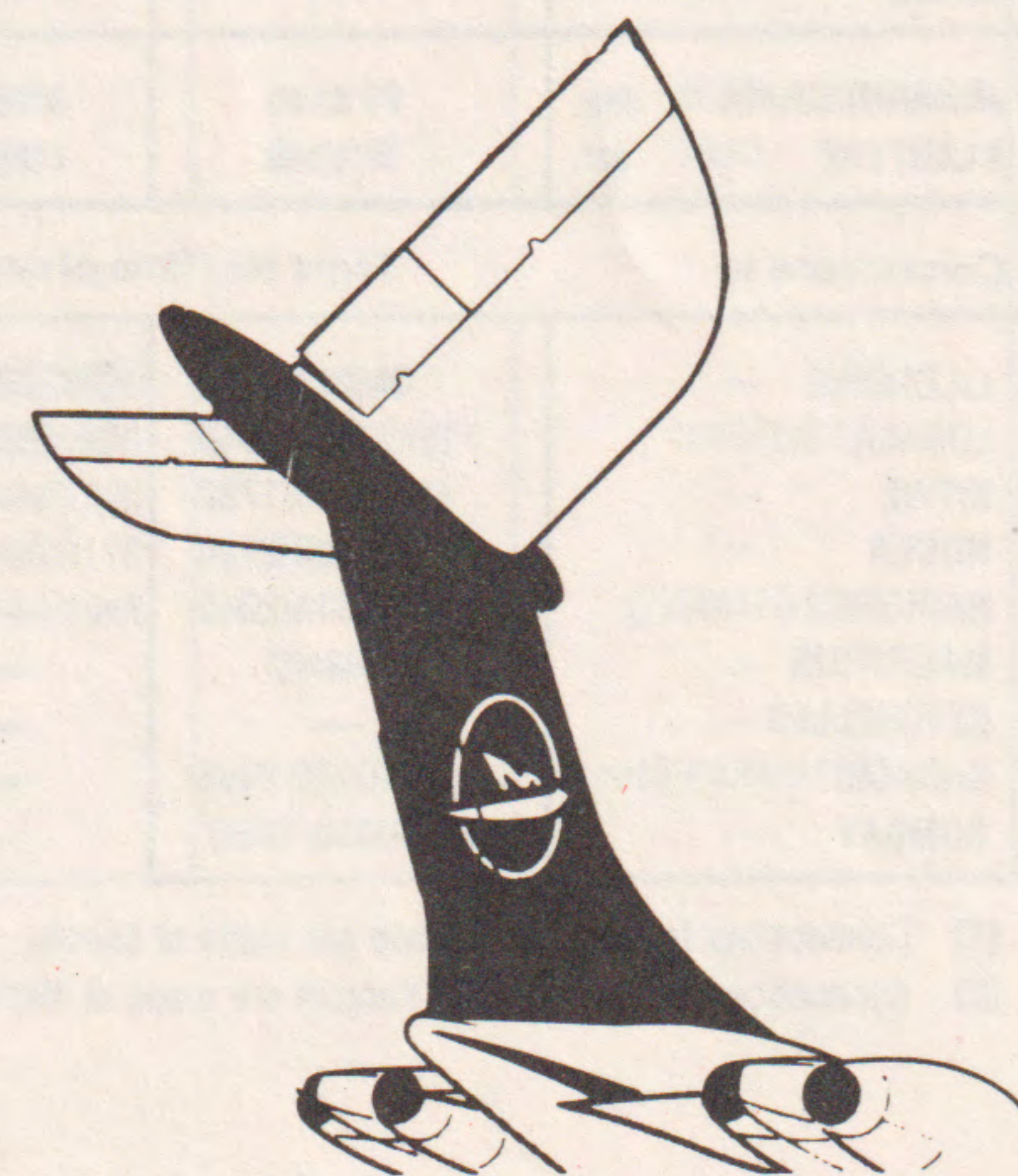

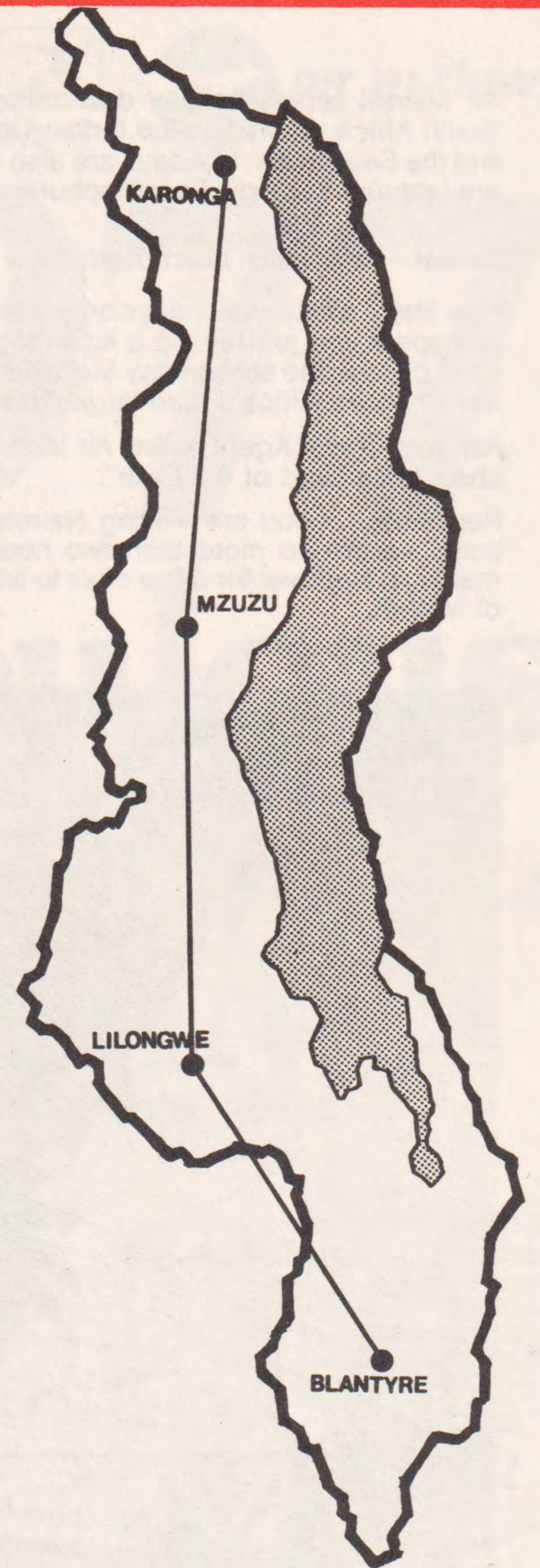

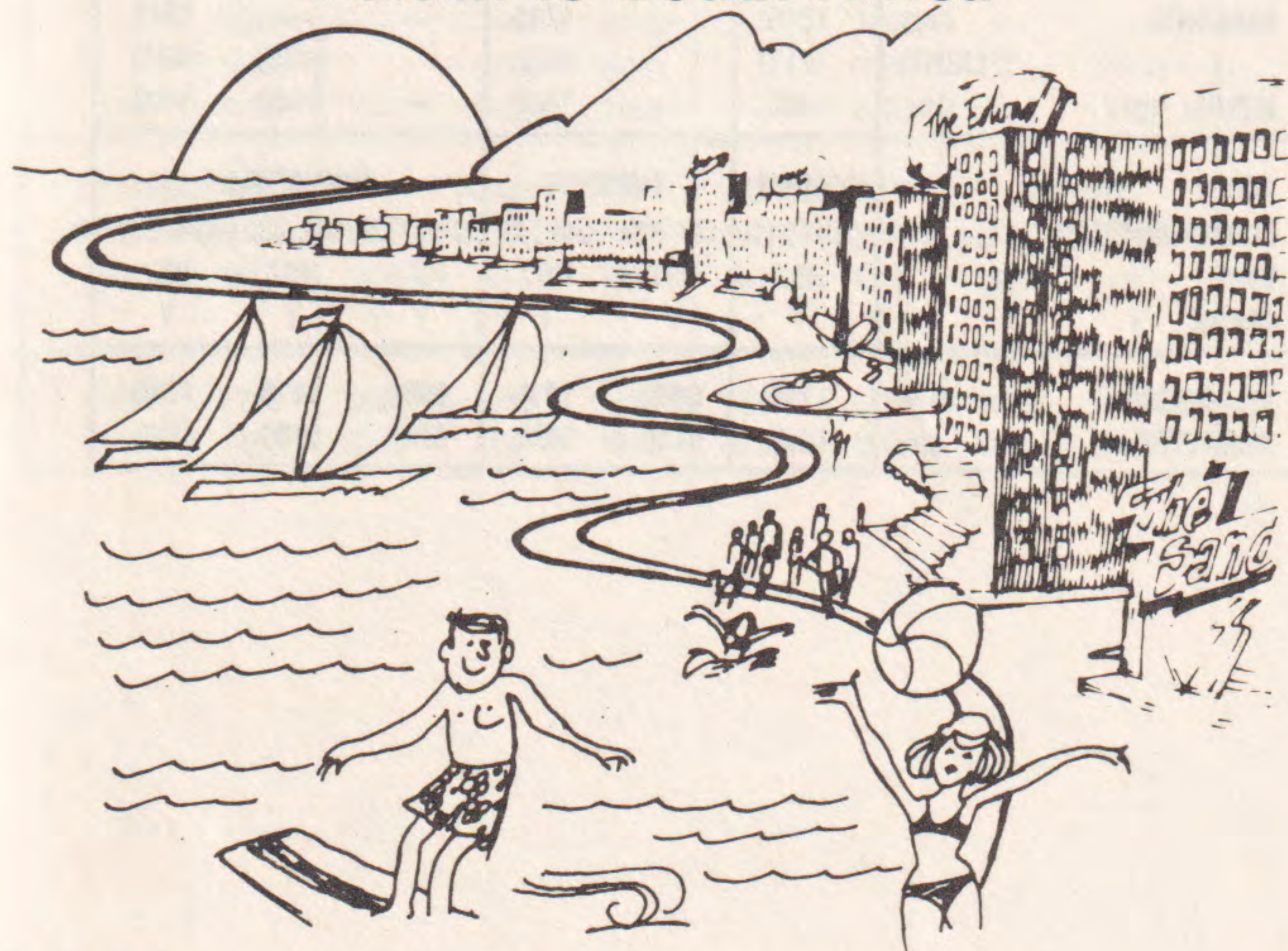

## Children and Infants

One infant under two years of age accompanied by an adult and not occupying a separate seat travels at 10% of the full applicable adult fare. Any additional infants accompanied by the same adult travel at 50% of the full applicable adult fare. Children of two years of age and over, but under twelve years of age travel at 50% of the full applicable adult fare. (See also Unaccompanied Children).

## Fares for Young Persons and Students

Special reduced rates are generally available to students between the ages of 12 and 25 inclusive, attending full-time school, college, university courses or other educational institutes when travelling between their place of education and their home.

## Taxes

Taxes and transportation charges are sometimes charged on air tickets and at international airports. Any Air MalaWi office or Appointed Travel Agent will gladly advise where these charges are applicable.

## Surface Transport

Surface transport is usually available between town terminals and airports (and vice versa). Normally such charges are payable locally and you are advised to ensure that you have sufficient local currency available in cash to meet this cost. Information regarding such transportation and its cost may be obtained at the time of making your reservations.

## BAGGAGE

### General

Passengers on international journeys are permitted to carry at no extra charge 30 kgs (66 lb) of baggage on First Class, and 20 kgs (44 lb) on Tourist and Economy Class services. Baggage should contain personal effects only, but you may carry commercial samples provided you arrange to be at the airport for international flights not later than the time specified by the local Customs; in the United Kingdom this is 40 minutes before the flight departure time. Fragile or perishable articles, money, jewellery, securities or other valuables, business documents, etc., will not be accepted as checked baggage. Children and infants travelling at half fare receive full adult baggage allowance. Infants travelling at 10% fare have no free allowance, but a reasonable amount of food for consumption during flights and a carry-cot may be carried free of charge.

### Personal Items

In addition to the free allowance, a lady's handbag, an overcoat or wrap, an umbrella or walking stick, a small camera, a pair of binoculars, and a reasonable amount of reading matter for the journey may be carried free in the cabin of the aircraft. A fully collapsible invalid's wheelchair, a pair of crutches and/or braces will also be carried free of charge provided that the passenger is dependent upon them. Briefcases, typewriters, radios, night-stop bags, ladies vanity or cosmetic cases, hat boxes, heavy cameras, excessive reading matter and other parcels, will be treated as part of the allowance.

### Excess Baggage

Excess Baggage will be carried if there is space in the aircraft and will be charged for at the appropriate rate.

### Unaccompanied Baggage

Unaccompanied baggage may be sent as cargo on all Air MalaWi routes. Special reduced rates apply between Europe and Africa or wholly within Africa. Full details from any Air MalaWi Cargo Office.

### Prohibited Articles

Government regulations do not permit the carriage on aircraft of a number of articles, including inflammable explosive, corrosive, oxidising, radio-active or magnetic materials, and you are asked not to carry with you or in your baggage such things as cylinders of compressed gas for picnic or camping stoves, cylinders of compressed air for use with aqua-lungs and underwater equipment, containers of cigarette lighter fuel, firearms or explosives including blank cartridges. On all Air MalaWi aircraft, except during take-off and landing, and in the toilets, smoking is permitted and you may carry a box of SAFETY matches or a lighter with you for use on the journey. If you are in any doubt as to whether any article or item is acceptable for carriage in the aircraft, our traffic staff will be pleased to advise you.

### Security

In the interests of your own security, your attention is directed to the following points:

- (i) If you have been given a present or other article by anyone with the request that you take it with you on your flight, you should inform an airline representative, police or Customs official immediately.
- (ii) Do not accept any such presents or articles from anyone AFTER checking-in for your flight.
- (iii) Do not leave your baggage at any time unobserved.

### Portable Electronic Equipment:

Passengers may not use any portable electronic equipment such as radios and tape recorders during the flight because of possible affects on the aircraft's equipment.

### Reconfirmation Procedure

If you break your journey for more than 72 hours at any point, please reconfirm the intention of using your continuing or return reservation. To do so, please inform the airline office at the point where you intend to resume your journey at least 72 hours before departure of your flight. Failure to reconfirm will result in the cancellation of your reservation(s).

### General

#### Ticket

Your ticket is issued subject to the Conditions of Contract printed inside the front cover, and to our GENERAL CONDITIONS OF CARRIAGE OF PASSENGERS AND BAGGAGE, copies of which may be inspected at our booking office.

### Passport Requirement

All passports must carry endorsements covering the countries through which you pass. An endorsement "All Countries of the World" will suffice. Although any Air MalaWi office or Appointed Travel Agent will gladly offer advice and assistance regarding the travel documents and visas required for your journey, you must personally ensure that you are in possession of the necessary travel documents and visas since Air MalaWi cannot accept any responsibility for the consequences of any irregularity. It should be noted, however, that some Consulates require a personal application before granting visas.

### Currency

Your travel agent or your bank will inform you of prevailing currency regulations in the countries you are visiting and it is advisable to carry Traveller's Cheques endorsed for the places you will visit.

## Departures

Services cannot be delayed for latecomers, so please check-in at the town terminal or at the airport by the time specified. The check-in time shown on your ticket should be regarded as the latest time for joining; it only allows for the minimum time needed to complete all the necessary formalities.

## Punctuality

Naturally every effort is made to ensure the punctuality of our services, but Air MalaWi cannot accept responsibility for any consequences caused by the delay or suspension of a service. Similarly, we cannot guarantee that connections will be made with the services of other air or surface carriers.

## Empty Seats on Fully Booked Aircraft

There is normally a good reason for any empty seats which may be seen on an aircraft stated to be fully booked. Sometimes seats are cancelled at the last moment and cannot be re-sold, and in other instances the equivalent weight has been reserved for additional mail or urgent cargo, which of course cannot be seen from the passenger cabin.

## Unaccompanied Children

Children who have reached their sixth birthday but have not reached their twelfth birthday and who are not accompanied, may travel, provided that arrangements are made by their parents/guardians for them to be escorted at a point of departure and arrival. A special form must be completed by the parent/guardian and returned to the office making the reservation at the time of purchase of the ticket.

These facilities are also available to children over 12 years of age and under 16 years of age upon request from the parent/guardian. Children and infants under six years of age will normally not be accepted for travel unless accompanied by an adult passenger who must assume responsibility for them during the journey. However, where this is not possible, such children and infants may travel if accompanied by an official escort provided by Air MalaWi exclusively for that purpose. The charge for the services of an escort will be the applicable adult return fare (this is in addition to the child's fare).

## Pets

We regret that we cannot carry pets in the passenger cabin. They can, however, be carried as cargo on most routes by prior arrangement.

## Catering

Complimentary meals or refreshments, in flight, are provided at appropriate times shown in the schedules. You will find an indication of the type of catering to be provided, however this may change without prior notice. Alcoholic drinks, in flight, are provided free for First Class passengers, and may be purchased by Tourist/Economy Class passengers. Dietary or religious meals can be provided if previously requested.

## Insurance

You can purchase personal and baggage insurance at some Air MalaWi offices, from vending machines at certain airports or through your local travel agent. Please ask for details.

## Reservations and Cancellations

Please reserve your seat as far in advance as possible, through any Air MalaWi Office or Appointed Travel Agent. Should you wish to cancel or alter your reservation, please inform us immediately.

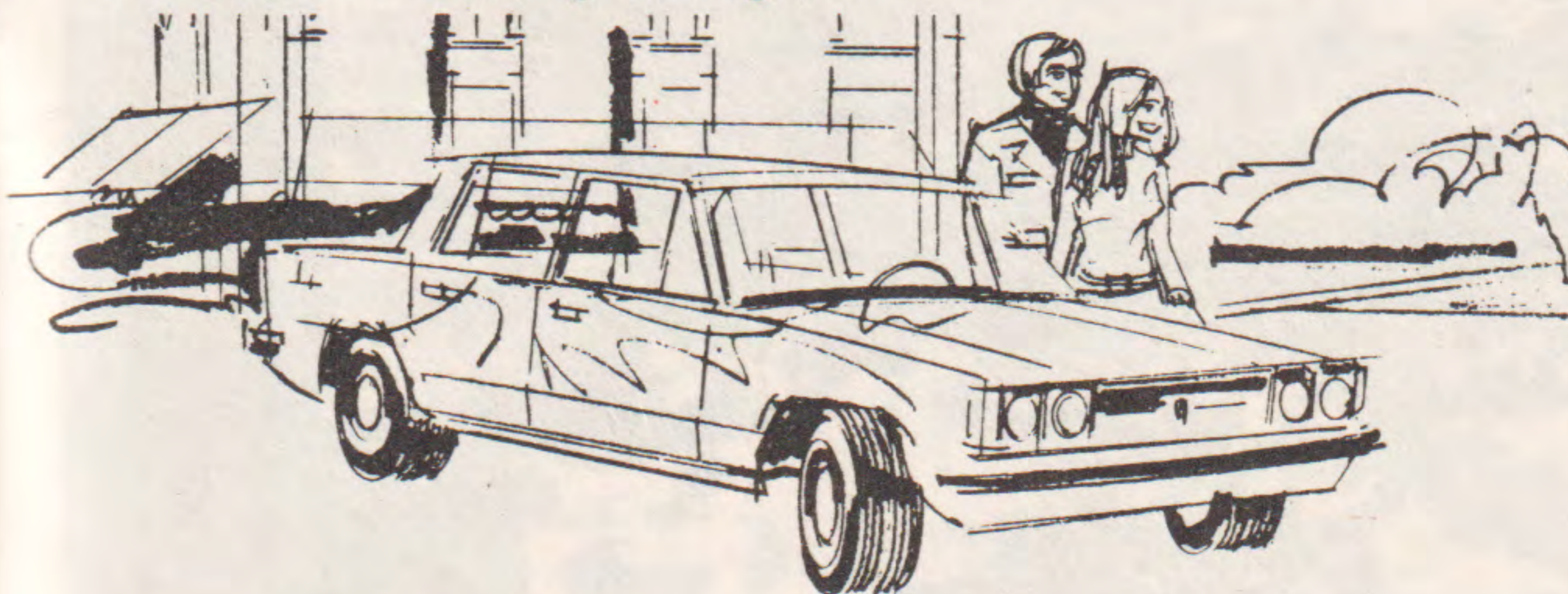
## Extra Service

At London if you are making a direct connection to or from an Air MalaWi flight, Air MalaWi provides free chauffeur-driven transfers between Gatwick and Heathrow. London, Gatwick Airport, is situated 35 miles due south of London and there is an integrated British Rail Station where trains leave every 15 minutes during the day, and every hour during the night. The running time is approximately 40 minutes. Our staff at Gatwick will be pleased to give you any further information that you may require, such as hotels, onward flight connections, and transportation to London Heathrow Airport.

## To/From London Airport Heathrow

A chauffeur-driven car is provided free for passengers transferring between Heathrow and Gatwick Airport — making direct connection to or from Air MalaWi international scheduled service.

The airline carrying passengers into Heathrow Airport will on application to their transfer desk arrange with British Caledonian Interline desk Terminal 1 for this service to be provided. At Gatwick Airport requests for the service should be made to Air MalaWi staff meeting the flight.

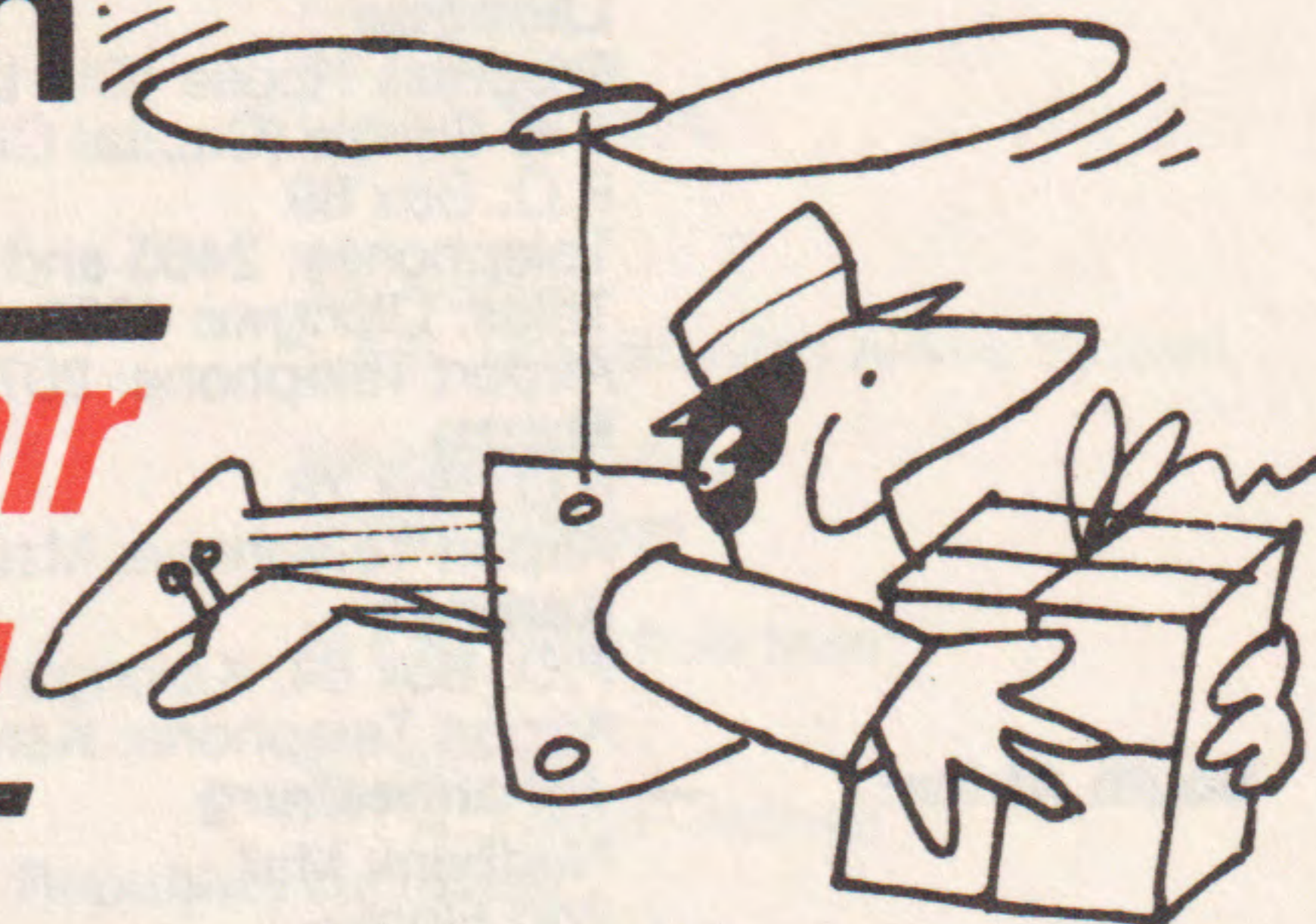
