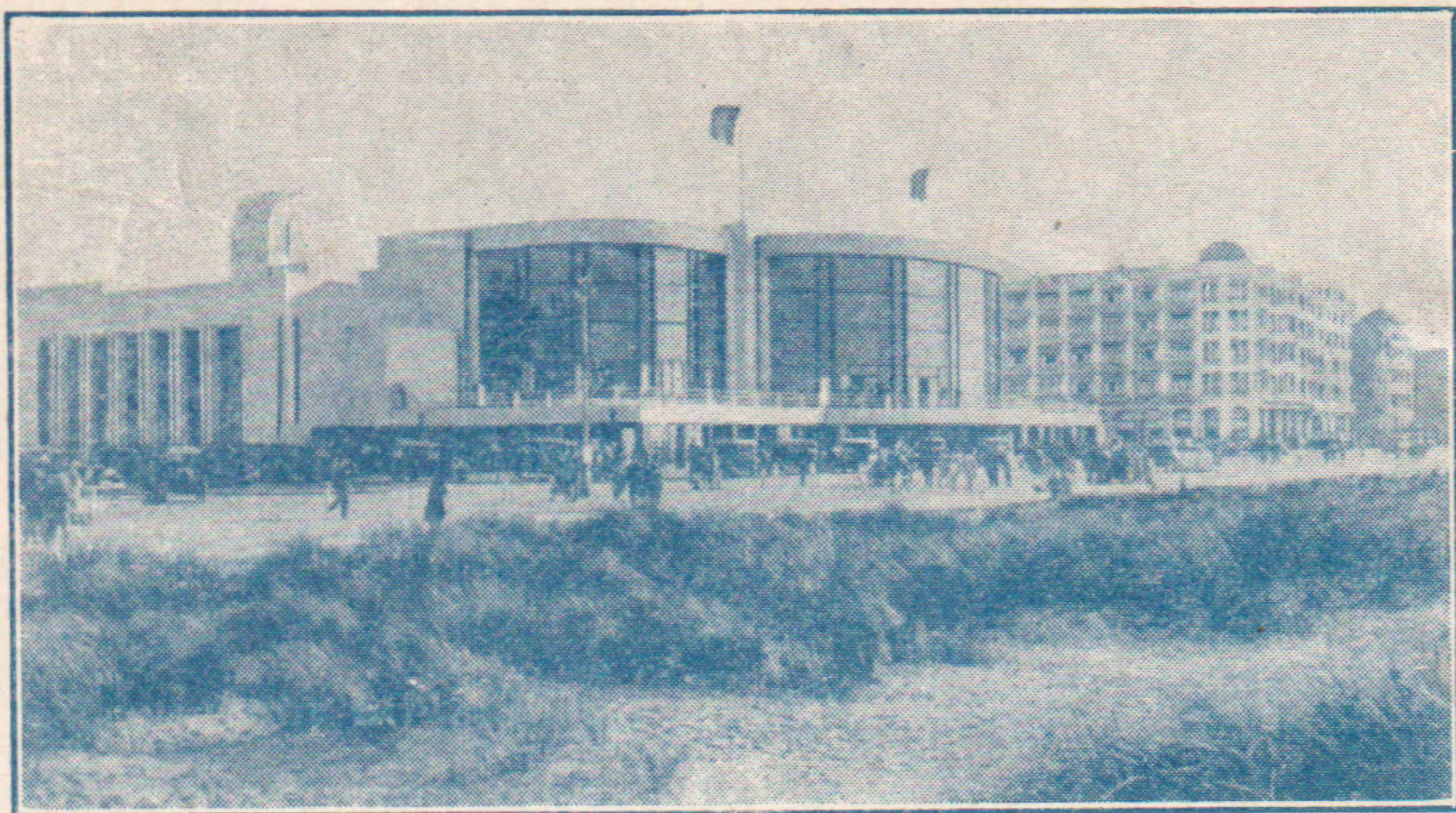

NOTES FOR PASSENGERS.

1. CONDITIONS OF TRANSPORT

The Company undertakes to carry Passengers and Baggage under the conditions, an extract of which is printed on the back of every Air Ticket issued by the Company.

2. CANCELLATIONS AND ALTERATIONS.

This Time Table and Fares are subject to alteration or cancellation without notice.

3. AIRCRAFT.

Modern Air Liners are operated, and the cabins are well ventilated and maintained at a normal temperature. Comfortable separate armchairs provide a restful journey. All machines are fitted with wireless to maintain two way communications with the ground stations over the route.

4. RESERVATIONS.

There is strictly limited accommodation, and passengers are strongly advised to book well in advance, otherwise seats cannot be guaranteed. No person is permitted to embark on the Company's Aircraft unless in possession of a ticket to travel. Under no circumstances will a voucher be accepted in lieu of a ticket.

5. RETURN TICKETS.

A return ticket does not give the holder any preferential claim to accommodation. Reservations for a return journey must be made as for single journeys. Open Date Return tickets are available on any day within the period of validity. Passengers not paying return fare at the time of buying a ticket for the outward journey cannot afterwards be put upon the same fare footing as the holder of a return ticket.

6. CANCELLATION BY PASSENGER.

Provided 48 hours' notice of cancellation of reservation be given the fare will be refunded less 10%, otherwise no refund can be made. Holders of return tickets not wishing to use the return half may claim a refund of the difference between the single and return fare paid, less 10% provided at least 48 hours' notice is given and that no accommodation has been reserved for the return journey. Claims cannot be admitted unless made within one month of the tickets date of expiry.

7. CHILDREN.

Under three years of age and accompanied by an adult are charged 10% of the fare. Half fare is charged for children between 3-7 years of age. There is no free baggage allowance for children under three years, but the free baggage allowance is permitted for children over three years.

8. BAGGAGE.

33lbs (15 kg.) of Luggage are carried free and every lb. in excess of this weight is charged for at the rates published in this Time Table. Notice of any excess of the free allowance must be given so that accommodation can be reserved in the machine in which the passenger is travelling, otherwise it may have to be left to travel on the first available machine afterwards.

9. AIRCRAFT DEPARTURES.

Passenger lists are normally closed five minutes before the advertised time of the Aircraft's departure, therefore passengers arriving at the Airport by their own conveyance should do so sufficiently in advance to enable ticket and baggage formalities to be completed before departure. No guarantee can be given that passengers arriving after the lists are closed can be carried on that service.

10. TRANSPORT.

Transportation Between City Centre and Airport is as indicated in the Time Table.

11. LIVESTOCK.

Dogs or other animals, birds, etc., cannot be carried in cabins of Air Liners or regarded as baggage. They must be forwarded as freight, and crated to the satisfaction of the Company and at least 24 hours' notice be given so that special arrangements can be made.

(a) Out by N.E.A., return by L.N.E.R. or L.M.S.R.

If you hold a return air ticket (except for the throughout journey between London and Glasgow) you may, if you wish, exchange your return half at a Railway Station Booking Office, for a First Class single ticket available by any recognised railway route to the place from which you started. Where the single Rail fare is in excess of the value of the return half of the Air ticket, the passenger making the transfer will pay the difference to North Eastern Airways, Ltd.

(b) Out by Rail (L.N.E.R. or L.M.S.R.) return by N.E.A.

Should you have travelled outward by rail, and hold the return half of an Ordinary, Tourist, or Monthly Return rail ticket (except between London and Glasgow) issued for a journey between places also served by an N.E.A. Service, you may, after handing your return half to N.E.A. or their Representative at the Airport, return by Air on payment of an appropriate supplementary fare.

The return journey must be made within the period of availability of the rail ticket.

In the case of children, you should pay the published Air Fare and apply to the Railway Company for a refund of the unused portion of the rail ticket, quoting the number of the Air Ticket issued.
