GENERAL INFORMATION

AIRCRAFT

AirCal utilizes Boeing 737 and McDonnell Douglas DC-9 Super 80 Sun-jets on all flights.

ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES

Federal Aviation Administration regulations provide that no persons may drink alcoholic beverages aboard an aircraft unless they have been served by the airline, and no such beverage may be served to any person who appears intoxicated.

BAGGAGE

Baggage Liability—Passenger name identification must be placed on the outside of all checked baggage. Baggage identification labels are available from AirCal at no cost. Liability for baggage between points in the U.S. will not exceed \$750.00 unless you declare a higher valuation and pay an extra charge. Excess valuation cannot be declared for certain checked valuable items such as jewelry, negotiable instruments, currency and antiques.

Free Baggage Allowance—(Per Passenger) 1 piece of baggage with linear dimensions (length + height + width) not exceeding 62 inches, plus 1 piece of baggage with linear dimensions not exceeding 55 inches. One or more additional pieces, totaling not more than 45 inches may be carried on board provided it fits beneath the seat; approximate dimensions not to exceed 10" x 16" x 19". In addition to size, no single piece can weigh more than 70 pounds.

Excess Baggage—A standard fee of \$7.00 will be charged for each of the first four pieces, and \$28.00 for each additional piece. The items listed below are subject to the special charges regardless of the total baggage carried.

Bicycles — \$14.00 Scuba Gear — \$7.00
Surfboards — \$14.00 Household Pets — \$21.00

CHECK-IN TIMES

Make sure that tickets, baggage and other details are in order before checking in. Check in at least 30 minutes before departure (45 minutes if you do not have your ticket). If you check in at the gate of departure less than 10 minutes prior to departure, your space is subject to cancellation and use by non-confirmed passengers.

CLAIMS

Damage to or loss of baggage must be reported to AirCal immediately upon termination of your flight.

CREDIT CARDS

AirCal honors American Express, BankAmericard, Barclay Card Chargex, Carte Blanche, Diners Club, First National Bank of San Jose, Master Charge, UATP and VISA credit cards.

DENIED BOARDING COMPENSATION

Compensation will be paid if the flight for which you have a confirmed reservation is unable to accommodate you and departs without you. Subject to the exceptions prescribed in the tariff on file, compensation will be in amounts from \$37.50 to \$200.00 depending upon the ticket value.

RESERVATIONS

Advance reservations are desirable, and may be obtained for any flight by contacting AirCal or your Travel Agent.

RESPONSIBILITY

AirCal will not be responsible for damages resulting from the failure to depart or arrive at times stated in this timetable nor for errors herein, nor for failure to make connections with flights of other airlines or of this company, nor for cancellation beyond our control when such actions are deemed advisable. The Company has the right to cancel reservations before passage or enroute whenever such action is deemed advisable or necessary. Schedules and fares are subject to change without notice.

RESTRICTED ARTICLES

Corrosive liquids, flammable substances, such as matches and lighter fluid, compressed gas or any hazardous material MAY NOT be carried in baggage.
