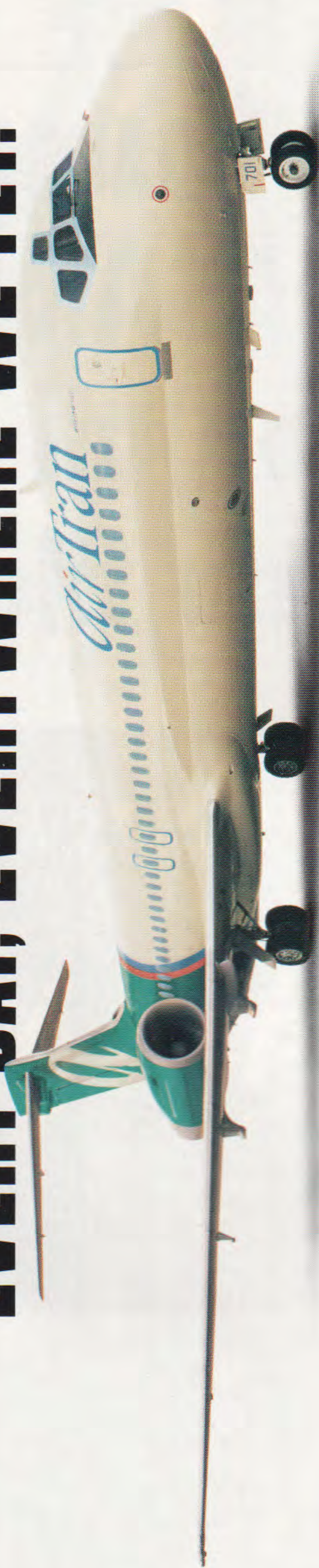

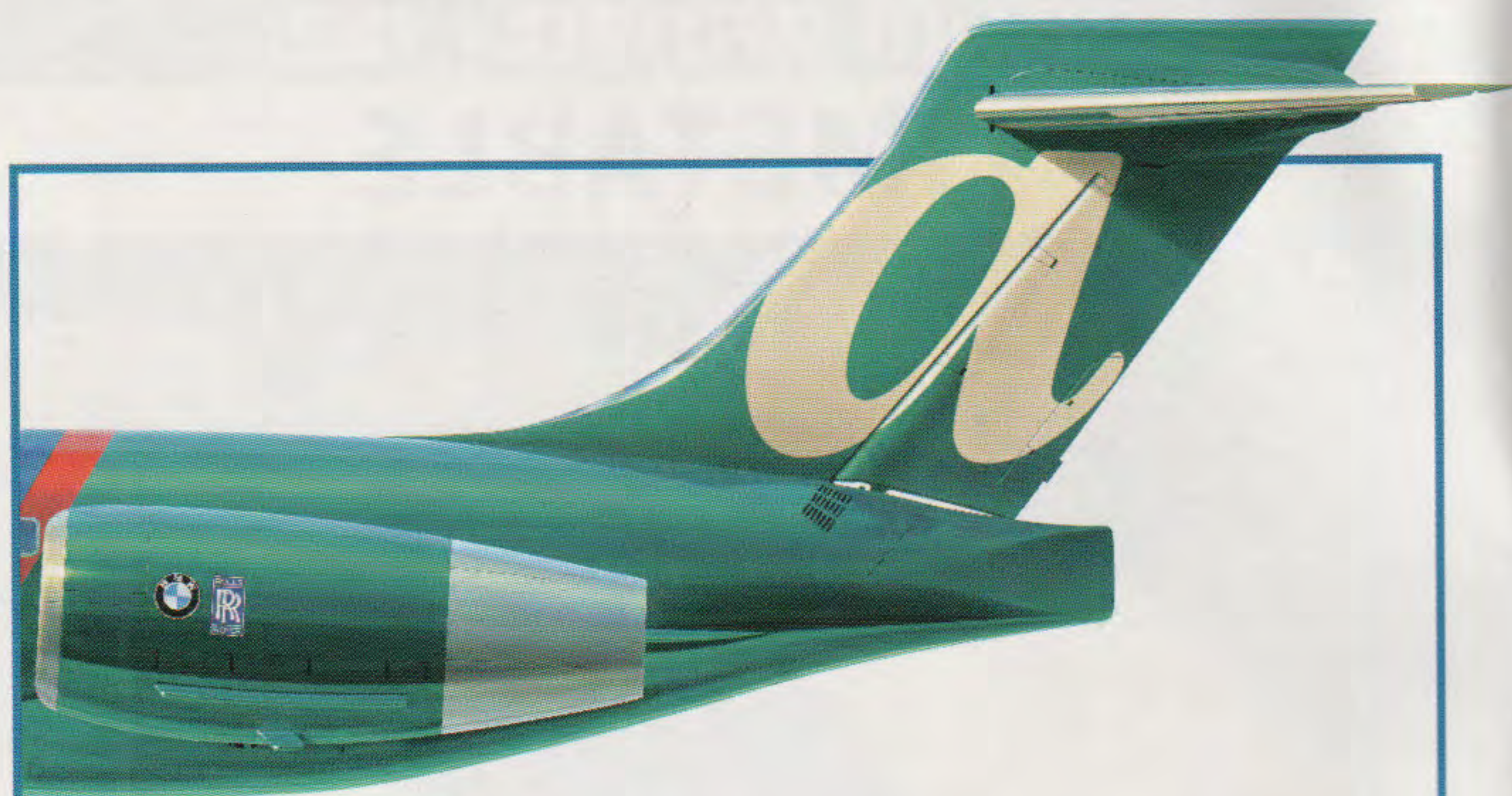

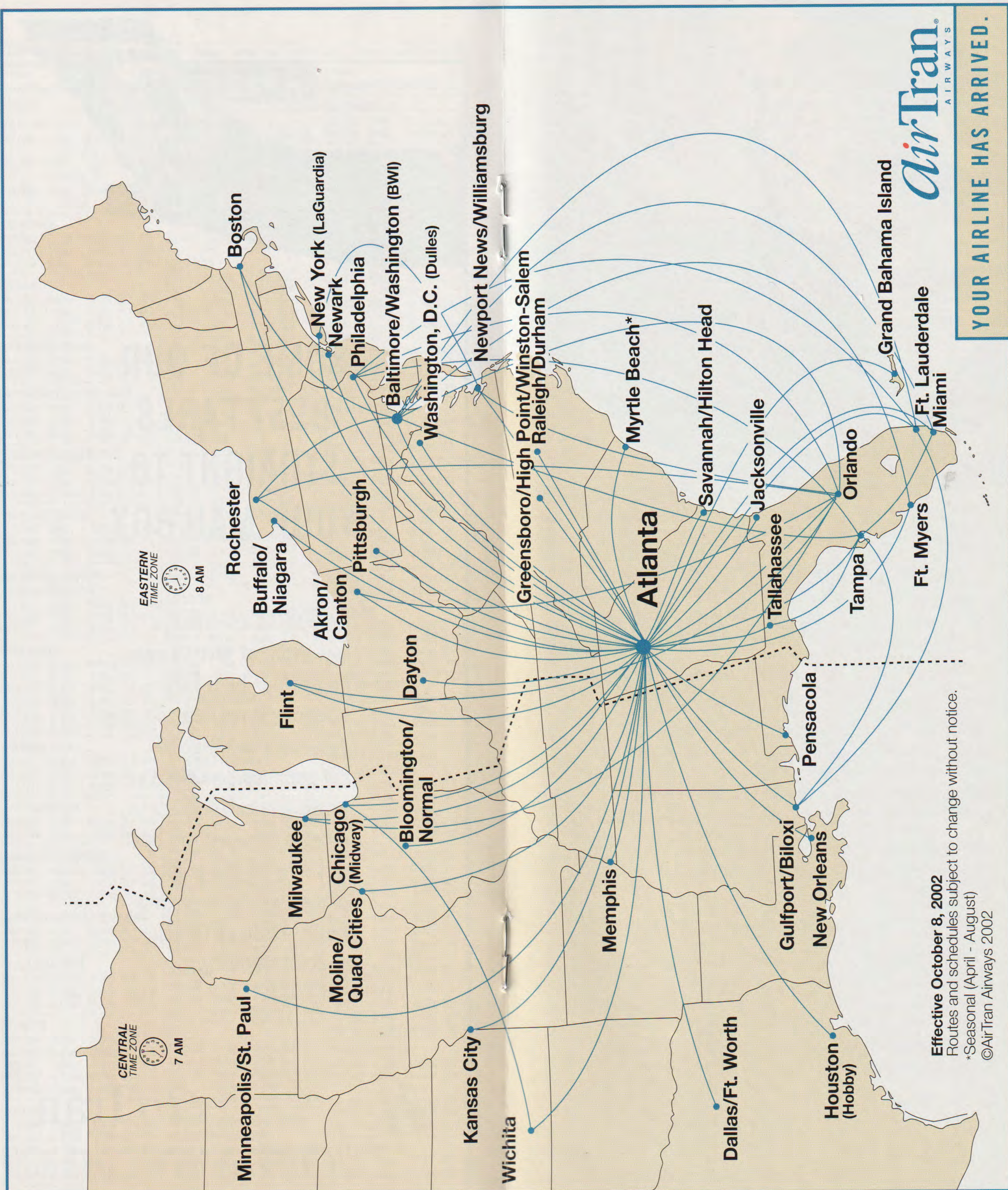

### AIRTRAN AIRWAYS CONTRACT TERMS

Transportation on Airtran Airways is subject to the terms of our contract of carriage, which may be inspected at any Airtran Airways customer service counter. These include provisions on: 1) Limits on liability for personal injury or death. 2) Limits on liability for baggage, including fragile or perishable goods, and availability of excess valuation coverage. 3) Claims restrictions, including time periods in which passengers must file a claim or bring an action against the air carrier. 4) Rights of the air carrier to change terms of the contract. 5) Rules on reconfirmation of reservations, check-in times, and refusal to carry. 6) Rights of the air carrier and limits on liability for delay or failure to perform service, including schedule changes, substitution of alternate air carriers or aircraft, and rerouting. Ask us for details, or how you may get a copy of the complete contract. Please note that fares are subject to change until the purchase of a reservation. All Airtran Airways fares are one-way. All Airtran Airways fares are non-refundable (except Business Class) and a \$50 fee per person applies to any change made after purchase plus any applicable increase in airfare. Failure to cancel reservation one hour prior to departure will result in forfeiture of airfare. Fares, routes, and schedules are subject to change without notice. Amounts shown are in U.S. dollars.

### ADVICE TO INTERNATIONAL PASSENGERS ON LIMITATIONS OF LIABILITY

Passengers on a journey involving an ultimate destination or a stop in a country other than the country of departure are advised that a treaty known as the Warsaw Convention may apply to the entire journey, including any portion thereof entirely within a country. For such passengers, the Warsaw Convention, including special contracts of carriage embodied in applicable tariffs, governs the liability of the carrier for death of or injury to passengers. The names of carriers party to such special contracts are available at all ticket offices of such carriers and may be examined upon request.

### AIRCRAFT

Airtran Airways operates McDonnell-Douglas DC-9 (16 Business Class, 90 Coach seats) and Boeing 717 (12 Business Class, 105 Coach seats).

### BAGGAGE

Checked baggage should be locked. Regulations require name identification on the outside. We recommend placing identification on the inside of luggage, too. Name labels are available at Airtran Airways customer service counters. Carrier will not be responsible for money, jewelry, cameras, video and electronic equipment, silverware, negotiable papers, securities, business documents, samples, paintings, antiques, artifacts, manuscripts, furs, irreplaceable books, or publications and similar valuables contained in checked or unchecked baggage. Fragile articles and perishables are accepted as checked baggage only at the customer's own risk. Checked baggage is subject to inspection and customers may be required to present identification. Claims for damaged or delayed luggage must be reported in person within four (4) hours of arrival at the destination airport.

#### A. ANIMALS

Some household animals may be carried in the aircraft cabin, subject to size limitations and service charges. Contact Airtran Airways Reservations for additional information at 800-AIR-TRAN or 770-994-8258 in Atlanta.

#### B. CARRY-ON BAGGAGE

All customers traveling on Airtran Airways will be restricted to one (1) carry-on item. Handbags, umbrellas, walking sticks, crutches, coats, cameras, reading matter, infant food, briefcases and laptop computers do not constitute carry-on items. No carry-on item may exceed overall dimensions of 45 inches, and all items must fit under the seat or in the overhead bin. Any heavy item must be placed underneath the customer's seat. Any item with inflexible surfaces must be placed underneath the customer's seat or flat on the floor of an overhead bin. For additional information regarding military baggage or sporting equipment, please call Airtran Airways Reservations at 800-AIR-TRAN or 770-994-8258 in Atlanta.

#### C. EXCESS BAGGAGE

Excess baggage will be charged at the rate of \$50 for each piece checked after the first three (3).



#### D. FREE BAGGAGE ALLOWANCE

For each fare-paying customer, AirTran Airways allows three (3) checked pieces, with size limitations.

#### E. NOTICE OF BAGGAGE LIABILITY LIMITATIONS

Liability for loss, delay, or damage is limited unless a higher value is declared in advance and additional charges are paid. For most international travel (including domestic portions of international journeys) the liability is approximately \$9.07 per pound for checked baggage and \$400 per person for unchecked baggage, unless excess value is declared and charges paid at the time of check-in. AirTran Airways' liability for lost, damaged, or delayed baggage is limited to \$2,500 per fare-paying customer for travel wholly between U.S. points. Excess valuation may be declared on certain types of articles. AirTran Airways assumes no liability for fragile, valuable, or perishable articles. Further information may be obtained from the carrier.

#### F. WEIGHT AND SIZE ALLOWANCE

The maximum weight is 70 pounds and maximum size is 62 inches for the first piece of baggage. Additional checked baggage may not exceed 55 inches or 70 pounds.

#### BOARDING PROCEDURES

AirTran Airways customers will receive seat assignments at the gate. Courtesy boarding is provided for unaccompanied minors, passengers traveling with infants in arms, and passengers requiring special assistance. During courtesy boarding, Business Class passengers will be allowed to board the aircraft. General boarding then begins by boarding those passengers seated in the rear of the aircraft first and then working forward. AirTran Airways recommends that passengers check in at least one (1) hour in advance of the flight. To ensure an on-time operation, flights close ten minutes prior to departure time.

#### CANCELLATION POLICY

To cancel a reservation, please call AirTran Airways Reservations at 800-AIR-TRAN or 770-994-8258 in Atlanta. Reservations must be cancelled at least one hour prior to departure, and there is a \$50 fee per passenger to cancel a reservation. The remaining balance will be placed in a credit file which may be used for future bookings for up to one year from the date of the original booking. Failure to cancel reservations one hour prior to departure will result in the forfeiture of airfare.

#### CHECK ACCEPTANCE POLICY

Personal checks made payable to AirTran Airways for the exact amount of purchase must include imprinted name, mailing address, and telephone number. A valid driver's license with picture (or valid passport) is required. Company checks made payable to AirTran Airways for the exact amount of purchase are also accepted. Proper identification of person presenting check (valid driver's license and valid company identification) is required.

#### CREDIT CARDS

AirTran Airways accepts American Express®, Carte Blanche, Diners Club®, Discover® Card, UATP<sup>SM</sup> MasterCard®, and VISA®.

#### CUSTOMER CHECK-IN PROCEDURES

Customers presenting themselves at the AirTran Airways gate less than ten minutes before scheduled departure of a flight may lose their reservations and, if so, will not be eligible for denied boarding compensation.

#### HAZARDOUS MATERIALS

Federal regulations restrict carriage on aircraft of items classified as hazardous materials. These materials include, but are not limited to, flammable gases — liquid and solid, nonflammable compressed gases, explosives, poisons, corrosives, oxidizing agents, radioactive materials, etiologic agents, and magnetized materials.

#### IDENTIFICATION

All passengers over the age of 18 must present a valid, government issued photo ID (such as a driver's license, U.S. Military ID card or passport) upon check-in and upon boarding the aircraft. Travel to/from Grand Bahama Island is considered international travel. We encourage you to contact U.S. Customs at 202-927-6724 to request a copy of their brochure, "Know Before You Go." If you are unfamiliar with the documentation requirements for international travel, please contact AirTran Airways Reservations at 800-AIR-TRAN or 770-994-8258 in Atlanta.

#### INFANTS AND CHILDREN

One (1) child over 14 days and under two (2) years of age, not occupying a seat, may be carried free with a customer paying the applicable adult fare. A birth certificate may be required to validate age of all infants under age two.

#### INTERNATIONAL – NOTICE OF BAGGAGE LIABILITY LIMITATIONS

For most international travel (including domestic portions of international journeys):

- Liability for loss, delay, or damage to baggage is limited to approximately \$9.07 per pound (\$20.00 per kilo) for checked baggage and \$400.00 per passenger for unchecked baggage, unless a higher value is declared in advance and additional charges are paid. Excess valuation may not be declared on certain types of valuable articles. Carriers assume no liability for fragile or perishable articles. Further information may be obtained from the carrier.
- Liability is for a maximum of 70 lbs. (\$640.00) per checked bag. The limit may be lowered for additional pieces to certain destinations or when using connecting carriers.

#### NO SMOKING

Per federal law, smoking is prohibited on all AirTran Airways flights.

#### NOTICE OF INCORPORATED TERMS OF CONTRACT OF CARRIAGE

Air transportation provided by AirTran Airways between points in the U.S. (including its overseas territories and possessions) is subject to the carrier's contract of carriage. Customers have the right to inspect the carrier's contract of carriage at the airport, or one may be requested by writing to Consumer Relations Department at the below address.

#### NOTICE OF OVERBOOKING OF FLIGHTS

Airline flights may be overbooked, and there is a slight chance that a seat will not be available on a flight for which a person has a confirmed reservation. If the flight is overbooked, no one will be denied a seat until airline personnel first ask for volunteers willing to give up their reservations in exchange for a payment of the airline's choosing. If there are not enough volunteers, the airline will deny boarding to other persons in accordance with its particular boarding priority. With few exceptions, persons denied boarding involuntarily are entitled to compensation. The complete rules for the payment of compensation and each airline's boarding priorities are available at all airport ticket counters and boarding locations.

#### ONBOARD SERVICE

AirTran Airways serves complimentary coffee, juices, Coca-Cola® products, and snacks on all flights. Cocktails, beer and wine are \$4 on all flights. AirTran Airways does not serve meals.

#### REFUNDS

Passengers entitled to refunds for flight cancellations or other reasons may apply for a refund through any AirTran Airways representative at any AirTran Airways gate, ticket counter, Reservations or Customer Relations office. Refund applications may be accepted in person (at any gate or ticket counter), on the phone (Reservations—800-AIR-TRAN or 770-994-8258 in Atlanta; Customer Relations 866-AIR-CHAT) or by email ("Talk to AirTran Airways" located on the home page of our website, airtran.com). If air transportation on AirTran Airways was paid by a credit card, refunds may be processed by any AirTran Airways representative. If air transportation on AirTran Airways was paid by cash or check, a refund check will be processed by the Refund Desk in Customer Relations. AirTran Airways processes applications for refunds within seven (7) days for credit cards and within twenty (20) days for checks/cash. For more information on refunds, please contact our Refund Desk at 866-5-REFUND.

#### SECURITY

For your safety and protection, all security checks are performed by or are consistent with the Transportation Security Administration (TSA) requirements. As a result, all passengers and their baggage may be inspected in accordance with TSA requirements. We appreciate your patience during these security procedures. It is recommended that passengers proceed through the security checkpoint at least one (1) hour prior to departure time.

## UNACCOMPANIED CHILDREN

Children must be at least five (5) years of age to travel unaccompanied, and may do so on any flight that carries them directly to their destination without a change of aircraft. Any children at least twelve (12) years of age may travel unaccompanied, even if their itinerary involves a change of aircraft. Unaccompanied minors will not be accepted on the last flight of the day. Each unaccompanied child travels at the regular adult fare plus an unaccompanied minor charge of \$25 for nonstop flights and \$40 for connecting flights each way. When making reservations, please advise the Reservations Agent that the booking is for an unaccompanied child. Parent must provide information regarding who will be dropping off and who will be picking up the child at the airport. To ensure a pleasant travel experience, AirTran Airways asks that you have the unaccompanied child check in at the departure gate at least one (1) hour prior to departure. The child will be courtesy-boarded and identified to the Flight Attendant as an unaccompanied child. Those unaccompanied children arriving too late to be courtesy-boarded will be boarded last to ensure identification to the Flight Attendant. The child will be escorted off the aircraft by a Flight Attendant and released to the designee or another designated AirTran Airways Crew Member. AirTran Airways will require the party picking up the unaccompanied child to produce positive identification and sign a release. In some cases, there may be a wait in receiving the child due to AirTran Airways personnel being engaged in the departure of another aircraft. AirTran Airways hopes you will understand the time spent is for the safety of your unaccompanied child.

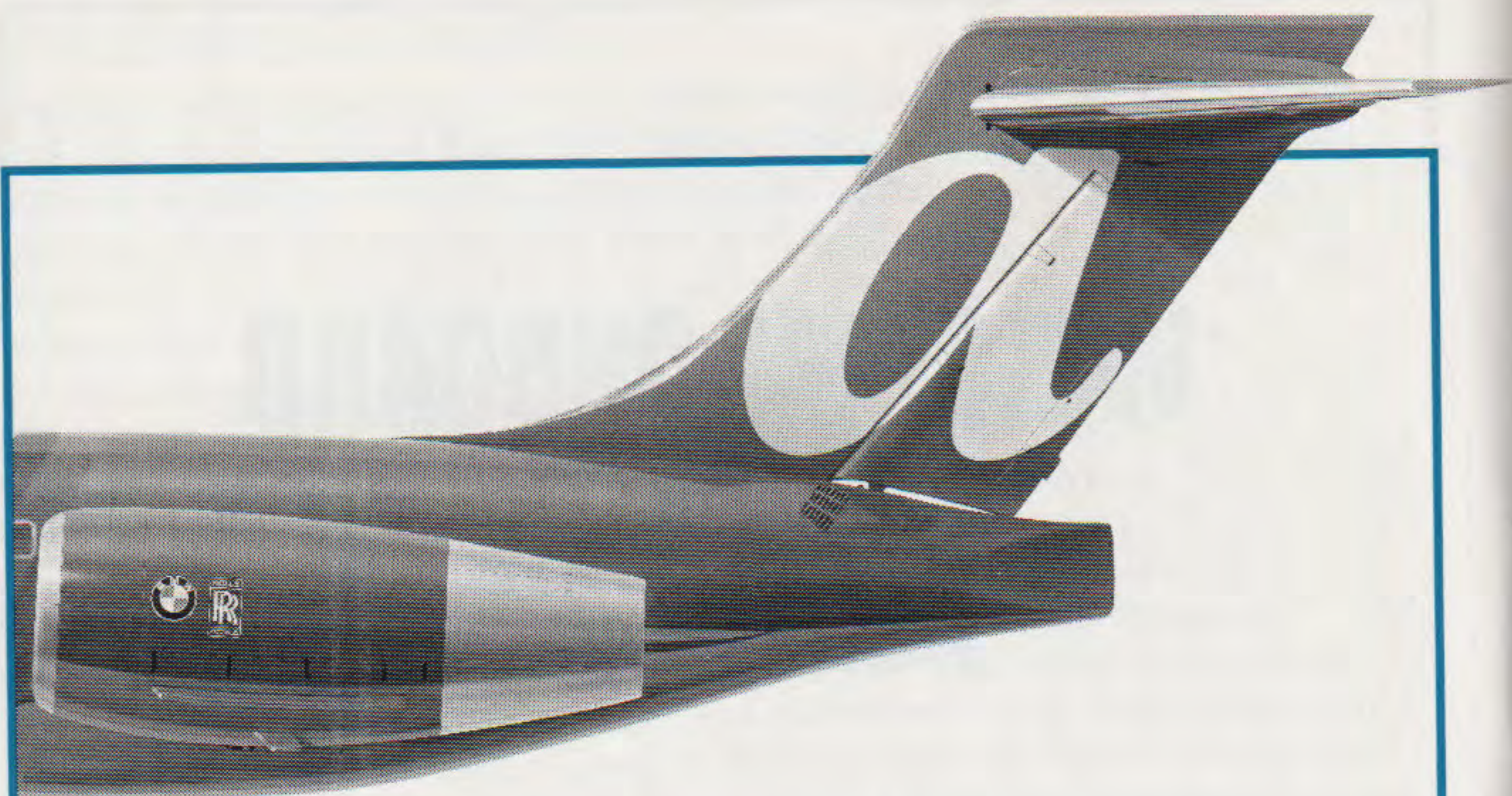
