IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Reservations and Ground Transportation —

Chicago O'Hare Passengers —

Air Wisconsin operates from the "A" Concourse located between Butler Aviation and the International Terminal.

Courtesy Bus Pick-up — Chicago Passengers —

From main terminals at O'Hare call 686-7424 for free pick-up from the lower level to Air Wisconsin ticket and passenger lounge.

Air Wisconsin's arriving flights are met in Chicago by a courtesy bus. Transportation is provided free of charge to all connecting airlines at O'Hare Airport and to the airport bus service for downtown Chicago points.

Detroit Passengers —

Air Wisconsin's ticket counter is located in the North Terminal next to North Central Airlines.

The airport courtesy bus departs every five minutes to all connecting airlines.

Minneapolis/St. Paul Passengers —

Air Wisconsin's ticketing and passenger lounge is located in the Green Concourse, upper level.

Check-in Times for Flights —

In the interest of on-time service to all passengers, Air Wisconsin requests that passengers be at the airport counter 20 minutes prior to published departure time. Reservations not claimed ten minutes prior to scheduled flight time are subject to cancellation.

Re-Confirmation —

Please re-confirm your reservations after a stopover of more than 12 hours. Re-confirmation is necessary at least 6 hours before departure in order to assure your reservation.

Baggage —

Free allowance is 50 pounds including brief case and hand luggage. Excess baggage will be charged for at the rate of 1/2 of 1% of the one way adult fare per pound. The liability of the company for baggage is limited to \$250.00 unless a higher value is declared and additional charges paid therefore in advance.

Air Freight —

Air freight is carried on all flights. Connections are made direct to all carriers. Maximum weight 150 pounds per piece, without prior arrangement. Call your local Air Wisconsin Agent for further information.

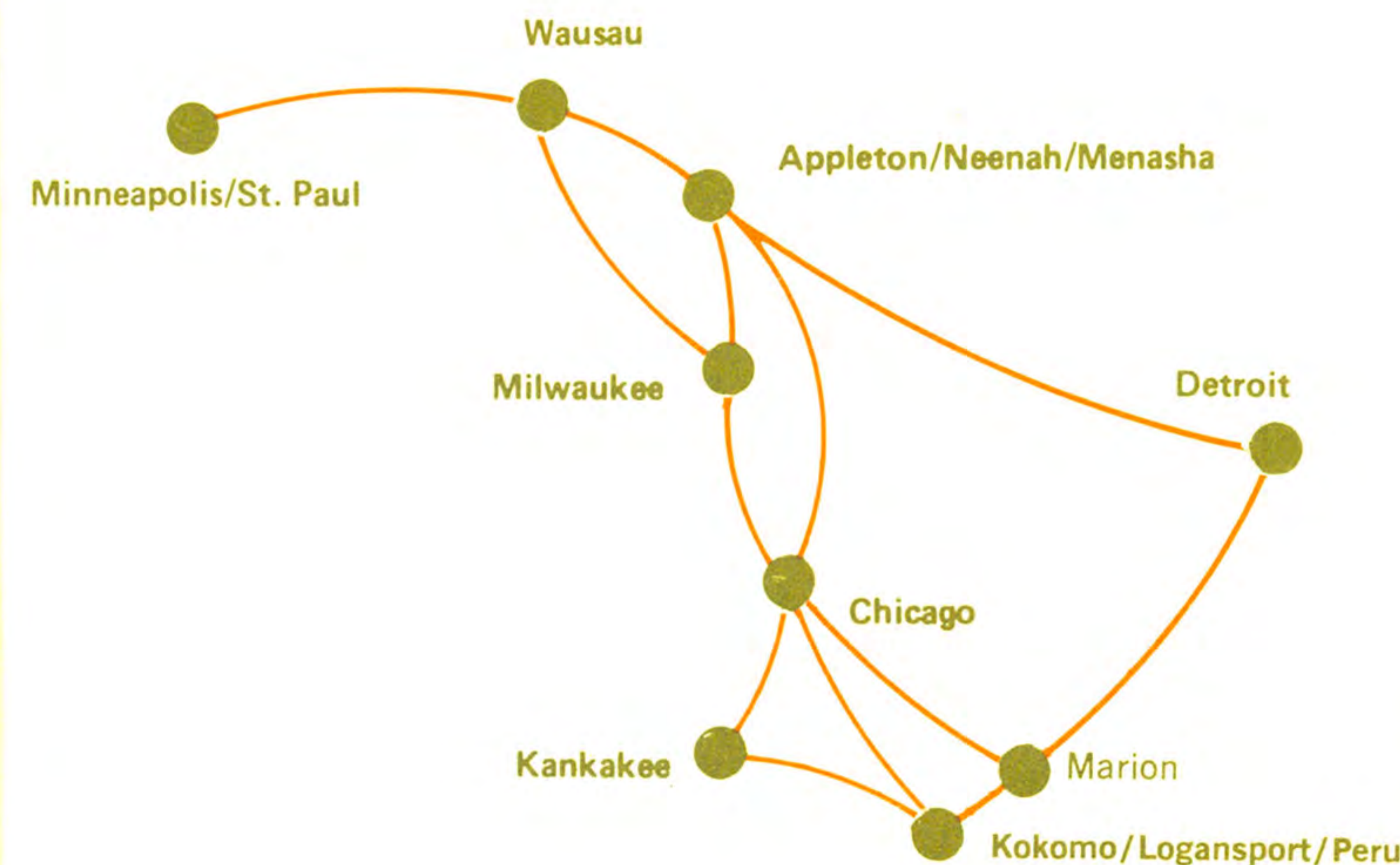
