

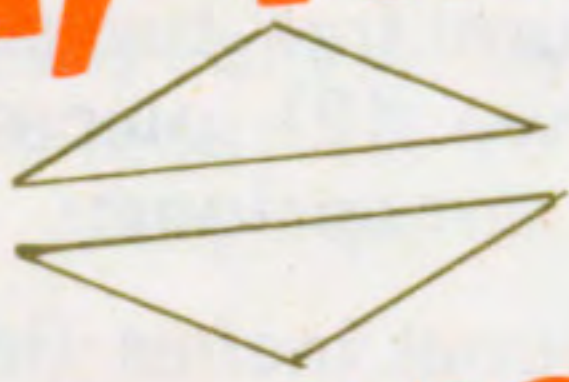

## EXPEDITE YOUR AIR FREIGHT

AIR FREIGHT is carried on all flights. Connections are made direct to all carriers. Freight carried on passenger flights is restricted to a maximum weight of 250 pounds per piece, without prior arrangement. Call your local Air Wisconsin Agent for further information. (See rates inside back cover.)

### WEIGHT LIMITATIONS

Special arrangements will be made for individual pieces weighing in excess of 250 pounds. Lot shipments up to 3,000 pounds can be accommodated on cargo flights.

### DECLARED VALUE

You are allowed \$50.00 free valuation on shipments weighing up to 100 pounds and \$.50 per pound on shipments over 100 pounds. If a higher value is declared on the air bill an additional charge of .15 cents per \$100.00 (or fraction thereof) will be assessed.

### PREPAID OR COLLECT CHARGES

Shipments can be made prepaid or collect and credit arrangements can be made by contacting your local Air Wisconsin office.

### PICK-UP AND DELIVERY SERVICE

Pick-up and delivery service is available at all points served on Air Wisconsin's system and at the final destination of the shipment.

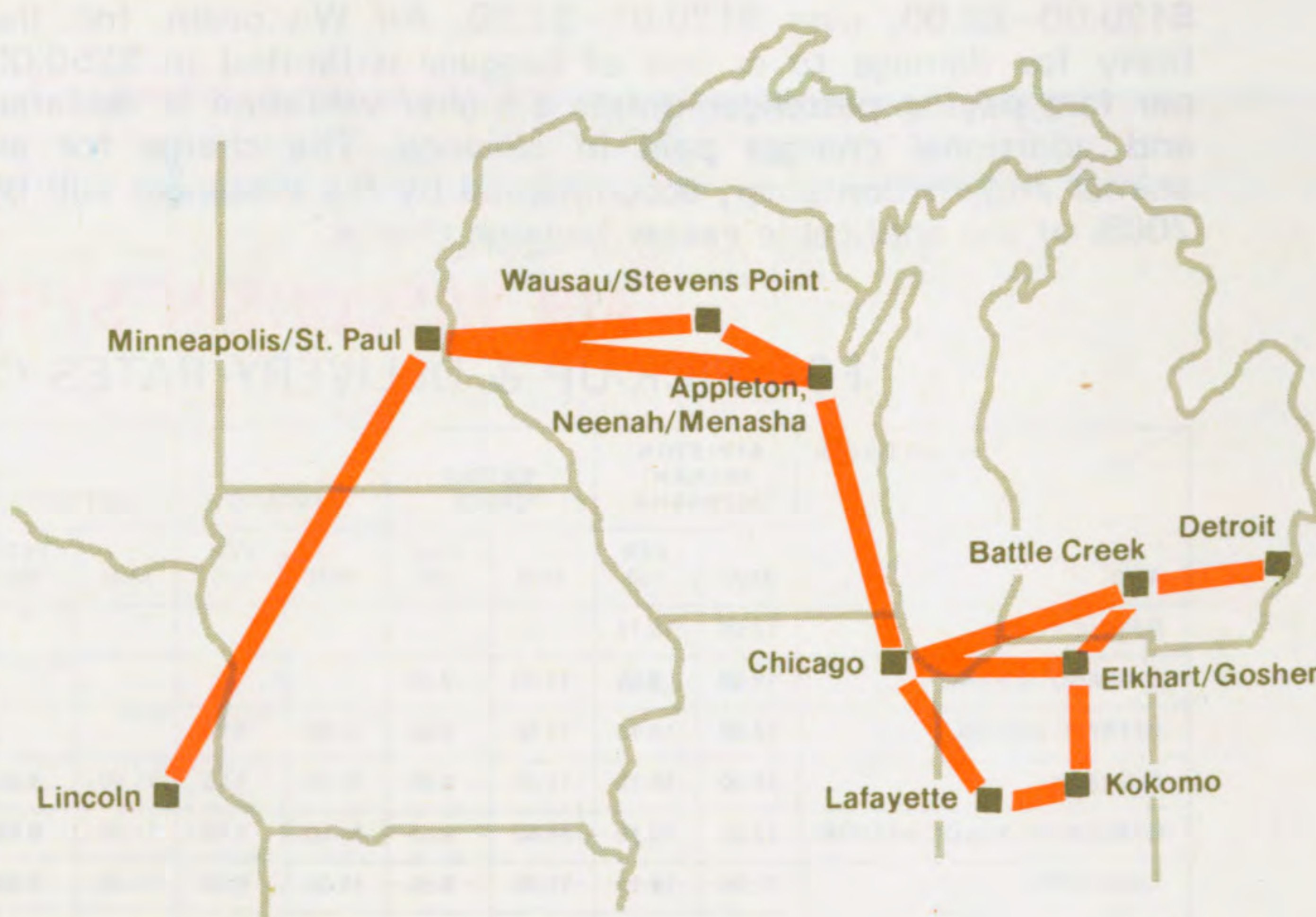

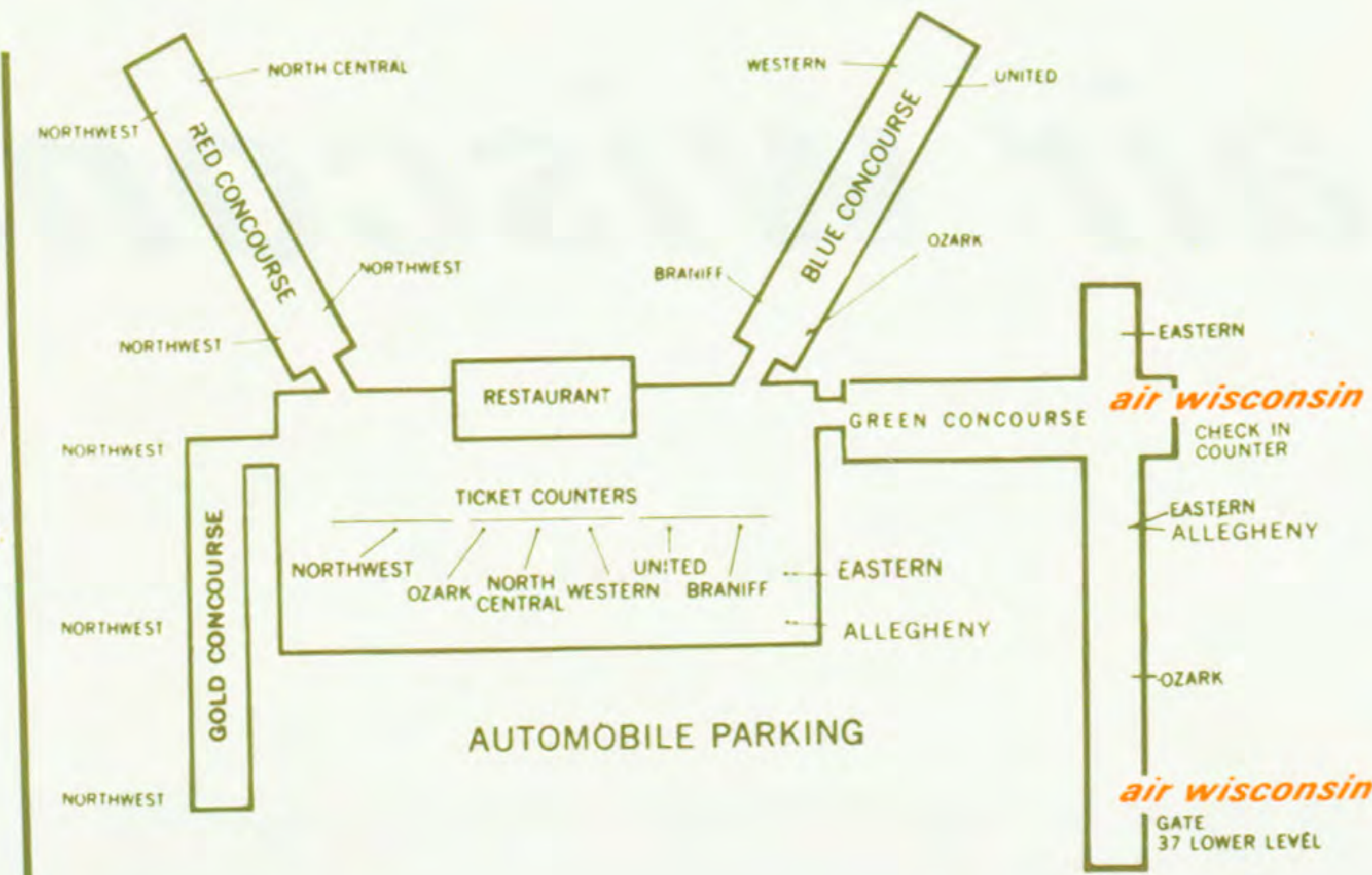




### CHICAGO O'HARE INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT

**Chicago O'Hare Passengers** Air Wisconsin operates from the "A" Concourse located between Butler Aviation and the International Terminal.

**Commuter Airline Terminal Bus**—Air Wisconsin operates continuous free pick-up service to and from all three main O'Hare Terminals. The Commuter Airline Terminal bus loads and unloads at the front of the taxi cab pick-up areas at the (lower ramp level). This bus provides direct service to and from the Air Wisconsin Ticket Counter in the "A" Concourse Commuter Airline Terminal, located between Butler Aviation and the International Terminal. ### MINNEAPOLIS/ST. PAUL INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT

AIR WISCONSIN BAGGAGE CLAIM IS IN MAIN TERMINAL, LOWER LEVEL - AREA NO. 4

Air Wisconsin's ticketing and passenger counter is located between gates 33 & 34 on the green concourse (upper level). Boarding and deplaning is at gate 37 lower level—green concourse.

**Detroit Passengers**—Air Wisconsin's ticketing counter is located in the South Terminal—Northwest Airlines—Gate Number 1, lower level. Baggage claim area is at the Air Wisconsin/Northwest Gate Number 1—South Terminal.

EFFECTIVE JUNE 15, 1975

**Children:** Children under 12 years of age accompanied by a fare-paying passenger at least 12 years of age will be 66 $\frac{2}{3}$ % of the full adult fare. Minimum fare is \$10.00.

**Military Fare Reservation Basis:** Apply all times for military personnel on active duty with proof of authorized leave.

**Check-in Times for Flights**—In the interest of on-time service to all passengers, Air Wisconsin requests that passengers be at the airport counter 20 minutes prior to published departure time. Reservations not claimed ten minutes prior to scheduled flights are subject to cancellation.

**Re-Confirmation**—Please re-confirm your reservation after a stopover of more than 12 hours. Re-confirmation is necessary at least 6 hours before departure in order to assure your reservations.

**Baggage**—The maximum free baggage allowance for fare paying passengers will be two (2) pieces plus one carry-on not to exceed the following dimensions:

- 1st Piece—62 dimensional inches (length & width & height)
- 2nd Piece—55 dimensional inches (length & width & height)
- Carry-on—45 dimensional inches (length & width & height)

Two bags must be checked and the third bag must be carried on board only if it is capable of being stowed under the seat. Total cannot exceed 50 lbs. Bag(s) exceeding the weight limitations will be shipped as Air Freight. Military personnel may check one duffel, sea or B-4 bag in lieu of the 1st piece. Skis, Golf bags and other sporting equipment are included in the per piece rules. **Charges for Excess Pieces** based on the one way unit fare per piece charges will be: \$25.00 or under—\$4.00, \$25.01 through \$50.00—\$5.00, \$50.01 through \$120.00—\$6.00, over \$120.01—\$7.00. Air Wisconsin, Inc. liability for damage to or loss of baggage is limited to \$250.00 per fare paying passenger unless a higher valuation is declared and additional charges paid in advance. The charge for an animal and its container, accompanied by the passenger will be 200% of the applicable excess baggage charge.

If a higher value is declared over the above limit of liability the higher value will be assessed at .20 cents per \$100.00, or fraction thereof—over the lines of Air Wisconsin.

Carrier is not liable for loss, damage to, or delay in the delivery of fragile or perishable articles, money, jewelry, silverware, negotiable papers, securities or other valuables, business documents, or samples or articles not suitable, or not suitably packed, for transportation in aircraft, which are included in the passenger's checked baggage whether with or without the knowledge of carrier.
