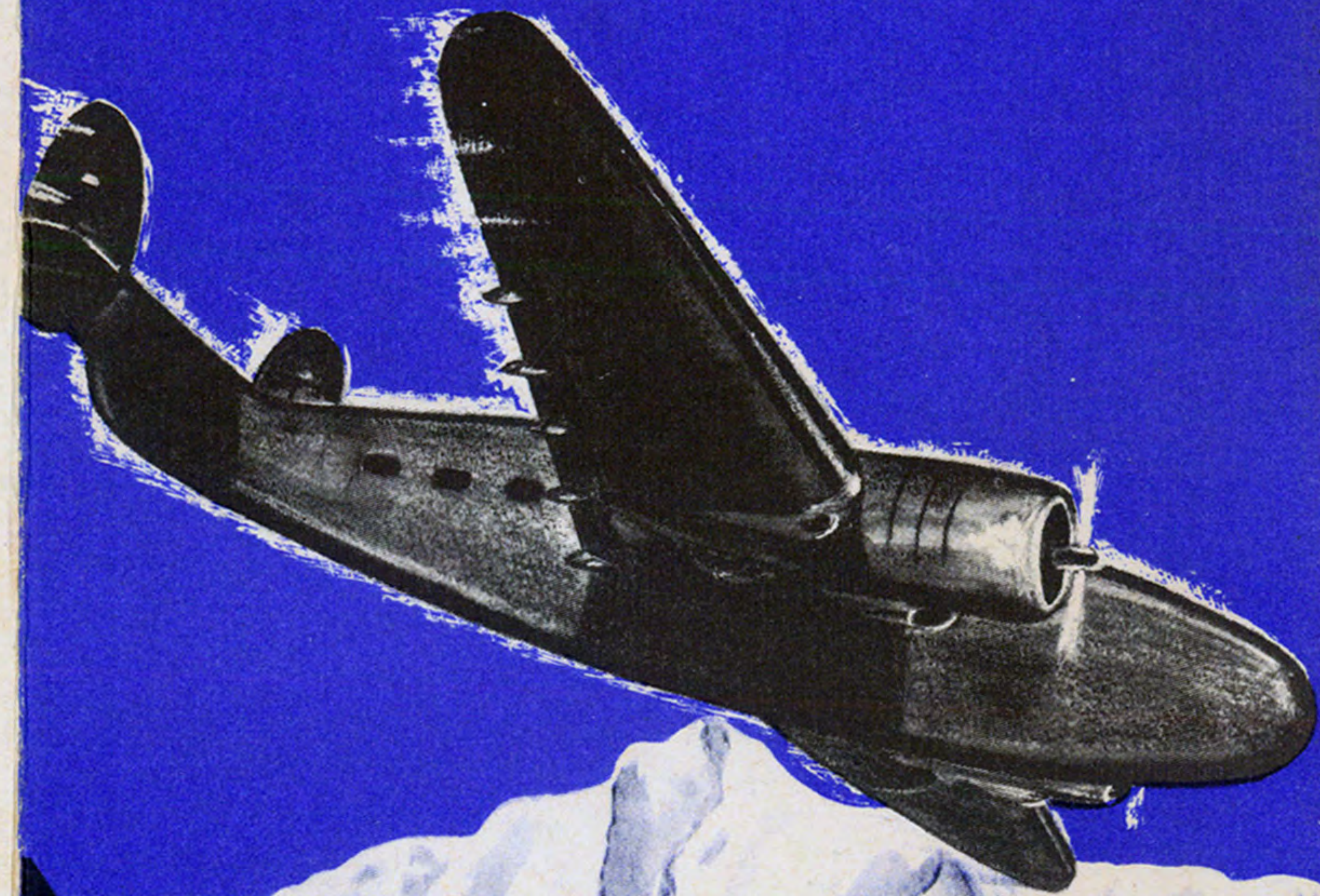

At no time in the history of the Territory of Alaska has there been so much bustling activity as in the past eighteen months. Today, a vital stronghold in our all-out war effort . . . tomorrow, a land of untold opportunity for aggressive post-war development.

Keeping pace with present day air traffic requirements and gearing up for the passenger, mail, express and freight transportation needs of the morrow, ALASKA STAR AIRLINES has vastly increased its facilities—adding eight airplanes to its fleet; two new ground radio communication stations; a new, completely equipped, major overhaul station at Anchorage.

ALASKA STAR AIRLINES, having recently acquired the operation and equipment of

Mirow Air Service, also Pollack Airlines has extended the Nome-Anchorage run 600 miles southeastward to Juneau. A new passenger, mail route has been established between Fairbanks and Kodiak, with daily service to Anchorage, and scheduled service inaugurated between Nome and Fairbanks.

Today, ALASKA STAR activities provide the most comprehensive transportation facilities available in the Alaskan Territory. At this time, ASA's fleet of 34 radio equipped transports maintains scheduled runs between 26 key cities, from which points 63 additional important destinations are quickly accessible via frequent ALASKA STAR operated non-schedule connecting flights. ASA is building today for a brighter tomorrow.

Passenger Information

CHILDREN'S FARES: A child in arms under two years of age will be carried free when accompanied by parent or guardian and provided parent or guardian has paid effective fare.

FREIGHT TARIFF: Freight rates between Anchorage or between any two towns on all routes (except between Fairbanks and the Kuskokwim and Lower Yukon for which consult local agent) are determined by multiplying the existing passenger fare by .005, this equalling cents per pound of freight.

BAGGAGE ALLOWANCE AND EXCESS CHARGES: Baggage in excess of the free allowance permitted by the current regulations of the Carrier will be carried only when the capacity of the aircraft permits and when excess charges shall have been paid. When the one-way value of passage ticket is \$100.00 U. S. Currency or less, 30 pounds of hand baggage will be carried free of charge thereunder; when the one-way value of passage ticket is between \$101.00 and \$200.00 U. S. Currency, inclusive, 40 pounds will be carried free thereunder.

- ‡From Naknek to: Kvichak River Points, Koggiung, Dillingham, Kanakanak, Ekuk, Clarks Points, Egegik, Pilot Point, Ugashik, Tanalian Point.
