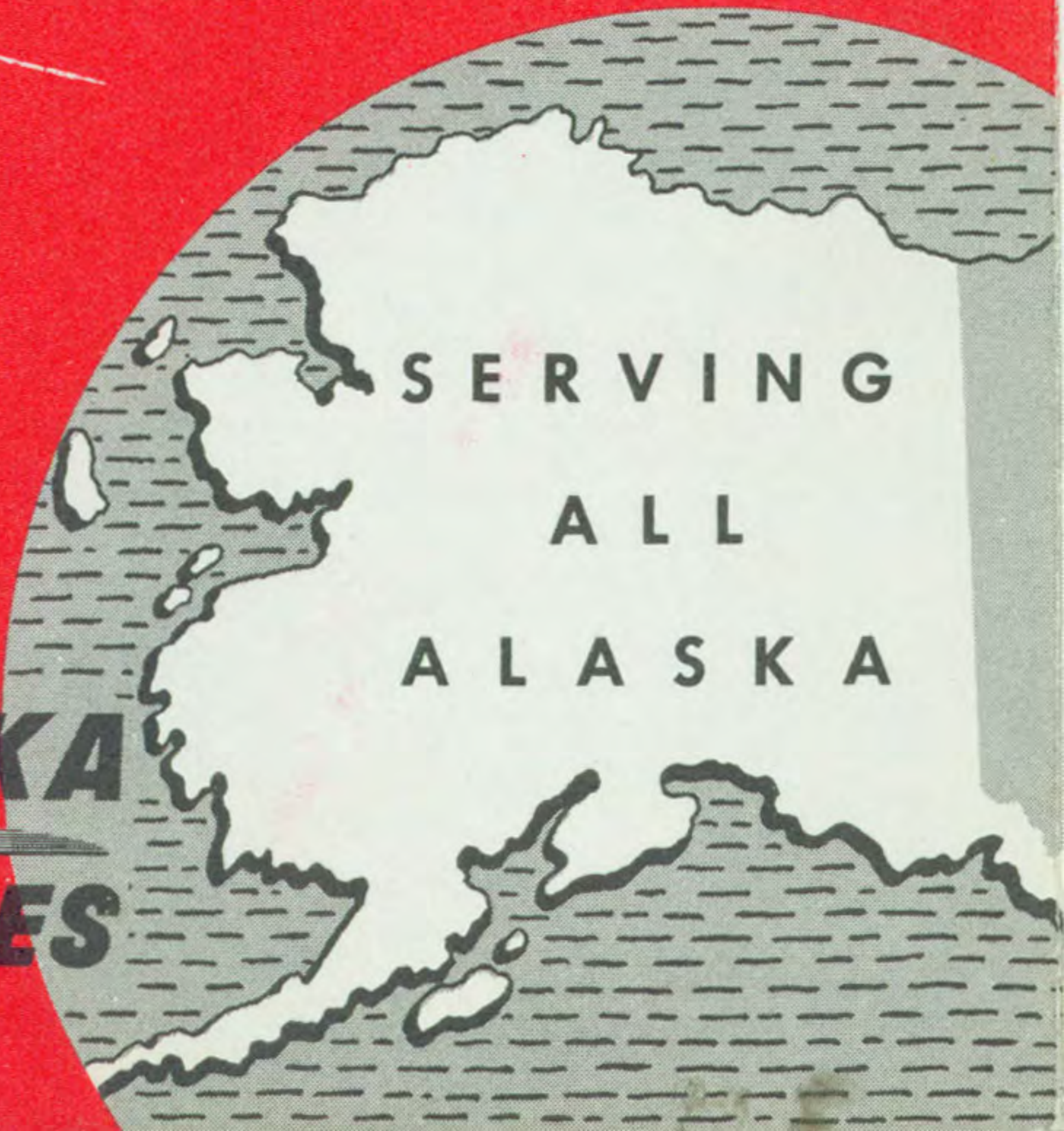

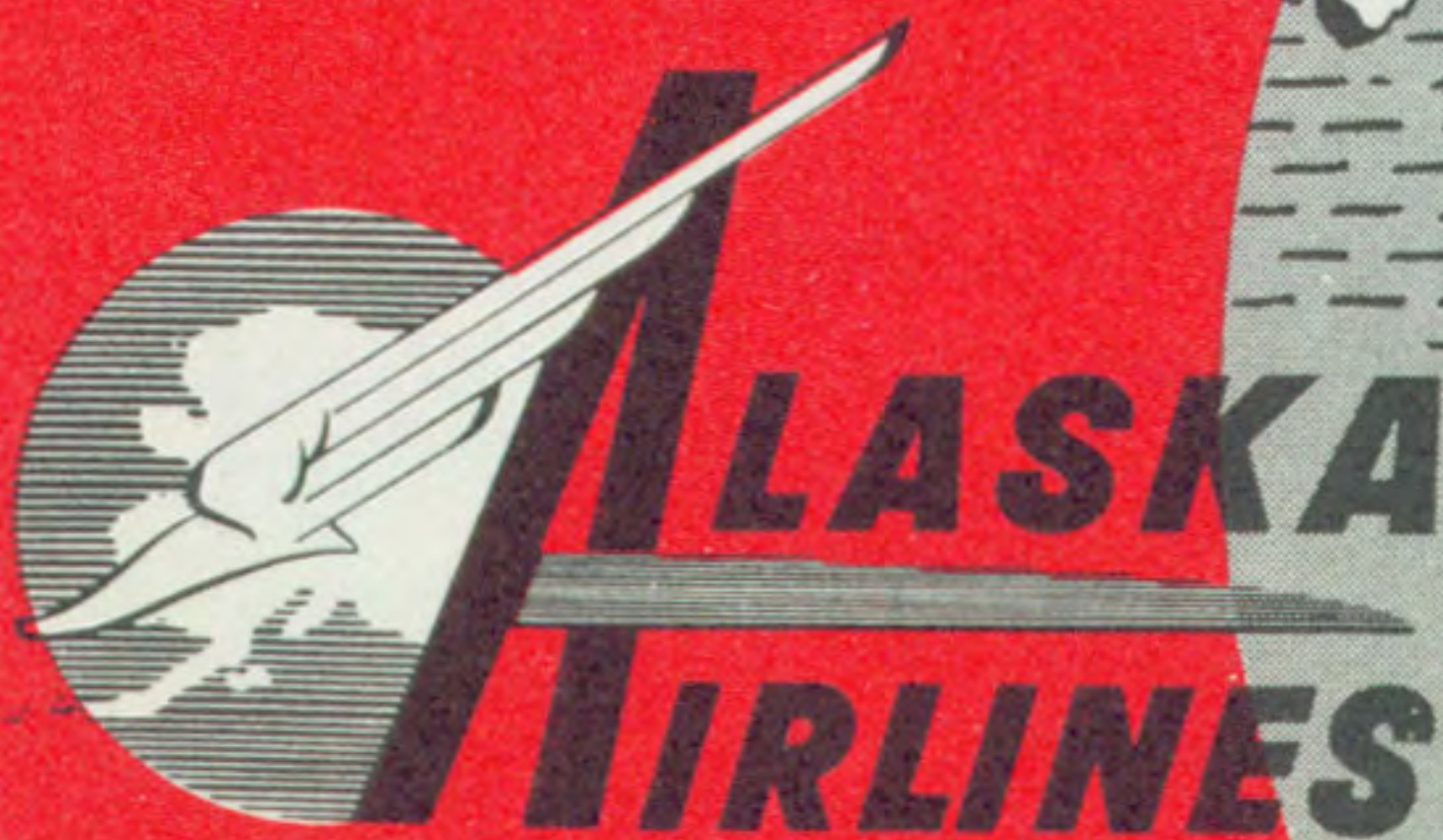

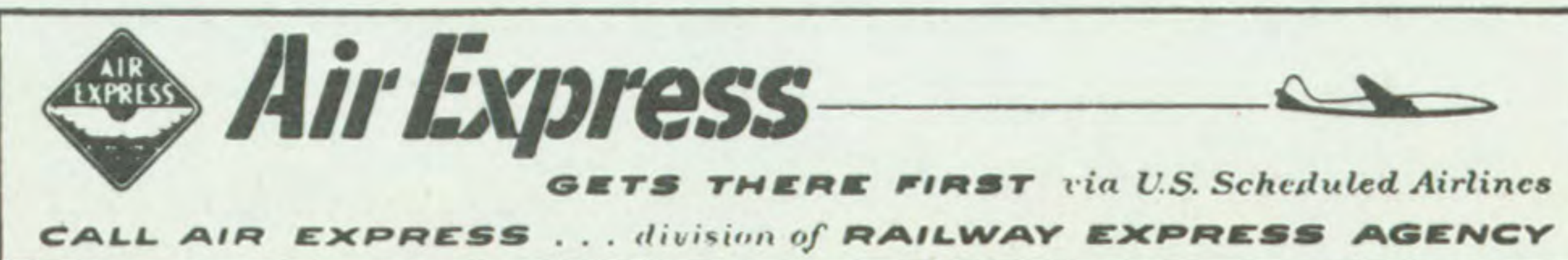

GENERAL INFORMATION

CHILDREN'S FARES—A child in arms under two years of age will be carried free when accompanied by parent or guardian and provided parent or guardian has paid effective fare. Children under 12 years of age one-half fare.

CHARTER RATES—between various points are available. For information, contact your Alaska Airlines office.

BAGGAGE—Fifty-five (55) pounds of baggage will be carried free on each ticket within the Territory of Alaska. Forty (40) pounds allowed on feeder flights. Sixty-six (66) pounds baggage will be carried free on each ticket between Alaska points and the United States and International points. Baggage over the allowable limit will be charged for at the rate per pound of one-half of one percent of the one-way fare with a minimum charge of twenty-five cents.

CHARTER SERVICE — FOUR-ENGINE DC-4 "STARLINERS" — TWIN ENGINE DC-3 AND CURTIS C-46's AS WELL AS SINGLE ENGINE AIRCRAFT ARE AVAILABLE FOR ALL TYPES OF PLEASURE OR BUSINESS TRIPS. FOR INFORMATION CONTACT YOUR NEAREST ALASKA AIRLINES OFFICE.
