# YUKON ADVENTURE

## TOUR OF THE COLORFUL KLONDIKE

Every Monday morning from June through September a magic carpet (in the guise of an Alaska Airlines plane) takes off from Fairbanks for Dawson and adventure—a "Yukon Adventure," unique tour of the colorful Klondike.

Dawson, center of the last great gold rush on this continent, lies at the confluence of the fabled Klondike and the storied Yukon Rivers. Here, 62 years ago, countless determined gold seekers began their quest for riches after months of incredible hardships on the frozen trail. Now it is a ghost town—a gay ghost town—an admirably preserved relic of a gaudier, grimmer and more glamorous day.

You will see Dawson and the famed Bonanza Creek (where it all started) on a sight-seeing trip that also takes you to the top of Midnight Dome, Dawson's mountain backdrop, for one of the grandest panoramas of virgin territory still available to the casual traveler.

After an evening's rest in the Occidental Hotel, historic pride of Western Canada, you will board Cloud 9, a rubber raft, to begin a hundred mile journey through a primitive wonderland—and all in absolute comfort, all in absolute safety. There will be overnight stops on the relaxing float down the smooth-flowing Yukon at Forty Mile and at Red Creek Camps. Forty Mile was a settlement when Dawson was a barren plain. Left for you to explore are the log buildings and their contents, abandoned in haste when the cry of gold echoed along the river.

On your journey there are scenes of unrivaled splendor, glimpses of wild life and visits with pioneers who survive from the days of old. The two and one-half day float trip



will bring you to Eagle, Alaska, whence you will take a bus journey through the scenic Forty Mile and American Rivers country and along the last stage of the Alaska Highway to return to Fairbanks, refreshed, invigorated, awed and exultant.

A guided tour of Fairbanks and a visit to the nearby University of Alaska's museum, a storehouse of Alaskan, old and new, will complete your "Yukon Adventure"—the vacation of a lifetime.

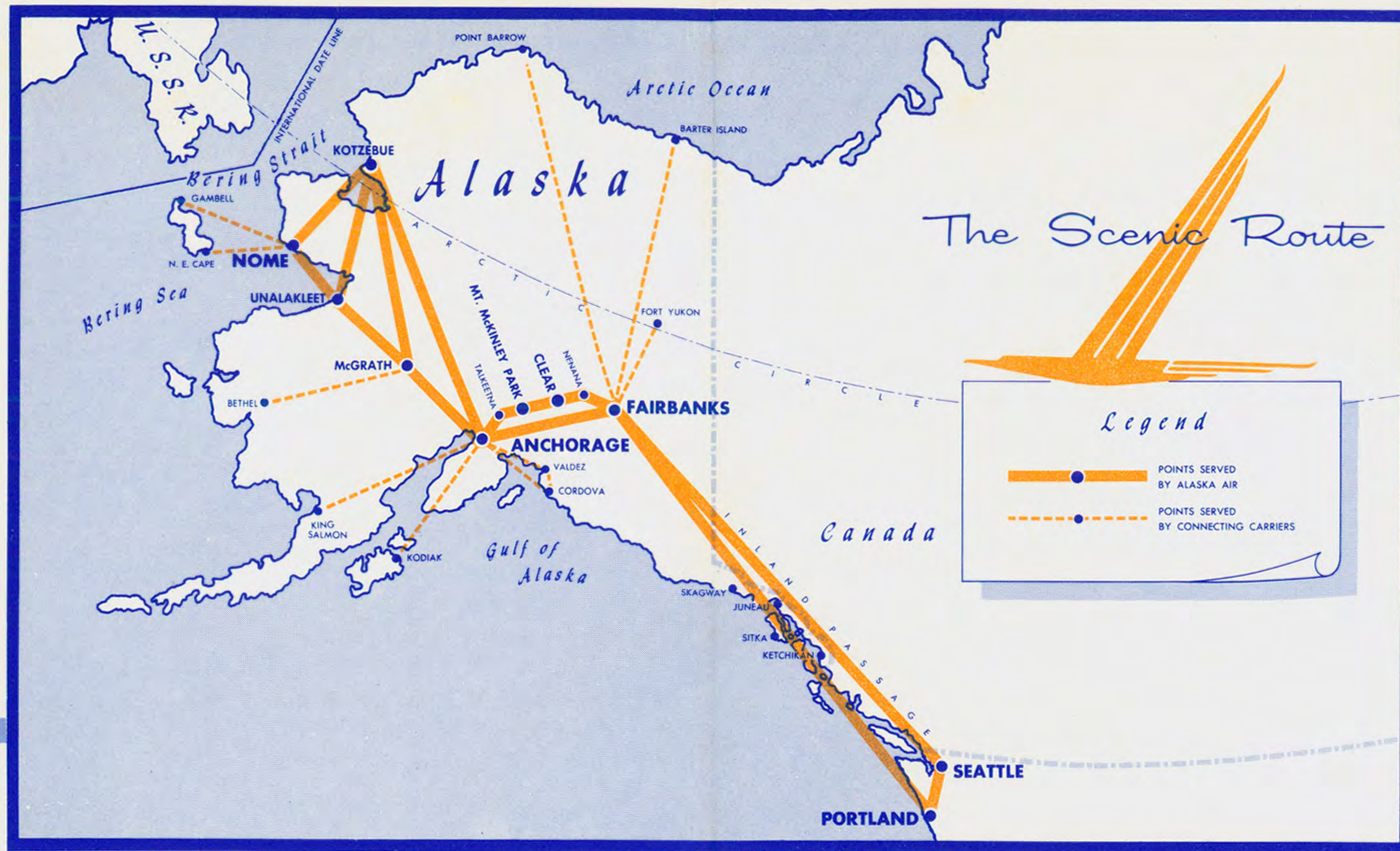
