# GENERAL INFORMATION

**AIR EXPRESS AND AIR FREIGHT RATES**—Contact your nearest Alaska Airlines office or Air Express Division, Railway Express agent for information.

**GROUP FARES** are available for groups of ten or more between Seattle and Fairbanks between Seattle and Anchorage and between Anchorage and Fairbanks/Kotzebue/McGrath/Nome/Unalakleet at savings from 25% to 30%.

**EXCURSION FARES**—Special excursion fares are available at savings from 25% to 33 1/8% applying between Seattle and Fairbanks, and between Anchorage and Fairbanks/ Nome/Kotzebue.

**CHILDREN'S FARES**—A child in arms under two years of age will be carried free when accompanied by parent or guardian and provided parent or guardian has paid effective fare. Children under 12 years of age one-half fare.

**BAGGAGE**—Sixty-six (66) pounds baggage will be carried free on each ticket between Alaska points and points outside Alaska. Forty (40) pounds of baggage will be carried free on each ticket within Alaska. Baggage over the allowable limit will be charged for at the rate per pound of one-half of one percent on the one-way fare with a minimum charge of twenty-five cents. Alaska Airlines liability for any personal property, including baggage whether or not checked or otherwise delivered into the custody of Carrier, is limited to \$100 for each passenger unless a higher valuation is declared and the additional charges required therefor paid before the transportation by air commences.

**SELL AND REPORT:** All authorized agents and scheduled airlines may immediately confirm reservations for travel on all Alaska Airlines flights for parties of 3 or less up to 24 hours prior to departure, by reporting sales to the nearest office of the connecting carrier or to the nearest Alaska Airlines office.

**FAMILY PLAN FARES** are effective January thru April. You buy a full-fare ticket and your spouse and/or all your children from 12 thru 21 fly at only two-thirds of the normal fare. Family fares apply between Fairbanks/Seattle and between Anchorage/Seattle.

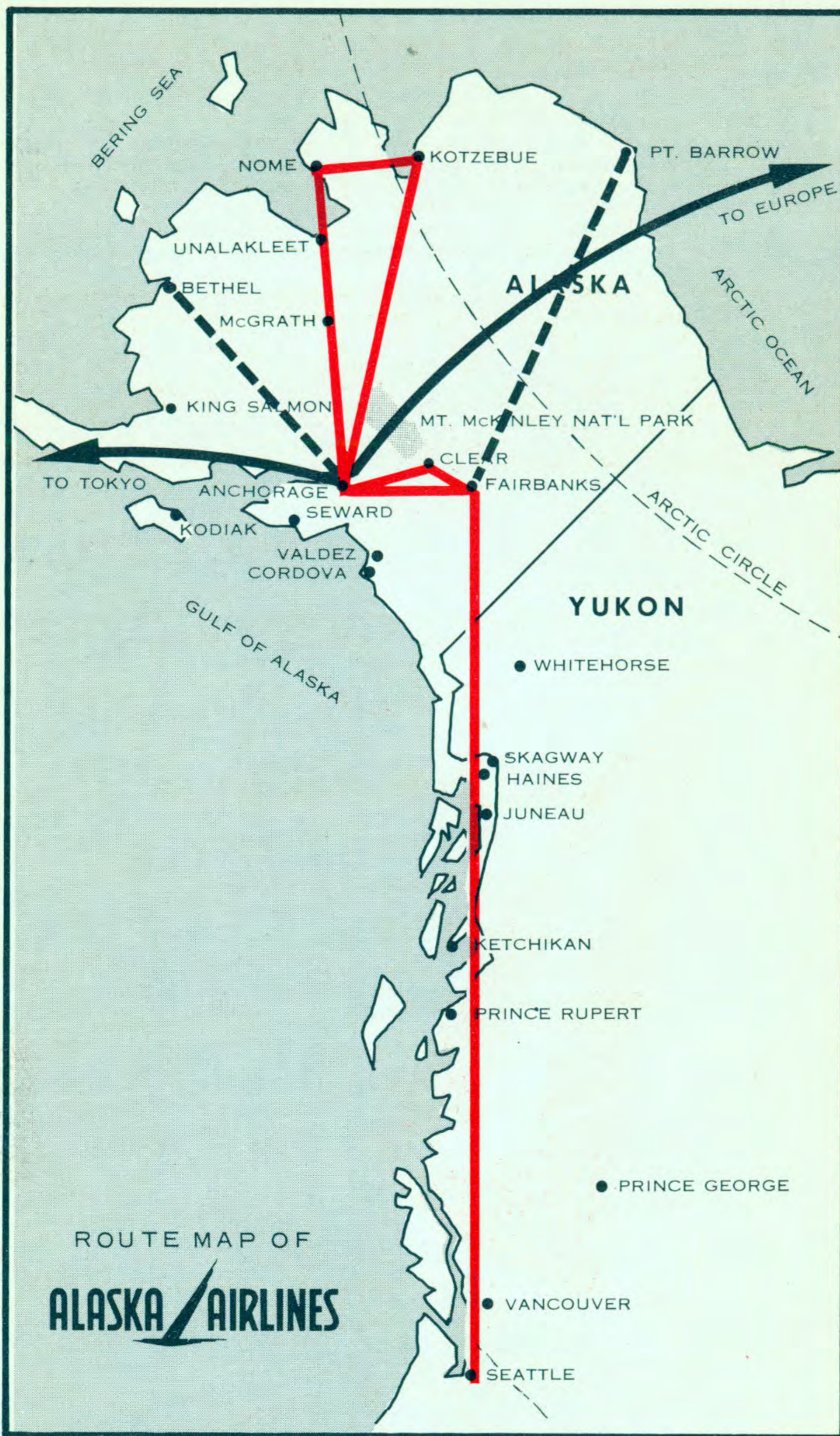
