GENERAL INFORMATION

BAGGAGE ALLOWANCE-New liberalized baggage allowance eliminates former weight limitations and allows checking of two bags per passenger (subject to size limitations). New allowance also provides for carry-on luggage with size limitations capable of being stowed under the seat. Lower rates also apply per piece of baggage in excess of free allowance.

CHILDRENS FARES-A child in arms under two years of age not occupying a seat will be carried free when accompanied by parent or guardian and provided parent or guardian has paid effective fare. Children between 2 and 12 years of age may travel at one-half the normal fare.

CLERGY FARES-A minister of religion may travel between most Alaska Airlines mainline points at half of the regular fares after purchasing a clergy identification card through the Airlines Clergy Bureau, Sacramento, California, or if in possession of an identification card issued by Air West or Frontier Airlines. Travel is on a space available basis, however, once travel has commenced, clergy passengers will not be removed at intermediate points. Ask your travel agent or Alaska Airlines for complete details.

DISCOUNT 50 - AIR TRAVEL U.S.A. Persons residing outside the Western Hemisphere may upon presenting proof of such residency purchase air travel at 50% of the regular round trip fare. The minimum adult fare is \$79.00 and minimum child's fare is \$40.00. This program is available over the routes of Alaska Airlines and via the majority of air carriers operating within the continental U.S.A. Ask your travel agent or Alaska Airlines for complete details.

FAMILY PLAN FARES - From October through April families traveling together can take advantage of big savings. Alaska Airlines family plan ap-

plies on all day-time flights any day of the week between Seattle and Sitka, Juneau, Cordova, Yakutat, Anchorage or Fairbanks. The head of the family pays the full round trip fare, spouse travels at 1/4 discount, and children 12 through 21 fly at 1/3 discount.

MILITARY STANDBY FARES-Members of our military service on furlough, leave or within 7 days from date of discharge, traveling in uniform, at their own expense may receive a 50% discount between most Alaska Airlines mainline points. Reservations will not be made but once the military passenger is enplaned, he will not be removed from the flight except to accommodate passengers holding confirmed reservations. When on authorized emergency leave, positive transportation with advance reservations will be permitted. Ask your Alaska Airlines agent for complete details.

VISIT U.S.A.-Persons residing more than 100 miles beyond any state in the U.S. may purchase 21 days of air transportation permitting unlimited travel throughout the Continental United States and Alaska for \$150. Children between 2 and 21 years of age pay one-half of this amount. Unlimited travel may be over all Alaska Airlines large aircraft routes and via the majority of local service carriers reaching into every area of the U.S. **YOUNG ADULT FARES**-Young adults 12 through 21 years of age may travel between many Alaska Airlines mainline points on a space available basis at a 40% discount from normal fares. Reservations will not be made but once the young adult is boarded he will not be removed from the flight except to accommodate passengers holding previously confirmed reservations. Alaska Airlines will accept as proof of age either a driver's license, birth certificate or a valid young adult I.D. card of any other airline.
