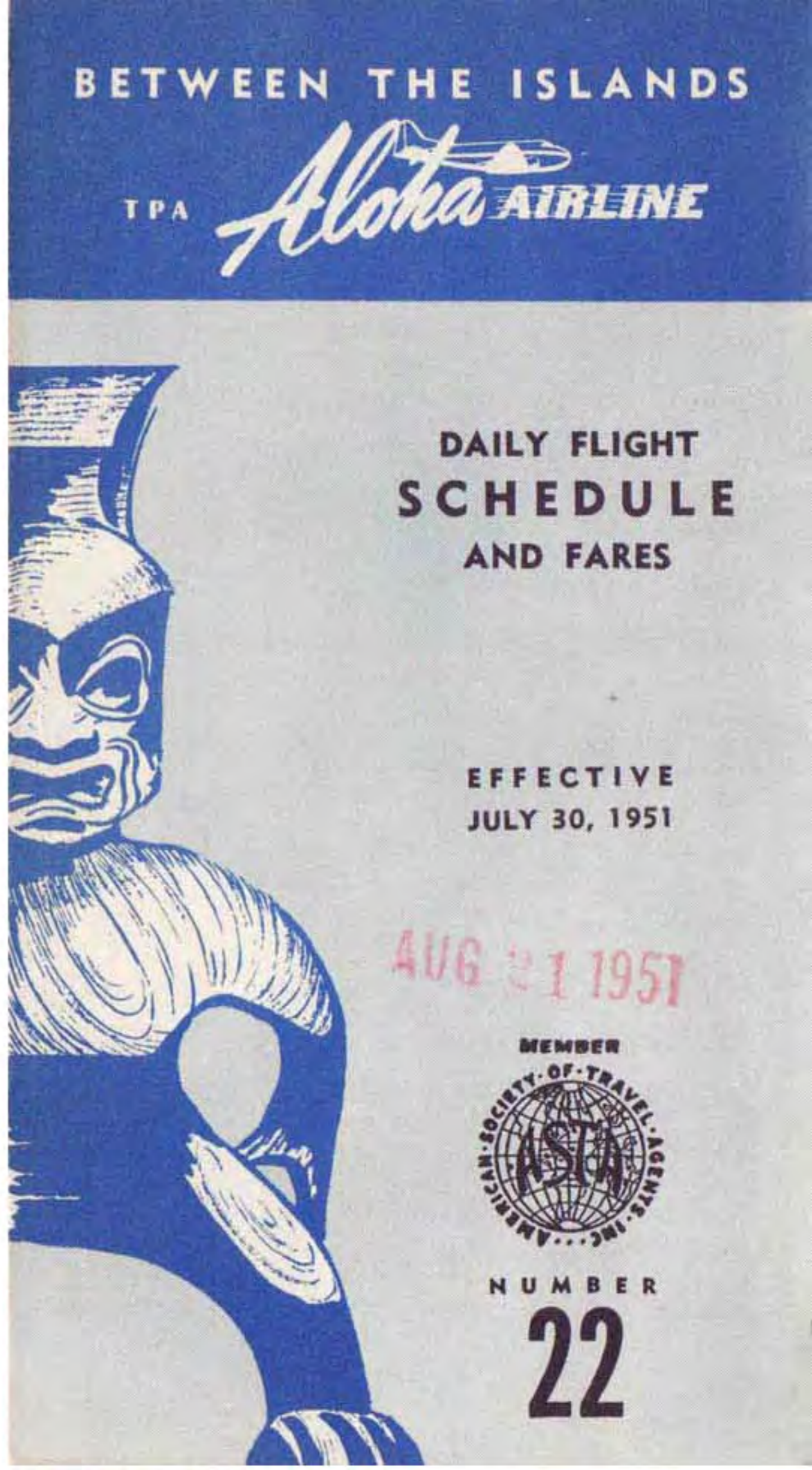

# Valuable Information

**AIR EXPRESS**—All ALOHALINER flights carry Air Express. Pickup and delivery service available. Air Express is fast. Call nearest ALOHA AIRLINE office for rates and other information.

**AIR MAIL**—TPA ALOHALINERS carry Air Mail and Air Parcel Post between the Islands.

**AIRPORT FACILITIES**—The ALOHA AIRLINE is only airline flying in the Islands which accommodates passengers through luxurious Overseas Terminal at Honolulu International Airport. Modern terminal facilities are maintained on neighbor Islands by the Territory.

**BAGGAGE**—Each ALOHALINER passenger is allowed 40 pounds free baggage. Excess baggage accepted, space and weight permitting, at Air Express rates. Mainland bound passengers permitted 66 pounds.

**CHILDREN**—Children under 12 years of age are charged one-half the adult fare, except that one child under 2 years of age, not occupying a seat, may be carried free with each accompanying full-fare passenger. ALOHALINER stewardesses cheerfully help parents with children.

**EQUIPMENT**—All flights are operated with latest type Douglas DC-3 28-passenger ALOHALINERS. TPA ALOHALINERS are specially equipped with tropic-tailored ventilation, providing complete change of fresh air in cabin every 60 seconds. All aircraft maintained and inspected daily under strict Civil Aeronautics Administration rules.

**FRAGILE & PERISHABLE ARTICLES**—These are carried at risk of passenger. Passengers are warned not to pack acids, matches, lighter fluid, liquids and other hazardous articles in baggage.

**GROUND TRANSPORTATION**—Independently operated ground transportation is available at reasonable rates at all points served by the ALOHA AIRLINE. Ground transportation including U-drive cars may be arranged in advance when you make flight reservation. Hotel reservations similarly may be arranged for you by TPA at no extra cost.

**PETS**—Animals will be carried only subject to weight limitation of 45 pounds including weight of suitable container, and only as excess baggage at owner's risk and subject to tariff regulations.

**STOP-OVERS**—Stop-overs allowed at any regular stop provided a reservation is made accordingly. There is no extra charge.

**TERMINAL REPORTING TIME**—In the interest of on-time service, passengers are requested to check in at airport 15 minutes before published departure time, and may be refused passage if arriving less than five minutes before departure time.

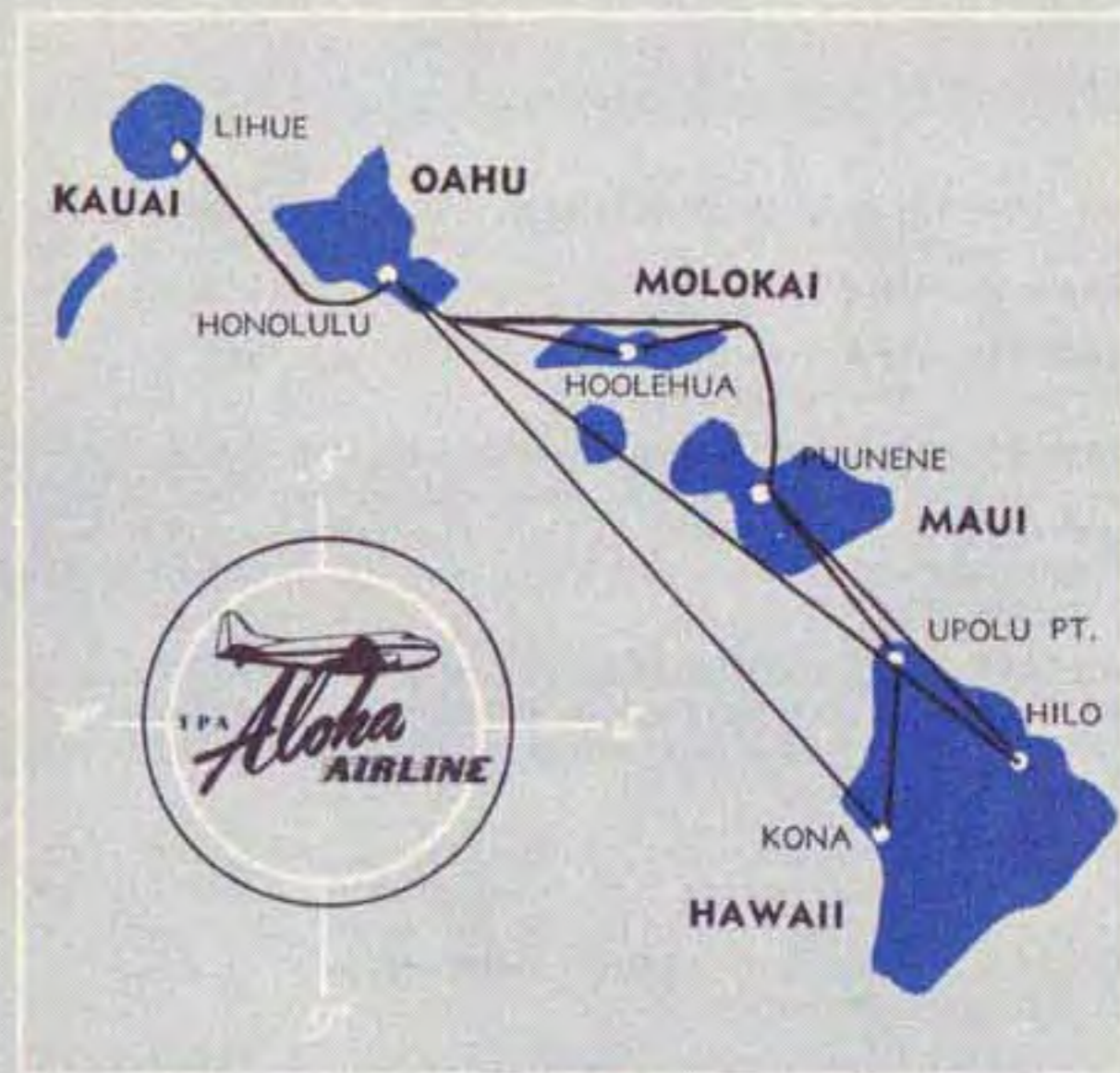
