## AIR MAIL INFORMATION

**AIR MAIL POSTAGE**—Eight cents (8c) first ounce and thirteen cents (13c) each additional ounce to any point in the United States.

**AIR MAIL ENVELOPES**—(Red, white and blue) Special envelopes not necessary, but if not used be sure to mark envelope on face plainly, "AIR MAIL," or use air mail sticker.

**AIR MAIL DEPOSITED CONVENIENTLY**—Air Mail can be deposited in any mail box, letter chute in buildings, main post office or branch office. If collection time is not shown on box or chute, call the post office.

**AIR MAIL REGISTERED, INSURED, C.O.D. OR SPECIAL DELIVERY**—Air Mail can be registered, sent Special Delivery, C.O.D., or insured, just the same as ordinary mail.

**PACKAGES BY AIR MAIL**—Packages can be sent by Air Mail the same as letters, providing they do not weigh more than 70 pounds or measure more than 100 inches combined length and girth.

**PREFERENCE GIVEN AIR MAIL**—U. S. Post Office Department order issued November 9, 1928, reads:—"Air Mail must be given special attention and must not, under any circumstances, be handled as ordinary mail."

**AIR MAIL TO CITIES NOT ON AIR LINES**—Air Mail can be sent to or from cities that are not located on Air Mail lines. In such cases the mail is carried by ordinary means to or from the nearest Air Mail station. Follow usual procedure and mark envelope plainly "Air Mail."

**AIR MAIL TO FOREIGN COUNTRIES**—The rate to Canada and Newfoundland is 8c for the first ounce and 13c for each additional ounce. The rate to Mexico is 10c for each half ounce or fraction. For rates to other countries call the post office.

## GENERAL INFORMATION

**ADJUSTMENT OF FARES**—In case of dispute with ticket agents, pay fare required, take receipt and communicate with the General Traffic Manager.

**ANIMALS**—Animals and birds will not be carried unless special arrangements have been made in advance for shipment via General Air Express.

**BAGGAGE**—Thirty (30) pounds of baggage will be carried free on any ticket. Excess baggage carried upon special arrangements and shall be at the rate per pound of one-half of one per cent. of the published air passenger fare, with a minimum charge of twenty-five cents, and the liability of the Carrier for loss of or damage to baggage and/or personal property is limited to the amount of One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) unless a higher valuation be declared and an additional charge paid therefor. Excess valuation limited to \$1000.00 on each full fare ticket.

**CHILDREN**—Children under two years of age, when held in arms of parent or guardian, carried free. Children over two years of age will be charged full fare.

**COMFORT FACILITIES**—Comfort facilities are available on most American Airways planes and at all airports.

**COMPLAINTS**—Complaints, or suggestions for the betterment of the service, should be addressed to the General Traffic Manager, American Airways, Inc., 4848 West Sixty-third St., Chicago, Ill.

**DINING SERVICE**—Schedules have been so arranged that meals may be secured at points where adequate facilities are available. American Airways endeavors to see that these are palatable and that costs are reasonable.

**INSURANCE**—Trip insurance is available at all airports.

**PASSAGE, CANCELLATION BY COMPANY**—The company reserves the right to cancel bookings before passage or en route. Pilot may remove passengers from plane at any point on the route for safety or other cause. In all events the passenger's sole recourse shall be recovery of that portion of the fare equal to the distance untraveled.

**PASSAGE, CANCELLATION BY PASSENGER**—The Purchaser may receive refund for passage if cancelled two hours prior to flight.

**PASSAGE, REFUSAL OF**—The person in charge at any point of departure or the Pilot may refuse to carry any holder of a ticket, whenever he believes the proposed passenger is suffering from permanent or temporary disability, which wholly in the discretion of such Manager or Pilot, might jeopardize the safety of such passenger or the plane. In any such case the passenger shall be entitled to the return of the price of the ticket but no other damages.

**RADIO**—All passenger planes are equipped with the best radio equipment available.

**REFUNDS**—Requests for refunds on tickets should be addressed to the Auditor of Ticket Accounts, American Airways, Inc., 4848 West Sixty-third St., Chicago, Ill.

**RESERVATIONS**—All seats are reserved. Reservation will not be made except upon payment of fare.

**ROUND-TRIP FARES**—10% discount from twice one-way fares on round-trip tickets when purchased in advance. Return trip must be made to point of origin, but the discount is also granted on return trip tickets to point of origin via alternate routes at the sum of total fares on the routes traveled. Return trip must be started within sixty days.
