

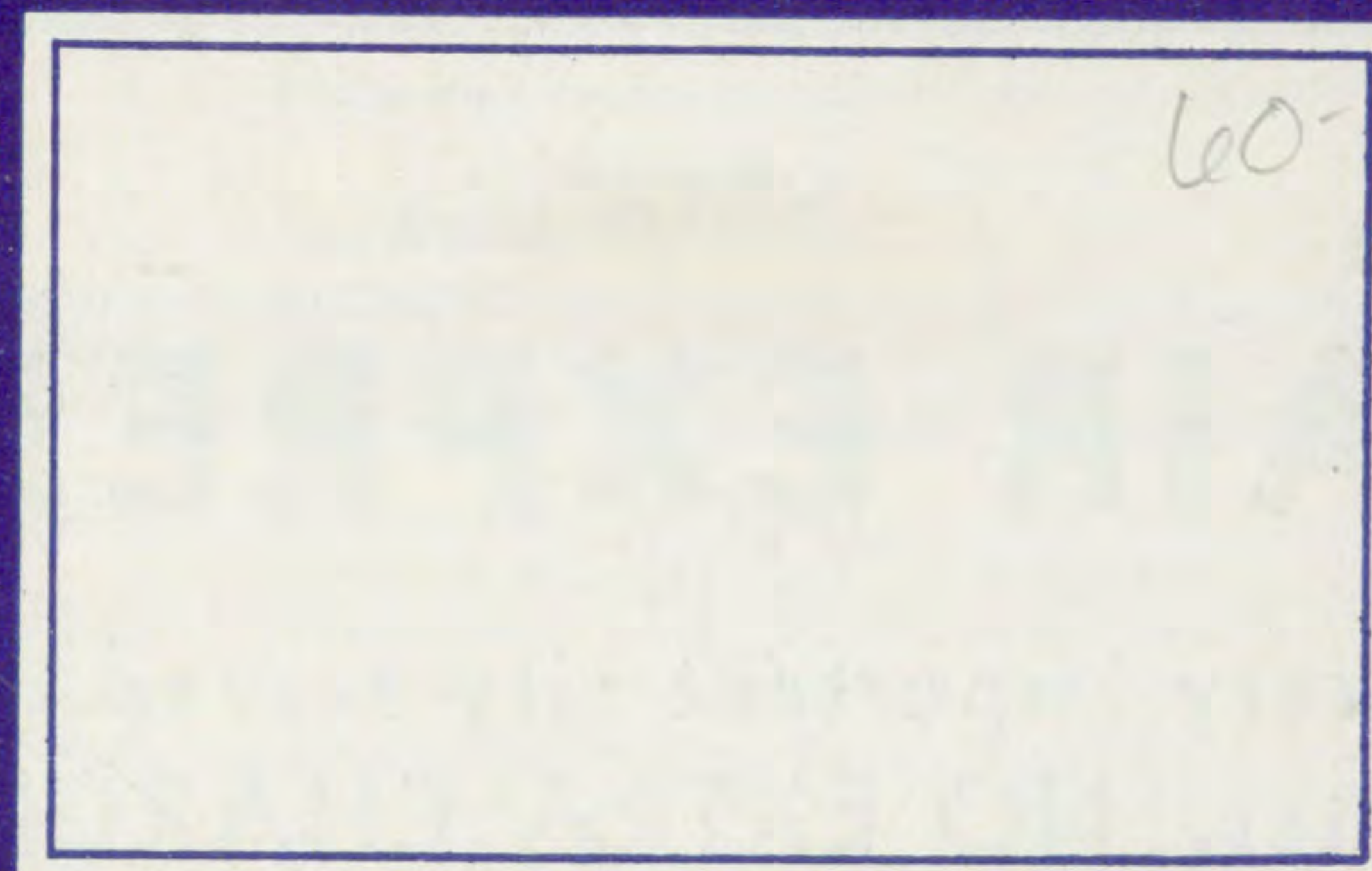

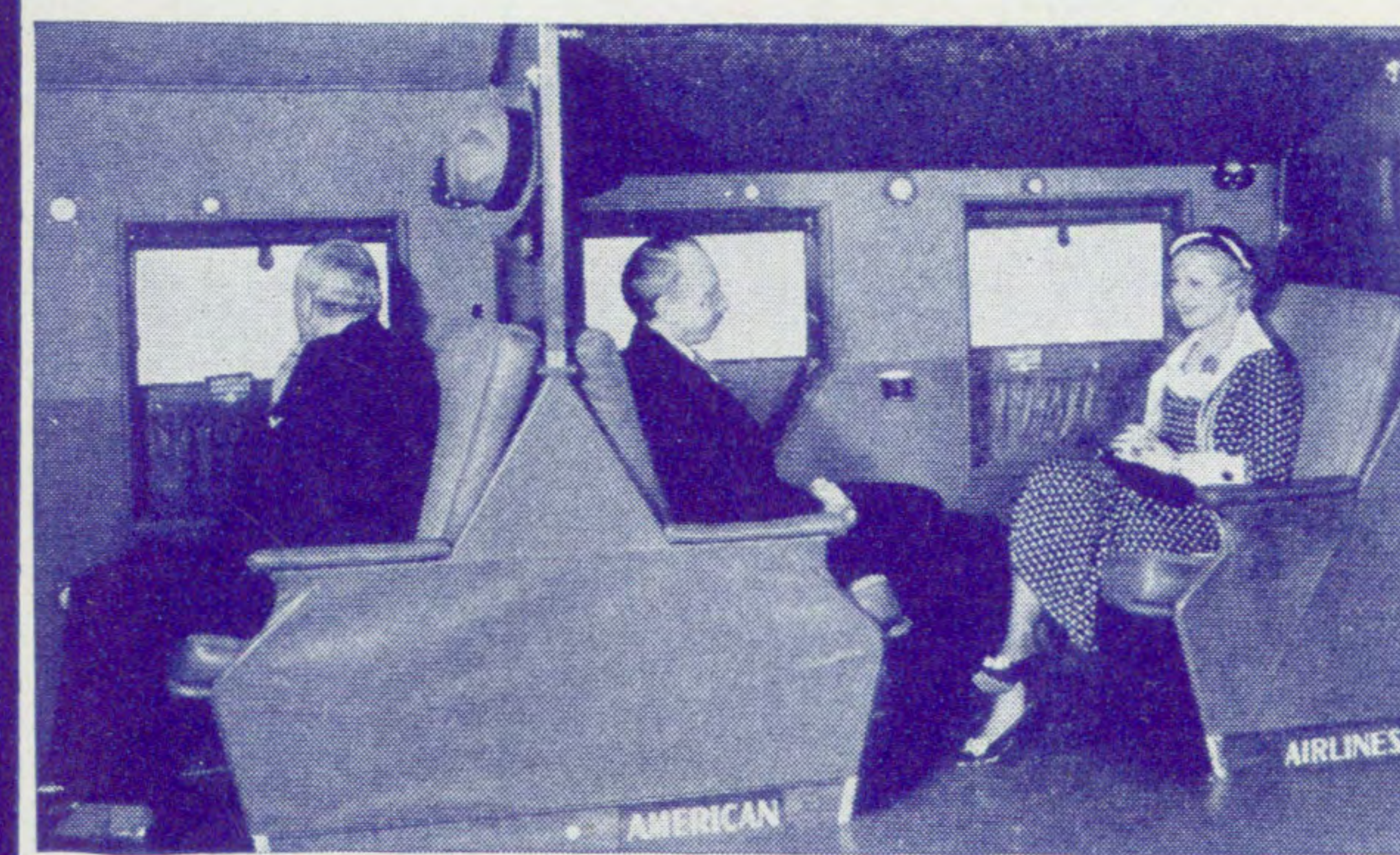

The full length, comfortable berths, comparable in every respect with those of deluxe sleeping cars, are made up

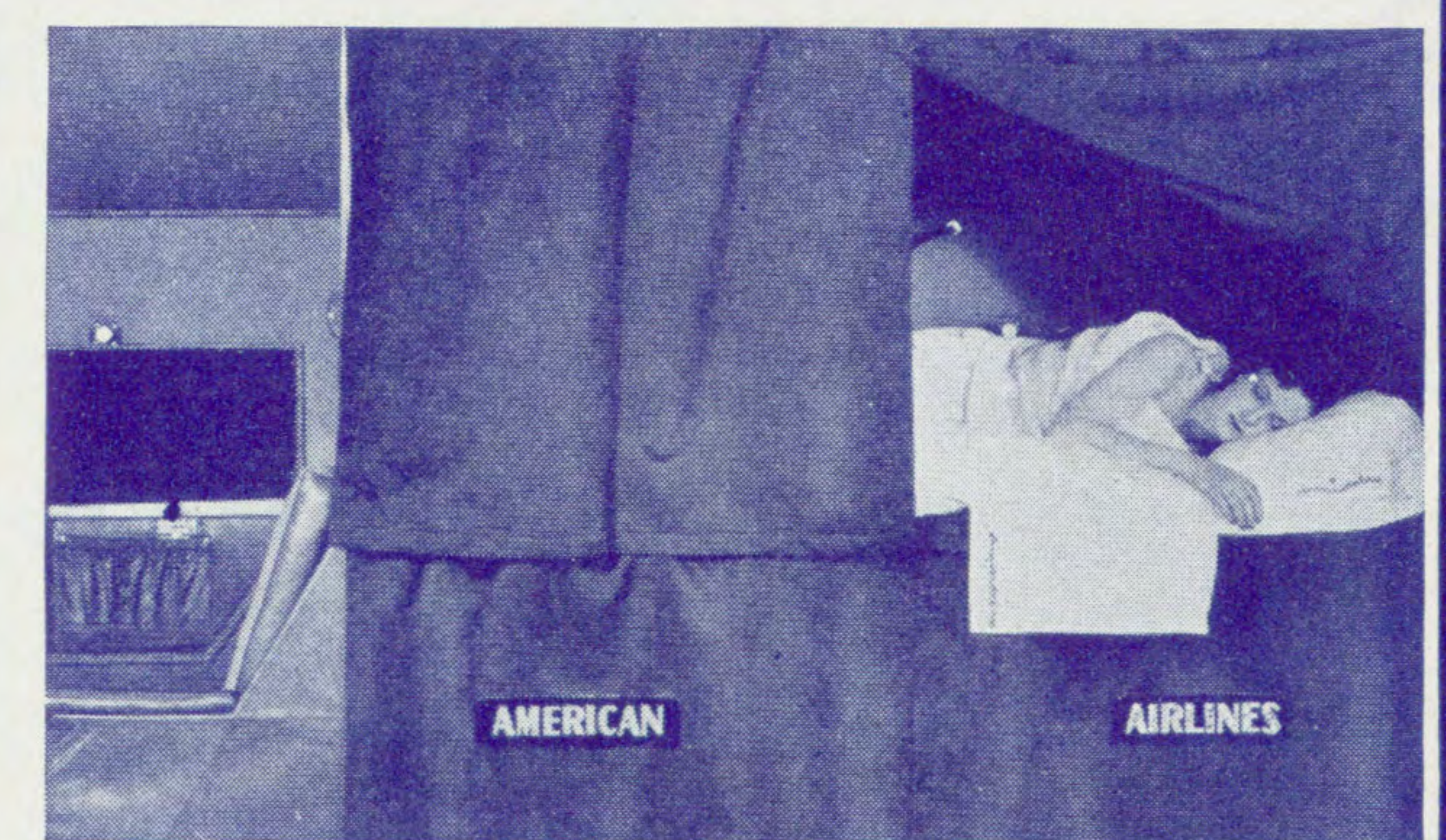
enroute at passenger's request. Berths have individual ventilation, clothes nets and hangers. Baggage is available at the foot of each berth, being carried on a special luggage rack.

GENERAL INFORMATION

ADJUSTMENT OF FARES—In case of dispute with ticket agents, pay fare required, take receipt and communicate with the General Traffic Manager. ANIMALS—Live animals and reptiles will not be accepted for transportation over the lines of the Company under any condition. BAGGAGE—Thirty (30) pounds of baggage will be carried free on any ticket. CHILDREN—Children under two years of age, when held in arms of parent or guardian, carried free. COMFORT FACILITIES—Comfort facilities are available on all American Airlines passenger planes and at all airports. COMPLAINTS—Complaints, or suggestions for the betterment of the service, should be addressed to the General Traffic Manager, American Airlines, Inc., 4848 West Sixty-third St., Chicago, Ill. DINING SERVICE—Schedules have been so arranged that meals may be secured at points where adequate facilities are available. INSURANCE—Trip insurance is available at most airports. PASSAGE, CANCELLATION BY COMPANY—The company reserves the right to cancel bookings before passage or en route. PASSAGE, CANCELLATION BY PASSENGER—The passenger reserves the right to cancel bookings before passage or en route.

PASSAGE, CANCELLATION BY PASSENGER—The Purchaser may receive a refund for passage if cancelled two hours prior to flight. PASSAGE, REFUSAL OF—The person in charge at any point of departure or the Pilot may refuse to carry any holder of a ticket, whenever he believes the proposed passenger is suffering from permanent or temporary disability, which wholly in the discretion of such Manager or Pilot, might jeopardize the safety of such passenger or the plane. RADIO—All passenger planes are equipped with the best two-way radio equipment available. REFUNDS—Requests for refunds on tickets should be addressed to the Auditor of Ticket Accounts, American Airlines, Inc., 4848 West Sixty-third St., Chicago, Ill. RESERVATIONS—All seats are reserved. Reservation will not be made except upon payment of fare. ROUND-TRIP FARES—10% reduction on all round-trip tickets if purchased before start of original trip. RETURN trip must be started within sixty days. STOP-OVER—Ten (10) day stop-over will be allowed at any regular stop provided reservation is made accordingly. TIME-TABLES—These time-tables show the times at which planes may be expected to depart from and arrive at the several stations shown, and to connect with trains or other planes, but their departure, arrival, or connection at the time stated is not guaranteed. WEARING APPAREL—Cabins of American Airlines planes are comfortably heated and ventilated. Wear regular apparel regardless of season.

AIR EXPRESS INFORMATION

SHIPMENTS ACCEPTABLE—Practically all articles and merchandise up to \$25,000 value may be shipped by Air Express. PICK-UP AND DELIVERY SERVICE—Tariff rates include special pick-up and delivery service by Postal Telegraph. CLASSES OF SERVICE—Shipments may be sent prepaid or collect. EXTENT OF SERVICE—Shipments will be accepted for air delivery to any city served by American Airlines and the following air lines of General Air Express—TWA, Eastern Air Lines and Pennsylvania Airlines.

RATES—Lowest air express rates are in effect. Send for General Air Express tariff, or inquire at any American Airlines or Postal Telegraph office. CARGO INSURANCE—Full coverage insurance may be obtained at the rate of 15 cents per \$100.00 valuation. VALUATION CHARGE—\$50.00 free liability. Additional liability accepted at 10 cents per \$100.00 valuation. RECEIPTS FOR SHIPMENTS—All shipments accepted on Interline air express way-bill, copy of which is retained by shipper. WRAPPING OR PACKING—Shipments should be wrapped or packed as for shipment by ordinary means. CARRIED ON ALL ROUTES—Air Express is carried on all passenger and mail schedules on all routes of American Airlines and associated lines of General Air Express.

AIR MAIL INFORMATION

AIR MAIL POSTAGE—Six cents (6c) first ounce and six cents (6c) each additional ounce to any point in the United States. AIR MAIL ENVELOPES—(Red, white and blue) Special envelopes not necessary, but if not used be sure to mark envelope on face plainly, "AIR MAIL," or use air mail sticker. AIR MAIL DEPOSITED CONVENIENTLY—Air Mail can be deposited in any mail box, letter chute in buildings, main post office or branch office. AIR MAIL REGISTERED, INSURED, C.O.D. OR SPECIAL DELIVERY—Air Mail can be registered, sent Special Delivery, C.O.D., or insured, just the same as ordinary mail.

PACKAGES BY AIR MAIL—Packages can be sent by Air Mail the same as letters, providing they do not weigh more than 70 pounds or measure more than 100 inches combined length and girth. PREFERENCE GIVEN AIR MAIL—U. S. Post Office Department order issued November 9, 1928, reads—"Air Mail must be given special attention and must not, under any circumstances, be handled as ordinary mail." AIR MAIL TO CITIES NOT ON AIR LINES—Air Mail can be sent to or from cities that are not located on Air Mail lines. AIR MAIL TO FOREIGN COUNTRIES—The rate to Canada is 6c for the first ounce and 6c for each additional ounce. For rates to other countries call the post office.

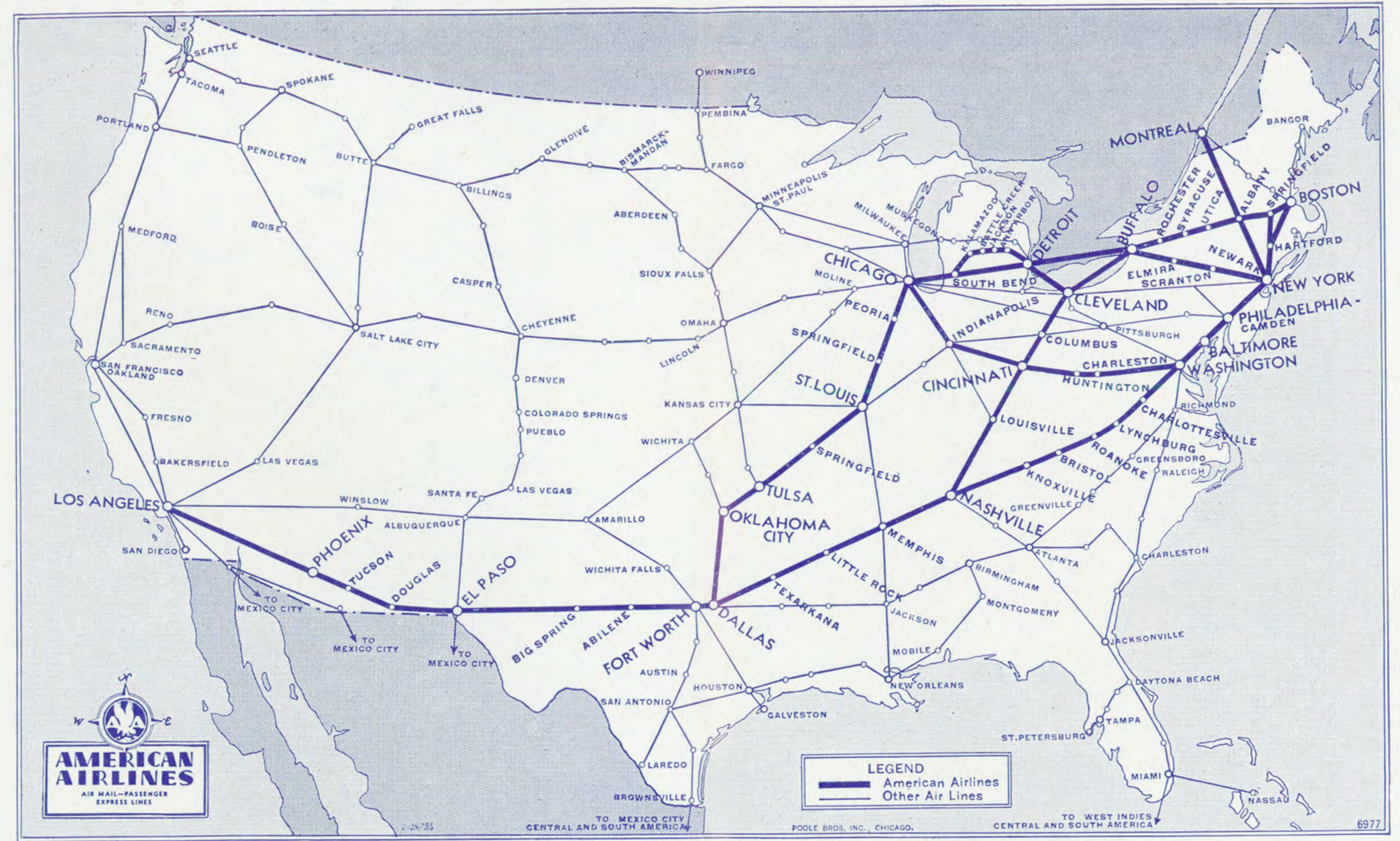
