ANIMALS—Pets will be accepted as excess baggage under certain conditions. Consult AMA agent.
BAGGAGE—Thirty-five (35) pounds of baggage will be carried free on any ticket. Excess baggage carried upon special arrangements and shall be at the rate per pound of one-half of one cent of the published air passenger fare, with a minimum charge of twenty-five cents, and the liability of the carrier for loss of or damage to baggage and/or personal property is limited to the amount of One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) unless a higher valuation be declared and an additional charge paid therefor.
