## YOUR TRIP TO MEXICO

### Requirements for Most Passengers Traveling to Mexico are Simple

#### DOCUMENTS

A United States Citizen traveling to Mexico for pleasure needs:

1. Proof of his United States citizenship (Birth Certificate, an old passport, or Naturalization Papers.)
2. A Mexican Tourist Card.

A United States Citizen traveling to Mexico for business needs:

1. A United States Passport.
2. A Mexican Visa.
3. Surety Bond of 500 Mexican Pesos.

Any American Airlines' office or your own travel agent will be glad to give you more detailed information and advise you fully concerning your individual requirements.

#### BAGGAGE

American Airlines permits you to carry 55 pounds of luggage free on each ticket. Additional baggage may be carried, with certain restrictions, for a nominal additional charge. All baggage will be examined by the customs officers as you enter and leave each country. Personal articles intended for your use while traveling are admitted to Mexico free of duty. However, any merchandise for sale, gifts, samples, or anything being carried for other persons will be subject to duty. If you have a large amount of excess baggage, your American Airlines representative will be happy to make the necessary arrangements to forward it for you.

If you are a resident of the United States, you will be allowed to bring back, duty free, \$100.00 in merchandise acquired outside the United States, but not more often than once in thirty days. This merchandise must be for your own personal use or for the personal use of your family.

#### CURRENCY

As a wartime measure, the Governments of both countries restrict passengers from carrying United States currency in denominations larger than \$20.00 bills. Travelers' checks, or equivalent form of financial paper, are a convenient and safe means of carrying your funds.

#### CENSORSHIP

Communications, written or printed matter of any kind, photographs, phonograph records, and any other medium by which a message can be conveyed, are subject to censorship, both on de-

parture from and return to the United States. Take as few letters and as little other written material as you can.

#### FILMS

If you plan to take photographs in Mexico, you may take with you unexposed still and motion picture film of any description, provided that the original package seals are unbroken. (Any one type of film valued in excess of \$25.00 requires an Export License). Exposed but undeveloped film must be left with the censor on exit from or entry into the United States.

#### PURCHASES IN MEXICO

Some of Mexico's many beautiful and novel souvenirs are subject to export duty which will be collected on departure at the Mexico City or Monterrey airport. These export duties are entirely separate from any duties imposed by the United States Government for importation of the same articles. It is recommended that passengers consult the American Airlines Office in Mexico concerning these export duties so that they may arrange their purchases accordingly.

#### CLIMATE AND CLOTHING

It is a mistake to think of all Mexico as having tropical climate. The greater part of the country you are likely to visit is high tableland where the air is invigorating. The days are clear, and the evenings are invariably cool. Between May and September occasional showers of short duration occur in the late afternoon. On the coastal lowlands warmer weather is prevalent.

Ordinary fall-weight clothing (sportswear is excellent) is suitable for general wear. You will, of course, need tropical weight clothing for the low country. A water-resistant coat is also recommended. In general, dress tends towards informality, and formal attire is not often seen.

#### TICKETS AND TAXES

Passengers holding return space, whether ticketed or not, must present their international documents and tickets to American Airlines office in Mexico City or Monterrey by 1:00 p.m. of the day before their scheduled departure or it will be assumed that they wish their return reservations to be cancelled. The U. S. transportation tax will be collected at the time you buy your ticket. Mexican transportation tax amounting to approximately 8% of the fare for that portion of your return trip over Mexican soil will be assessed at the time you check your return reservations.

All international regulations and information are subject to change without notice.

International passengers must possess all documents required by the laws of the countries from, into or over which they are to fly, and should any required documents be missing, passage may be denied by American Airlines, Inc.

## GENERAL INFORMATION

**AIR EXPRESS**—All flights carry Air Express. Special door-to-door pickup and delivery afforded by Air Express Division of the Railway Express Agency, Inc., International Air Express Service to Monterrey and Mexico City.

**AIRFREIGHT**—For information regarding rates, pickup and delivery service, inquire at any American Airlines office.

**AIR MAIL**—All flights carry Air Mail.

**BAGGAGE**—Forty (40) pounds of baggage will be carried free on any domestic ticket. The term "baggage" shall mean all luggage including briefcases, portfolios, parcels, sleeper envelopes, camera equipment and similar articles whether carried in the cabin or checked in cargo compartment. Excess baggage carried upon special arrangements and at the rate per pound of approximately one-half of one per cent of the published air passenger fare, subject to a minimum charge of twenty-five cents, and the liability of the Carrier for loss of or damage to baggage and/or personal property is limited to the amount of One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) unless a higher valuation be declared and an additional charge paid therefor. Excess valuation limited to \$2,500.00 on each full fare ticket. Fifty-five (55) pounds of baggage will be carried free on tickets of passengers to and from Mexico. Inquire of ticket agent for full details.

**CAMERAS**—Due to wartime restrictions, no cameras may be carried into the cabin of American Airlines' airplanes.

**CHILDREN**—One child under two years of age, not occupying a seat, will be carried free with each accompanying passenger twelve years of age or over.

**EQUIPMENT**—All American Airlines' flights are operated with Douglas 21-passenger "Flagship Club" airplanes, except flights 801, 802, 815 and 816 which are operated with Douglas Airfreighter equipment. Equipment is scheduled to operate through, as shown in the Tables.
