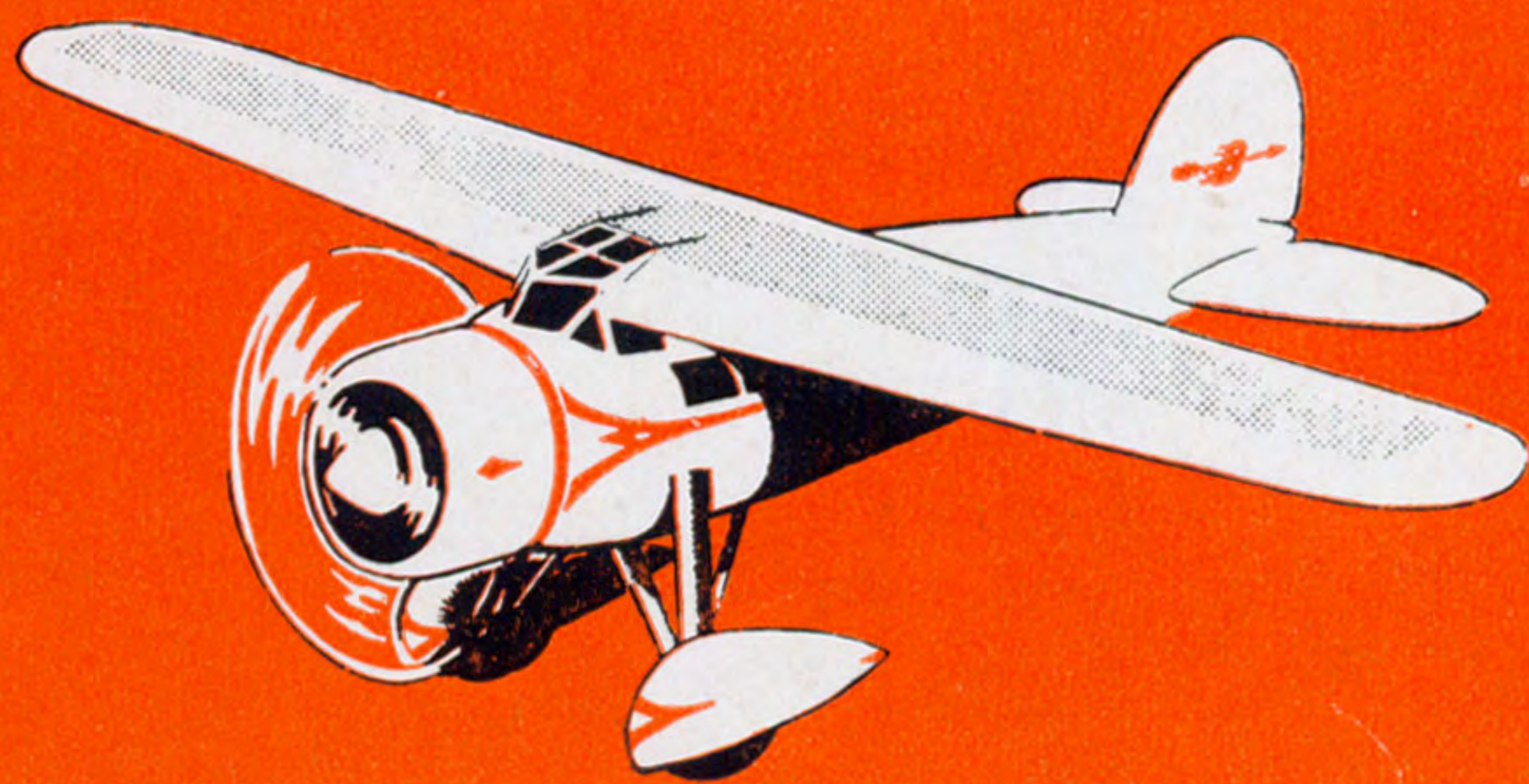

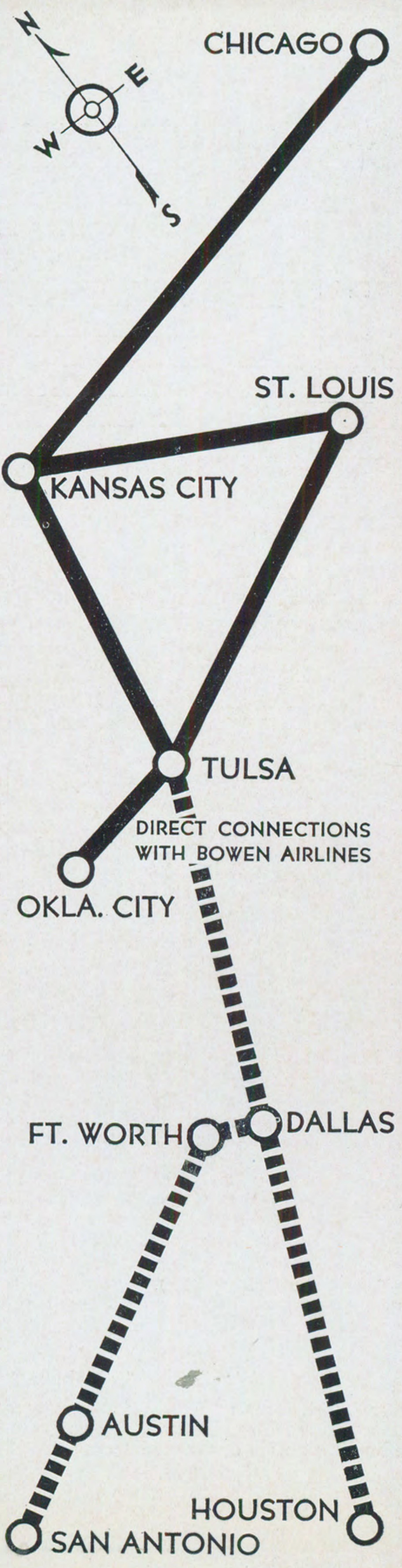

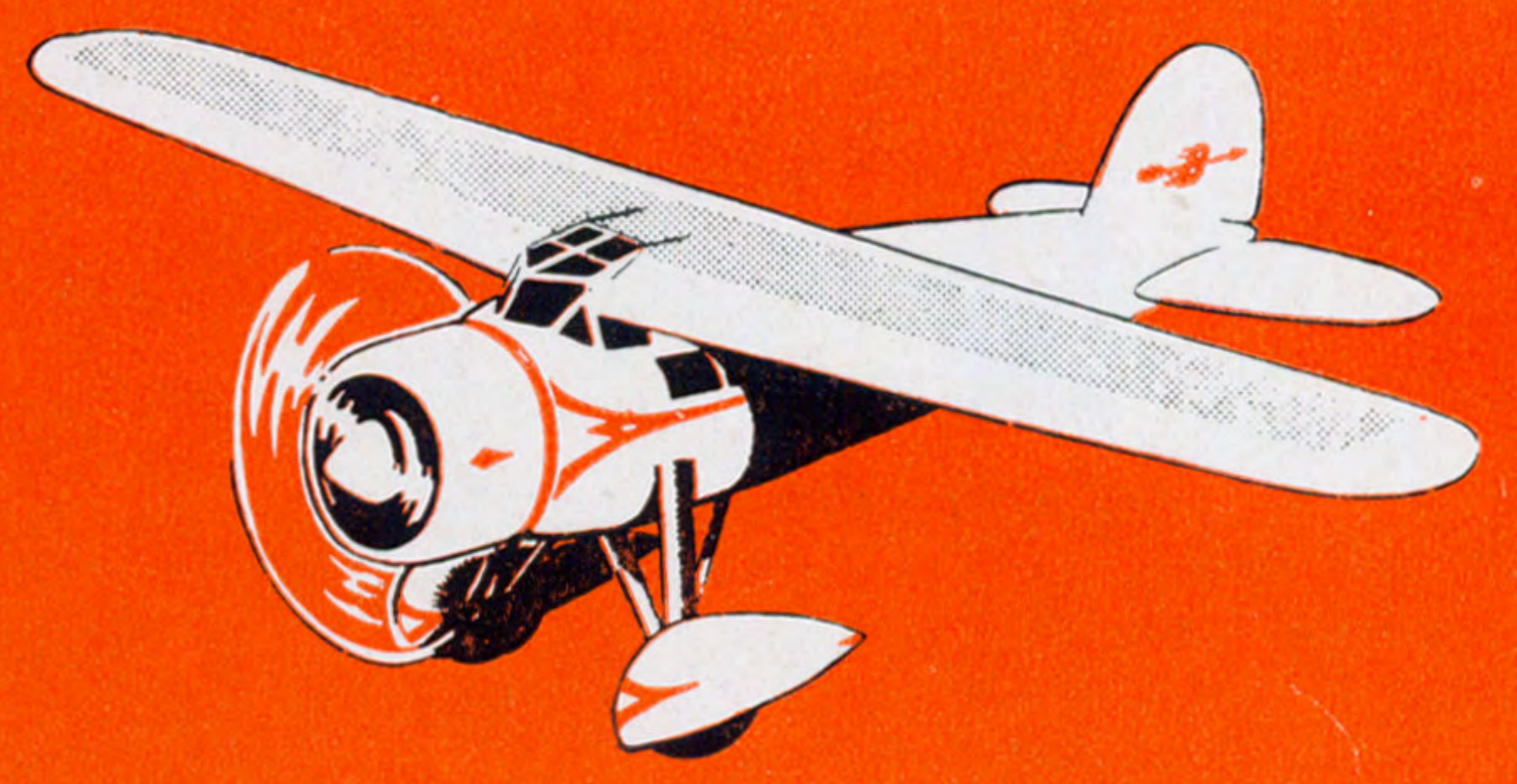

EQUIPMENT AND PERSONNEL—Lockheed Vega seven-place cabin planes. Cruising speed 150 miles per hour. Top speed 180 miles per hour. All planes, pilots and mechanics are licensed by the United States Department of Commerce.

The Company will not be liable for inconvenience or loss of any nature whatsoever due to the above.
