BAGGAGE—30 pounds carried free on each full fare ticket; charge for excess baggage up to 50 pounds is 1/2 of 1% of fare per pound of excess but no charge to be less than 5 cents per pound with a minimum total charge of 25 cents. Baggage weighing over 50 pounds carried only by special arrangement.

GROUND TRANSPORTATION—Transportation between the airport and downtown office will be arranged for, at reasonable rates and will be at the expense of the passenger.

EQUIPMENT AND PERSONNEL—Lockheed Vega seven-place cabin planes. Cruising speed 150 miles per hour. Top speed 180 miles per hour. All planes, pilots and mechanics are licensed by the United States Department of Commerce.

PASSENGER CONDITIONS—All schedules herein are subject to cancellation and individual postponement at terminals or any point along the route without notice. The company will not be liable for inconvenience or loss of any nature whatsoever due to the above. In all events the passenger's sole recourse shall be the recovery of the proportion of fare paid as distance untraveled bears to the scheduled miles of flight.
