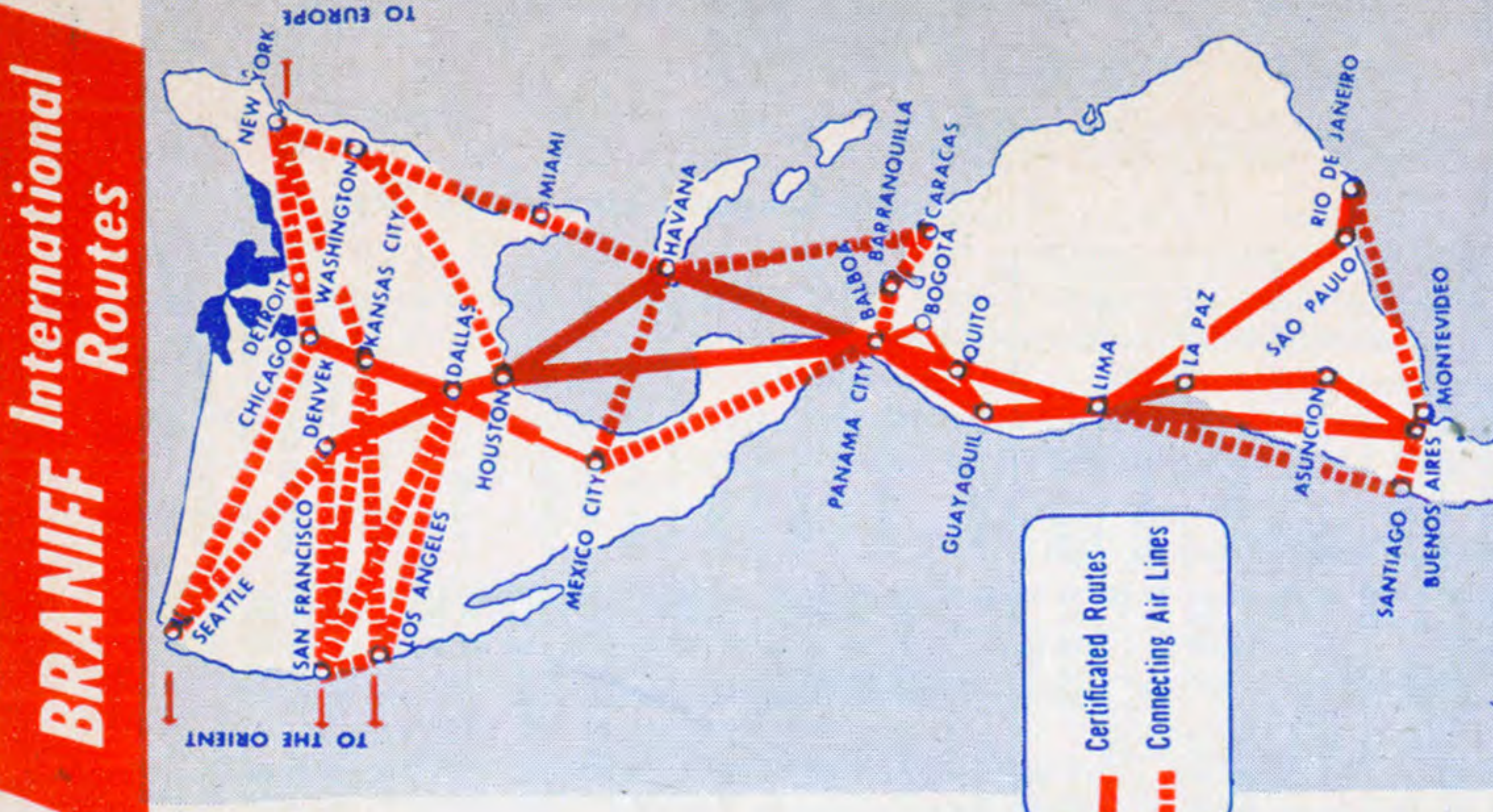

**AIRPLANES:** U. S. schedules on pages 5 and 6 shown in blue on red background are operated with 52-passenger DC-6 Braniff Skyliners. Schedules shown in red on white background are operated with 48-passenger DC-4 Skyliners. All other schedules are operated with 21-passenger DC-3 Skyliners. International schedules on pages 3, 5 and 6 are operated with DC-6 De Luxe Skyliners on "EL CONQUISTADOR" flights; DC-4 air-coaches on "EL INTERCONTINENTAL" flights.

**HOURS OF ARRIVAL AND DEPARTURE:** Time shown is local standard time. A.M. in light face, P.M. in dark face.

**CHECK IN FOR FLIGHTS:** Our passengers expect on-time performance. Therefore, to maintain our enviable on-time record, we reserve the right to cancel the reservation of any passenger who fails to present himself at the airport ticket office at least ten minutes prior to the scheduled departure time of a domestic flight, and at least 30 minutes before scheduled departure time of an international flight. Help us keep your flight on time. Check in early.

**BAGGAGE INFORMATION:** The free baggage allowance on all flights within the United States and Canada is 40 pounds. International passengers are allowed 66 pounds. Baggage in excess of these weights is charged for at the rate of 1/2 of 1% of the regular one-way fare per pound.

Excess baggage or personal property be lost, damaged or delayed in delivery, our liability is limited to \$100 for each ticket, unless extra value charges are paid before departure, or when checking articles for temporary storage.

When you leave the airplane at your destination, please make certain that you remove your hand parcels, briefcase, camera, etc.

**GROUND TRANSPORTATION:** is provided at all stations served by Braniff by reliable operators not under the control of Braniff, at reasonable rates, and for information purposes only such rates prevailing on the effective date of this folder are shown on this page.

**HOTEL RESERVATIONS:** Any Braniff office will gladly arrange your hotel reservations in any city served by the airline.

**MEAL SERVICE:** Delicious complimentary meals are served aloft on flights at regular meal hours. In addition, liquids are available between meal hours. Snack service is provided on "El Intercontinental" flights.

**INSURANCE:** Domestic airline trip insurance may be purchased from any Braniff Airways ticket office in the United States. The charge for a \$5000 policy, good on any certified airline, is 25 cents.

For foreign travel, our insurance company extends its policies purchased in the United States over any portion of our foreign operations at the same rates which apply domestically.

**CHILDREN:** One child, under two years of age and not occupying a seat will be carried free with each accompanying passenger twelve years of age or over on the routes of Braniff Airways. Children under two years of age for whom seats are reserved and children two years of age and under twelve years of age will be charged one-half of the applicable adult fare for passage. Children under eight years of age must be accompanied by a passenger twelve years of age or over.

**FAMILY FARES:** On Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday your wife and children, 21 years of age and under, travel half fare when you buy one regular fare ticket to any point served by Braniff in the United States. Family half fares also apply on your family's return trip on Monday, Tuesday or Wednesday of any week, but you may return any day. Mother may buy a regular fare ticket and take the children at half fare even if father can't go. Family half fares also apply between domestic points and Havana, Cuba on Braniff international routes.

**SCHEDULES AND FARES:** All schedules and fares shown herein are for information only, and are subject to change and correction without notice. Official Braniff Airways, Inc., fares for passage between points within the U.S.A. are published in Local and Joint Passenger Tariff No. PF-4, A.T.B. No. 12, C.A.B. No. 18, M. F. Redfern, Agent, which is on file with the Civil Aeronautics Board. Official Braniff Airways, Inc., fares for passage between points in the U.S.A. and points in Cuba, the Canal Zone, Ecuador, Peru, Bolivia, Paraguay, Brazil and Argentina are published in Braniff Airways, Inc., Local and Joint Passenger Tariff No. 1, C.A.B.
