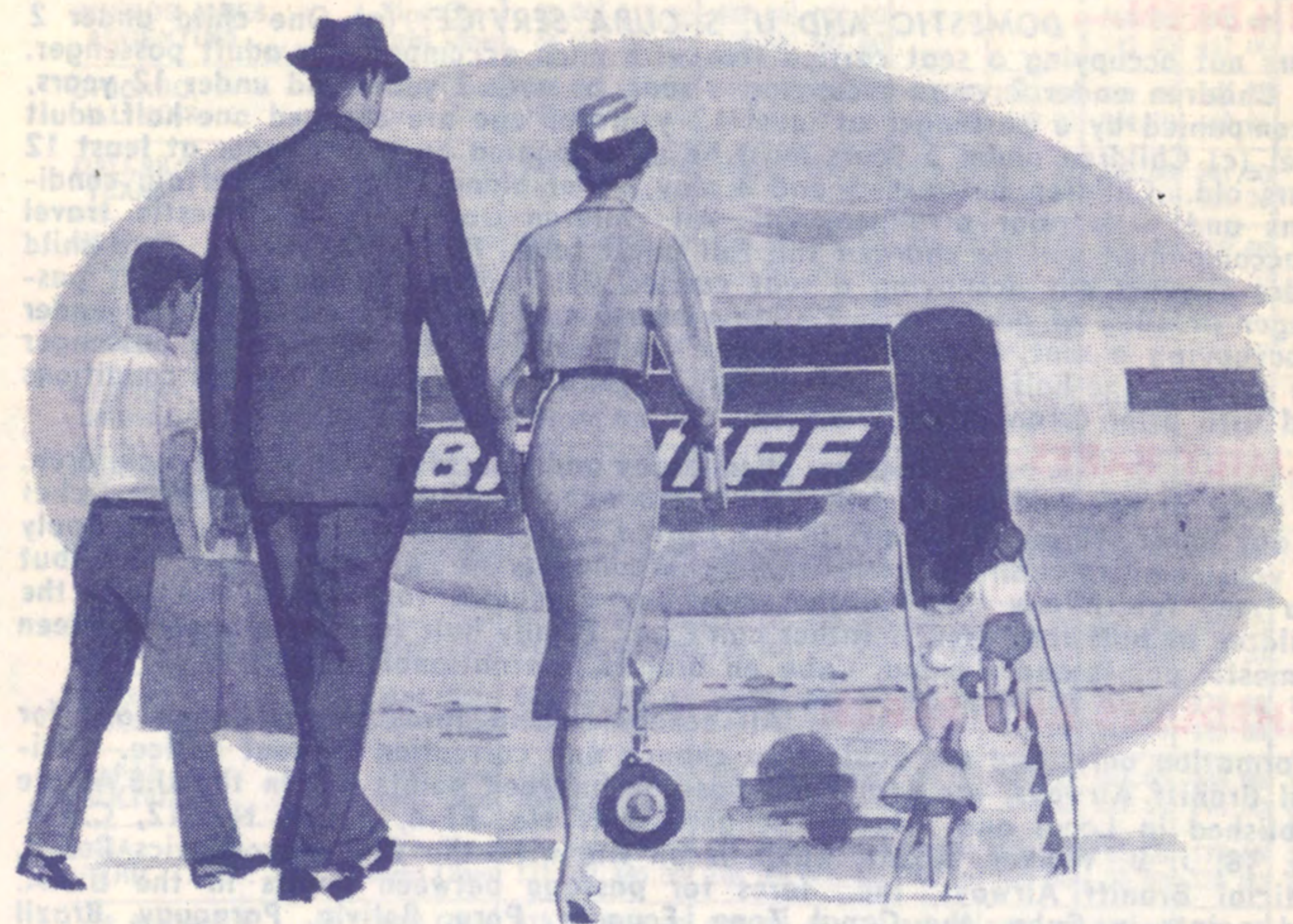

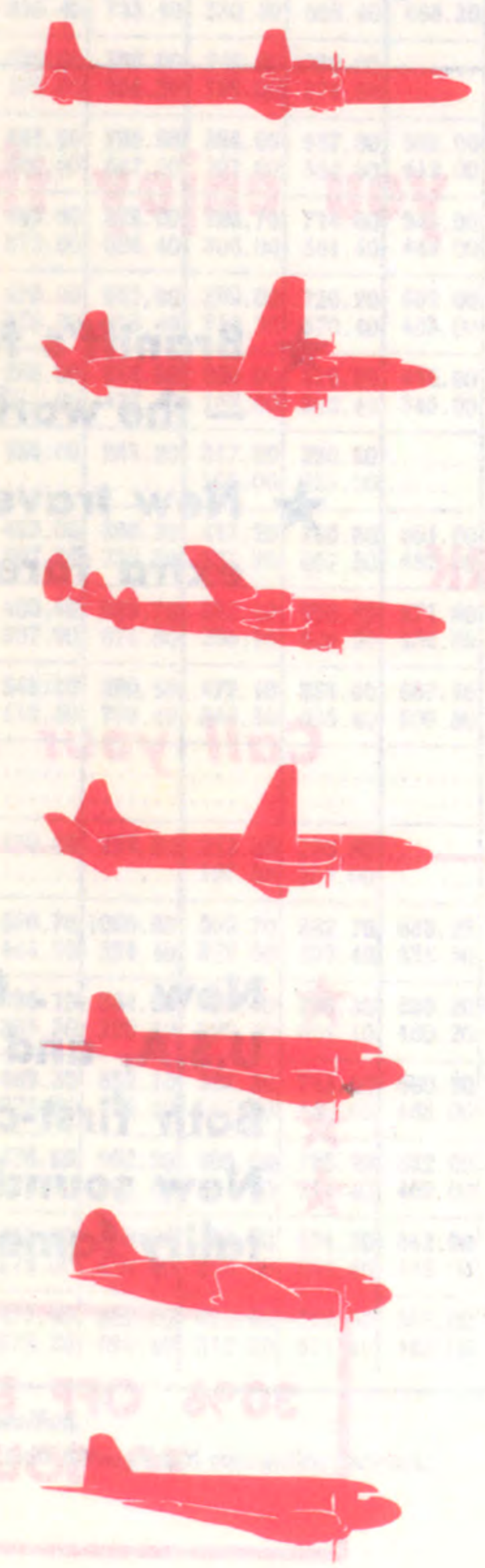
FAMILY-FARE PLAN

Braniff gives budgets a break with this popular family flying plan. One parent pays full fare and the other parent, plus children over 2 and under 22 years of age, pay only half-fare when you start your travel at any time Tuesday, Wednesday or Thursday. (One accompanied child under two flies free, those under 12 pay only half-fare anytime.)

You can leave on a Braniff flight as late as one minute before midnight Thursday and continue traveling Friday on Braniff and most other carriers at family-fare plan rates.

The whole family leaves on the same flight, but it's not necessary for all to return on one flight, so long as return days are Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday. If Dad is pressed for time, the others can come back later.

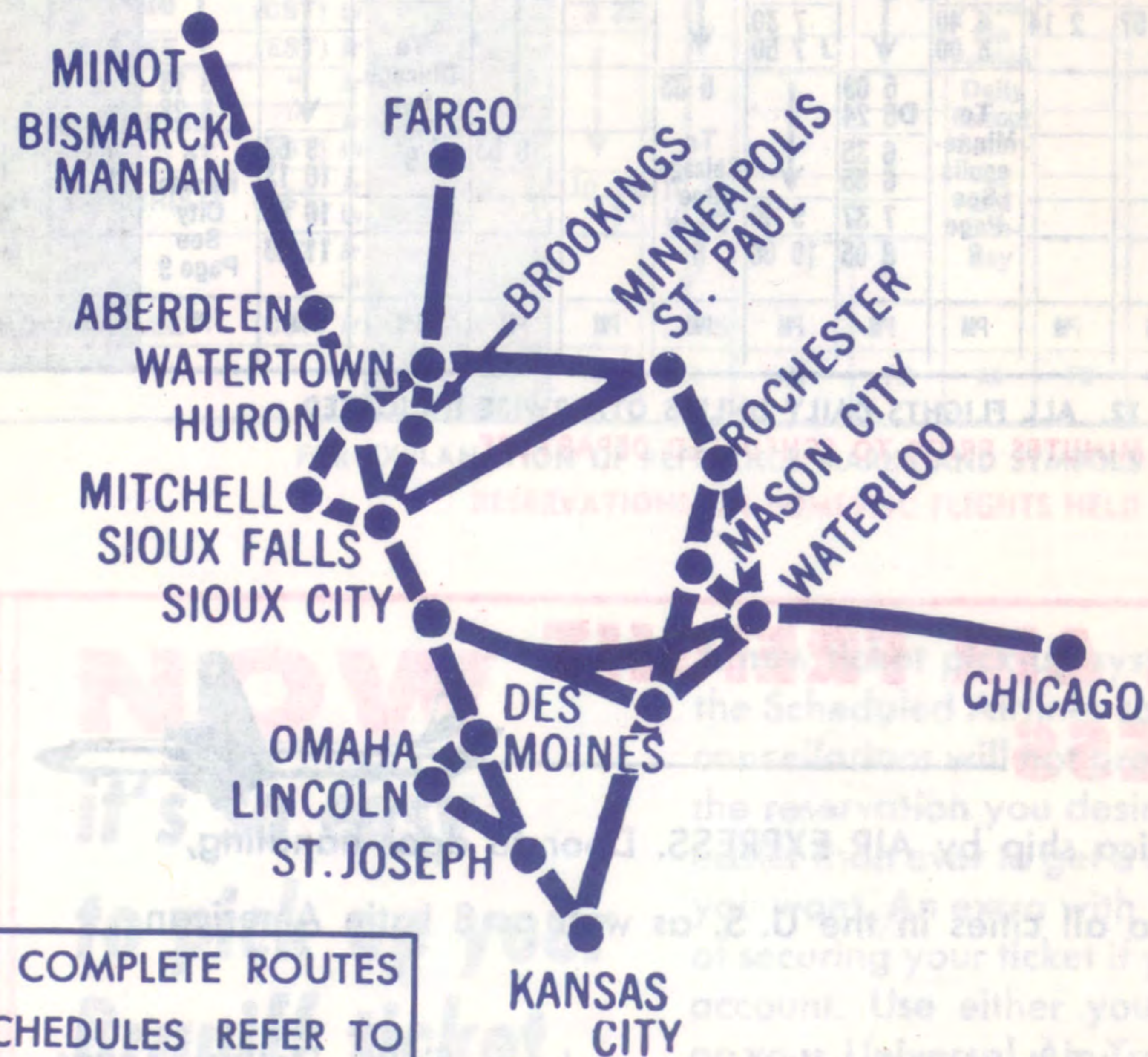
