

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

■ The number of minutes before plane departure when passengers should leave the downtown area in order to allow sufficient time for driving to the airport and completing necessary formalities before boarding plane.

BAGGAGE—Forty (40) pounds of baggage (55 pounds for Chicago and Southern Airlines International travel) will be carried free on any ticket. Excess Baggage, Domestic and International, will be accepted upon special arrangement at the published rates. The liability of the Carrier, if any, for loss of or damage to baggage is limited to the actual value of such baggage, which is presumed not to exceed \$100.00 for each passenger, unless a higher valuation is declared and an additional charge paid therefor. Baggage weight charges are separate and distinct from baggage valuation charges.

CHILDREN—Babies under 2 years old carried free when accompanied by a full fare passenger. Half fare for children under 12 years of age via Chicago and Southern Air Lines, Inc. (for International travel see tariff).

EQUIPMENT—4 Engine Douglas DC-4, 50 passenger and Douglas DC-3, 21 passenger planes. DC-4 equipment used on flights indicated by symbol (●).

GROUND TRANSPORTATION—Chicago and Southern Air Lines has arranged ground transportation facilities for the convenience of its passengers. The company itself does not operate such service. Passengers using their own ground transportation direct to the airport are requested to report to the Ticket Agent at least twenty (20) minutes before Dixieliner departure time.

INTERNATIONAL REQUIREMENTS—It will be the passengers' responsibility to possess valid passports and/or other documents required by the Governmental Agencies involved.

PASSAGE, CANCELLATION BY COMPANY—The Company may cancel

any reservation if the person holding the reservation has not presented himself at the airport ticket office for the purpose of checking in at least ten minutes prior to the scheduled departure time of the flight for which the reservation was made. The company reserves the right to cancel booking before passage or en route. Pilot may remove passengers from plane or refuse them admittance to plane at any point on the route for safety or other cause. In all events the passenger's sole recourse shall be recovery of that portion of the fare equal to the distance untraveled.

PASSAGE, CANCELLATION BY PASSENGER—Reservations must be cancelled prior to scheduled departure time if full refund is desired.

RESERVATIONS—All seats reserved. Reservations should be made as early as possible.

TICKETS—All-year Domestic, valid for 120 days from date of issuance. All-year International, valid for 1 year from date of commencement of passage from point of origin. For validity of excursion tickets see applicable tariff.

STOP-OVERS—Stop-overs will be permitted at any regular stop provided reservation is made accordingly.

TIME-TABLES—These time-tables show the times at which planes may be expected to depart from and arrive at the several stations shown, but are subject to change without notice, and are not guaranteed.

EQUIPAJE—Cuarenta (40) libras de equipaje (55 libras en la línea internacional de la Chicago and Southern Airlines) serán transportadas sin costo adicional. Cualquier exceso ya sea en las líneas domésticas o internacionales será aceptado bajo la tarifa convencional. La responsabilidad de la C. & S. Airlines, si alguna, por la pérdida de equipaje o daño ocurrido al mismo se limita al valor actual de equipaje que se presume no pasar los límites de 100 dólares por cada pasajero a menos que se haya declarado un valor mayor y un precio adicional pagado. Los precios por la pesa de equipaje son segregados y distintos de los precios por el valor del mismo.

NIÑOS—Los niños menores de dos (2) años de edad serán transportados gratis cuando van acompañados por una persona que haya pagado pasaje completo. Los niños menores de 12 años de edad serán transportados en la Chicago and Southern Airlines por medio pasaje, (para viajes internacionales debe consultarse la tarifa).

EQUIPO UTILIZADO—Aviones cuatrimotores Douglas DC-4 de 50 pasajeros y bimotores DC-3 de 21 pasajeros.

TRANSPORTE DEL Y AL AEROPUERTO—Este servicio no está incluido en el pasaje y será suministrado a petición del pasajero.

REQUISITOS PARA LOS PASAJEROS INTERNACIONALES—El pasajero correrá con la responsabilidad de obtener pasaportes válidos o los documentos requeridos por las agencias gubernamentales.

CANCELACIONES HECHAS POR LA COMPAÑIA—La compañía se reserva el derecho de cancelar cualquiera reservación si la persona no se ha presentado en el aeropuerto a lo menos diez minutos antes de la hora indicada para la partida del vuelo por lo que la reservación haya sido hecha.
