Domestic round trip fare is discounted 10% on return ticket (except tickets purchased under the Family Fare Plan). Official tariffs are on file and open for inspection at any Chicago and Southern Air Lines offices.

NOTE — Fares quoted do not include hotel service fees nor ground transportation. Fares referenced "M" are 30-day excursion fares. All other international fares are all year fares.

AIR FREIGHT AND AIR EXPRESS carried on all flights. For information on domestic and international rates or service, contact Traffic Manager in cities shown herein, or write Cargo Traffic and Sales Manager, Memphis, Tenn.

BAGGAGE includes all luggage such as brief cases, portfolios, handbags, packages, parcels, typewriters, camera equipment and accessories and other similar articles, whether personally carried by passenger in cabin or checked and carried in cargo compartments. Ladies' purses, overcoats, umbrellas, small pocket cameras, and binoculars are regarded as personal weight of passenger. The liability of the Carrier, if any, for loss of or damage to baggage is limited to the actual value of such baggage, which is presumed not to exceed \$100 for each passenger, unless a higher valuation is declared and an additional charge paid therefor. Baggage weight charges are separate and distinct from baggage valuation charges.

CANCELLATION—The Company reserves the right to cancel any reservation before passage or en route. Pilot may remove passengers from plane or refuse them admittance to plane at any point on the route for safety or other cause. In all events the passenger's sole recourse shall be recovery of that portion of the fare equal to the distance untraveled.

CHILDREN'S FARES—Except as shown in paragraphs 1 and 2 below, one unaccompanied child under 2 years of age, not occupying an individual seat will be carried at 10% of the normal adult fare from origin to destination.

(1) that on traffic between Mexico, Puerto Rico and U.S.A. on the one hand and Central America, South America, Islands of the Caribbean Sea or the West Indies

on the other hand the charge shall be 10% from origin to destination or from Miami to destination whichever is cheaper.

(2) no charge will be assessed for carriage between points in the U.S.A., between the U.S.A. and points in Canada, Cuba, Mexico, Nassau and Puerto Rico. A child 2 years of age or over, but under 12 years of age (or child under 2 years of age for whom a reservation has been made) will be charged one-half of the normal all year adult fare and will be allowed to occupy a reserved seat. Children under eight years of age must be accompanied by a passenger at least 12 years of age, except that under certain specified conditions children five to eight years of age may travel unaccompanied.

GROUND TRANSPORTATION—Scheduled facilities have been arranged for the convenience of passengers. C&S itself does not operate such service.

RESERVATIONS—All seats are reserved, and reservations are tentative until tickets have been purchased. Passengers are urged to make reservations well in advance. STOP-OVERS within the time limit of the ticket will be permitted at any scheduled stop or flag-stop en route, unless otherwise restricted.

TIMETABLES show the times at which planes may be expected to depart from and arrive at the several stations shown, but are subject to change without notice, and are not guaranteed.

EQUIPMENT—Flight numbers in the hundred series, denoted by (★), operate with C&S New Luxury Constellation equipment. All other flights operate with 21-passenger DC-3 equipment.

DOMESTIC TRAVEL INFORMATION

BAGGAGE—Forty pounds will be carried free domestically. Rate for excess weight will be one-half of one per cent of one-way fare per pound, with a minimum of twenty-five cents. Valuation in excess of \$100 will be subject to charges of 10 cents per \$100, with maximum valuation limited to \$500.

CANCELLATION—Passengers are requested to report to ticket agent at airport

at LEAST 20 MINUTES before departure time. Reservations may be cancelled and resold if passenger has not presented himself for check-in at least ten minutes prior to scheduled departure.

TICKETS—Valid for 4 months from date of issuance.

C & S INTERNATIONAL TRAVEL INFORMATION

BAGGAGE—Thirty kilos (66 pounds) will be carried free. Rate for excess weight, if allowed, will be 1 per cent of adult one-way fare per kilo (2.2 lbs.) for the first 10 kilos (22 lbs.). Baggage in excess of such 10 kilos (22 lbs.) will be charged for at one-half of one per cent of the adult one-way fare per kilo (2.2 lbs.). Valuation in excess of \$100 subject to charges of 15 cents per \$100, with maximum valuation limited to \$2500.

CANCELLATION—The company may cancel the reservation of any passenger at his point of embarkation either from or to the U. S. unless the passenger communicates with a reservation or ticket office of C&S located at such point at least 6 hours before scheduled departure, or within 30 minutes after his arrival at such point by air, if less than six hours before such scheduled departure.

CHECK-IN AT PORT OF EMBARKATION—Passengers must arrive at airport of embarkation at least 45 minutes before scheduled departure to permit checking of their baggage and completion of Government and other formalities.

CUSTOMS-DUTIES—All baggage will be examined by Customs Officers of each country on arrival. Personal articles intended for use while traveling are admitted free of duty. However, any merchandise for sale, gifts, samples or anything being carried for other persons will be subject to duty. Residents of the United States are not permitted to claim a customs exemption more than once every 30 days and may bring into the U. S. a maximum of \$200 in merchandise acquired outside the country provided they have been abroad for at least 48 hours, or \$500 in merchandise provided they have been abroad more than 12 days (the latter is permitted only once every six months). Important Note: Either of the foregoing allowances limits each passenger to one gallon of spirits and 100 cigars duty and internal revenue free.
