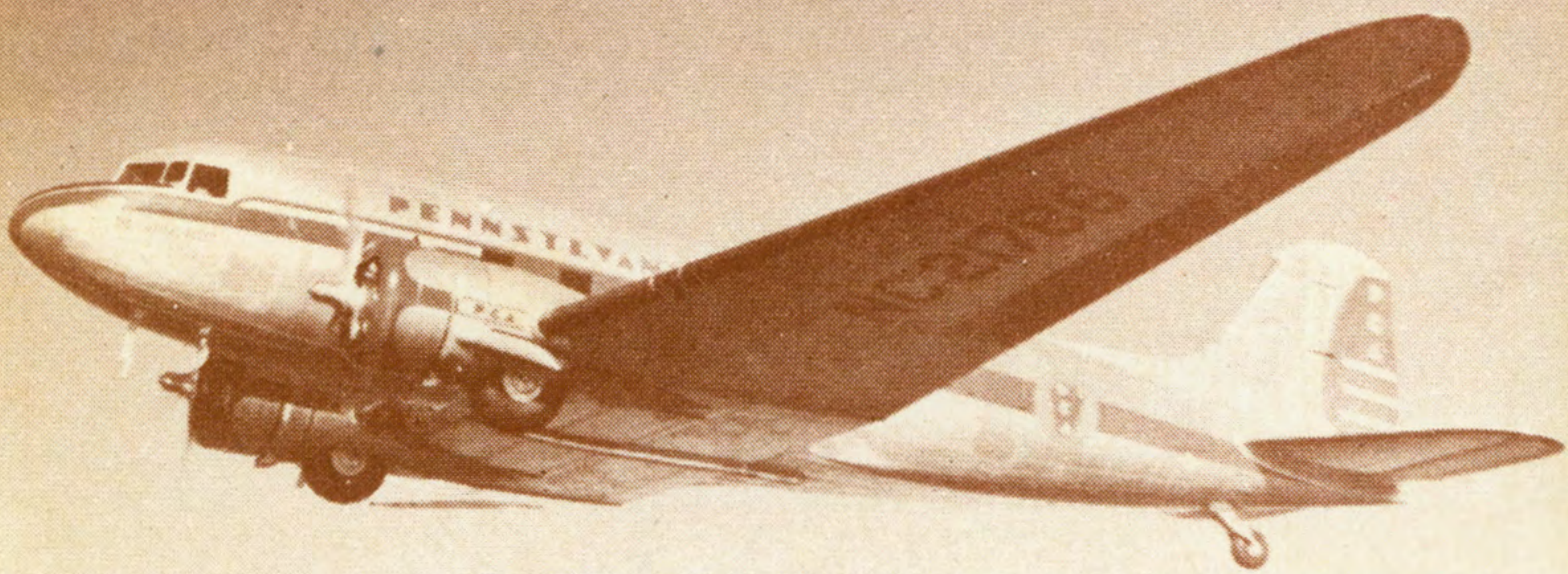

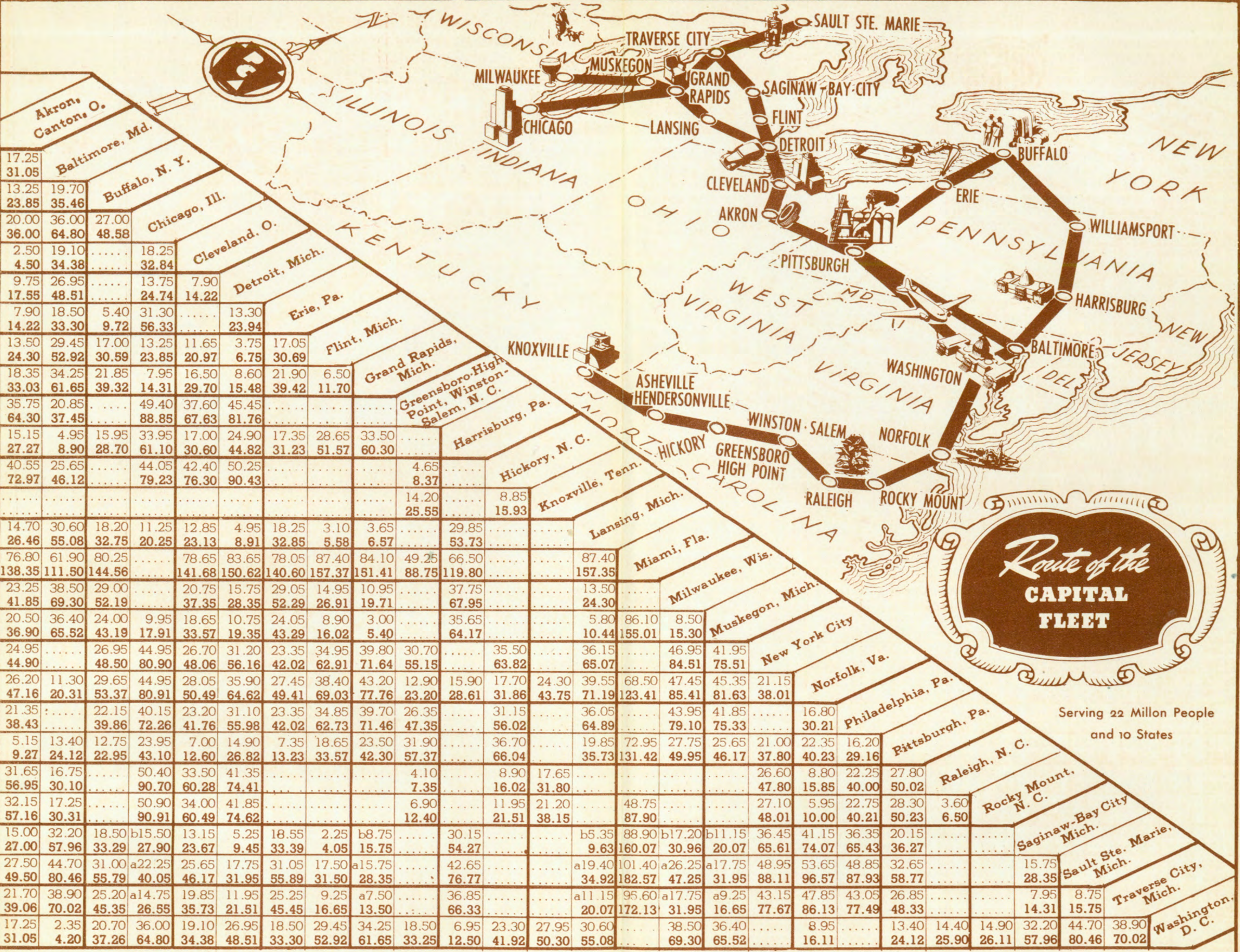

GENERAL INFORMATION

ANIMALS—Pets will be accepted as excess baggage under certain conditions. Consult your Agent.

BAGGAGE—Forty (40) pounds of baggage will be carried free on any ticket. Baggage in excess of 40 pounds will be carried subject to load on all flights and shall be at the rate per pound of one-half of 1 percent of the published one way passenger fare, with a minimum charge of 25c.

CHILDREN—Children under two years of age, when held in arms of parents or guardian will be carried free. Children two years of age and under 12 and children under two years of age for whom seats are reserved, will be charged one-half of the published tariff. Children under eight years of age must be accompanied by a passenger 12 years of age or over.

COMMUTER FARES—Books, in units of 10 tickets, good for passage between Detroit-Cleveland, in either direction, are sold to individuals for \$65.00 and expire at midnight of June 13, 1941. See your travel agent or call any Airline Office for further details.

FARES—Fares quoted herein apply from airport to airport and via the most direct routing unless indicated otherwise. A 10% reduction from one way fares is granted on all round trip or circle tour tickets if purchased before start of original trip. Tickets are good for 4 months after date of issuance. Fares shown are for information only and are subject to the rules and regulations contained in Local and Joint Passenger Tariff No. 1, as amended, on file with the Civil Aeronautics Board, copies of which are open for public inspection in any Pennsylvania-Central Airlines office.

OPTIONAL ROUTINGS—Optional routings are permitted at the published fares, in either direction, between Baltimore via Washington or Washington via Baltimore, and all stations on Pennsylvania-Central Airlines with the exception of Harrisburg and Williamsport.

RESERVATIONS—All seats are reserved, though no definite seat assignments are made. Tickets must be purchased 2 hours before departure of planes; otherwise, reservations are subject to sale. If cancellation is necessary after ticket has been purchased, notice of cancellation must be made 2 hours before scheduled plane departure; otherwise, request for refund must be made to the General Office. The Company reserves the right to cancel bookings before passage or enroute and the passenger's sole recourse shall be recovery of that portion of the fare equal to the distance untraveled.

STOP-OVER—Stop-overs will be allowed at any regular stop at no extra charge provided reservation is made accordingly.

TIME TABLES—This time table shows the times at which planes may be expected to depart from and arrive at the several stations shown and to connect with trains or other planes, but their departure, arrival or connection at the time stated is not guaranteed. Pennsylvania-Central Airlines Corporation will not be responsible for errors or omissions in time tables, inconvenience or damage resulting from delays to planes or failure to make connections and also reserves the right to vary from the times shown, without notice to the public.

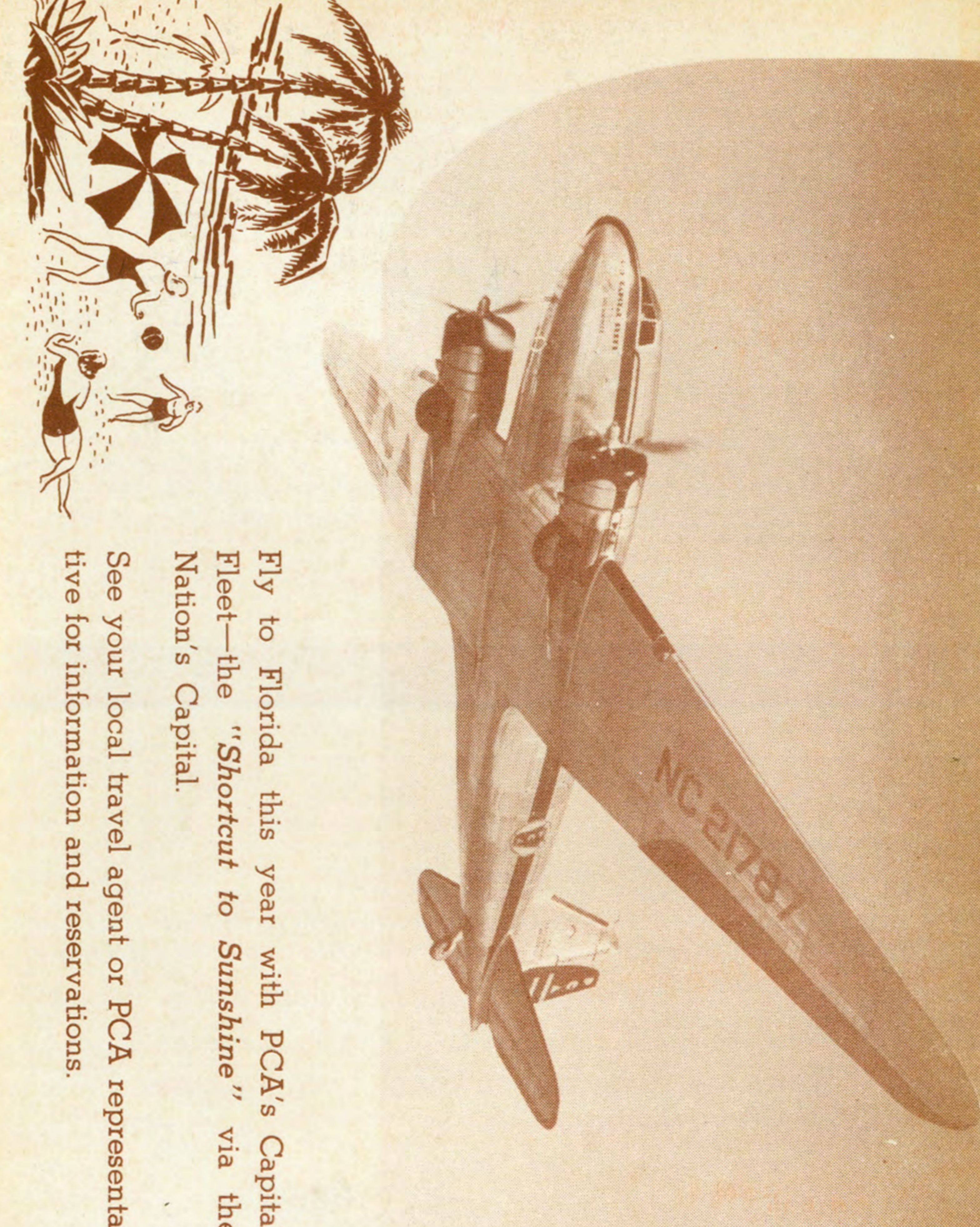

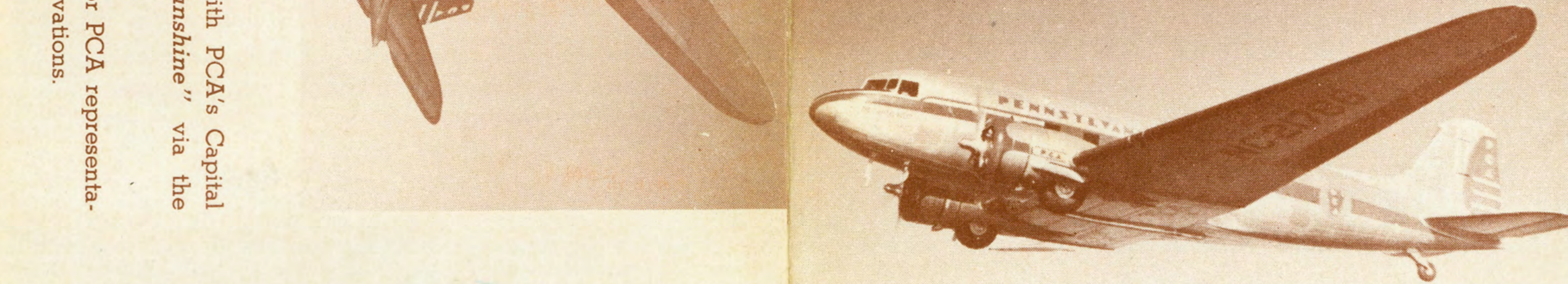
