## GENERAL INFORMATION

**Reservations**—All seats are reserved. Bookings may be through any Pennsylvania Airlines agent, all Postal Telegraph and Western Union offices, Greyhound Bus Lines, leading hotels, travel bureaus and Pennsylvania Railroad offices west of Pittsburgh.

**Children's Fares**—There are no half-fares. Infants under 2 years of age may be carried free.

**Round Trip Fares**—10% reduction on all round trip tickets. Return coupon is not transferable and must be used within 60 days.

**Baggage**—Thirty (30) pounds of baggage will be carried free. Excess baggage, if allowed, will be charged for per pound at the rate of one-half of one per cent (1/2%) of the passenger fare, with a minimum charge of twenty-five cents (25c).

**Cancellations—By Company**—Company reserves the right to cancel bookings before passage, or enroute any time such action is deemed advisable or necessary. In all events, the passenger's sole recourse shall be the recovery of the unused portion of the air fare.

**Cancellations—By Passenger**—To secure refund, ticket must be surrendered to company office or authorized agent two hours before scheduled departure of plane.

**Connections**—Services of connecting lines are shown for the convenience of passengers. Pennsylvania Airlines is in no manner responsible for the failure of such connections.

**Cab Service**—Available at all terminals at passenger's expense.

**Schedule and Fares**—Published in this time table are subject to change without notice.

### Facts About Air Mail:

1. Air mail may be posted in any mail box.
2. Air mail stamps are not necessary. The proper amount of ordinary stamps will be satisfactory, provided the envelope is marked "Air Mail".
3. Special air mail envelopes not necessary. Any ordinary envelope may be used. An air mail sticker, or the endorsement "Air Mail" below the stamp is sufficient.
4. Postage 8c for the first ounce and 13c for each additional ounce or fraction thereof to any post office in United States, Mexico or Canada. An ordinary letter of three or four sheets usually weighs an ounce or less.
5. Packages weighing up to 70 pounds and not exceeding 100 inches in length and girth combined may be sent air mail. Any mailable matter, except that liable to damage by freezing, may be sent air mail.
6. Air mail may be posted wherever ordinary mail is posted and sent Insured, Registered, C.O.D. or Special Delivery to any post office in the United States whether or not it is on an Air Mail Line, connections being made by rail.
7. Your post office welcomes inquiries on the use of air mail. Check your local air mail closing time.
8. Air mail travels three times faster than first-class mail and is accorded preferential handling by the United States Post Office Department.

... use **AIR EXPRESS**

Pennsylvania Airlines is associated with the group of airlines which comprise GENERAL AIR EXPRESS, the Interline System, with over 17,000 miles of airways, permitting the shipper fast day and night service between cities on its system and all points throughout the nation and air, rail and bus connections to Canada, Mexico, Central and South Americas and the West Indies.

Through routing on a single waybill and the lowest air express rates, which include special pick-up and delivery by Postal Telegraph, are the reasons for the tremendous monthly increase in Air Express shipments being shown by all airlines.

Pack your shipment like ordinary express, then phone a Pennsylvania Airlines Agent or the nearest Postal Telegraph Office. Shipments may be sent either express collect or prepaid. Cargo insurance is available at low rates.
