

General Information

Baggage—Thirty-five (35) pounds of baggage will be carried free on any ticket. Brief cases and small packages not checked will be included in weighing baggage. Baggage in excess of 35 pounds will be charged at the rate of one-half of 1% of the published one way passenger fare per pound, with a minimum charge of twenty-five (25) cents.


Cancellations—Tickets must be purchased 2 hours before departure of planes; otherwise, reservations are subject to sale. If cancellation is necessary after ticket has been purchased, notice of cancellation must be made 2 hours before scheduled plane de-

parture, otherwise, no refund will be made of the fare paid.




Boeing planes flown between Milwaukee, Detroit and Washington are high-speed, 1100 Horsepower transports of 10 passenger capacity.

The Stinson transports flown on certain flights between Detroit and Washington, offer wide, spacious cabins, side-by-side seating and radio at every seat.
