ANIMALS—Pets will be accepted as excess baggage under certain conditions. Consult your agent.
BAGGAGE—Forty (40) pounds of baggage will be carried free on any ticket. Baggage in excess of 40 pounds will be carried subject to load on all flights and shall be at the rate per pound of one-half of 1 percent of the published one way passenger fare, with a minimum charge of 25c.
CHILDREN—Children under two years of age, when held in arms of parents or guardian will be carried free. Children two years of age and under 12, will be charged one-half of the published tariff. Children under eight years of age will not be carried unless accompanied by a full fare paying passenger.
RESERVATIONS—All seats are reserved, though no definite seat assignments are made. Tickets must be purchased 2 hours before departure of planes; otherwise, reservations are subject to sale. If cancellation is necessary after ticket has been purchased, notice of cancellation must be made 2 hours before scheduled plane departure; otherwise, request for refund must be made to the General Office.

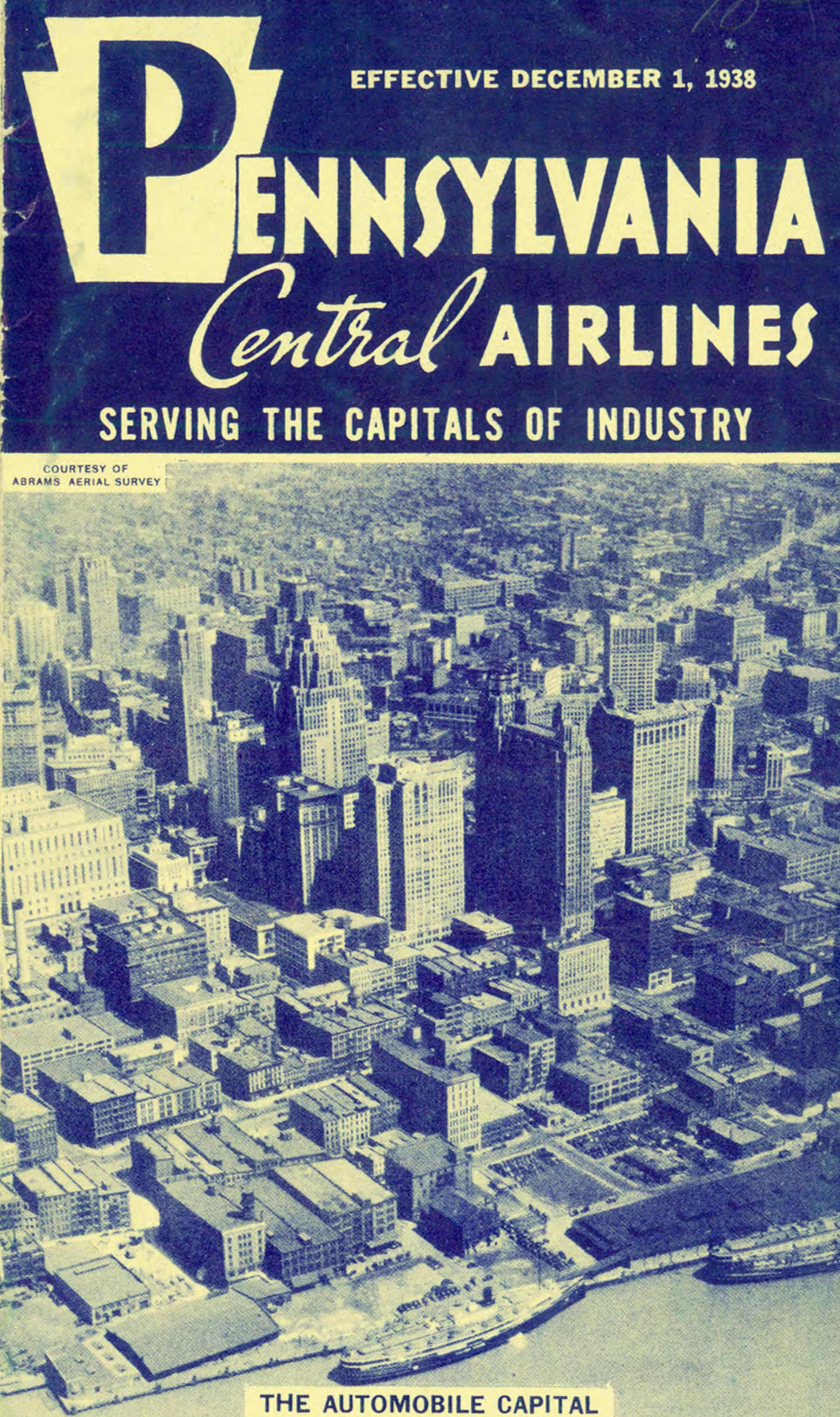
GENERAL INFORMATION

The Company reserves the right to cancel bookings before passage or enroute and the passenger's sole recourse shall be recovery of that portion of the fare equal to the distance untraveled.

ROUND TRIP FARES—10% reduction on all round trip, or circle tour tickets if purchased before start of original trip. Tickets are good for 90 days and may be extended an additional 30 days upon application.

STOP-OVER—Stop-overs will be allowed at any regular stop at no extra charge provided reservation is made accordingly.
