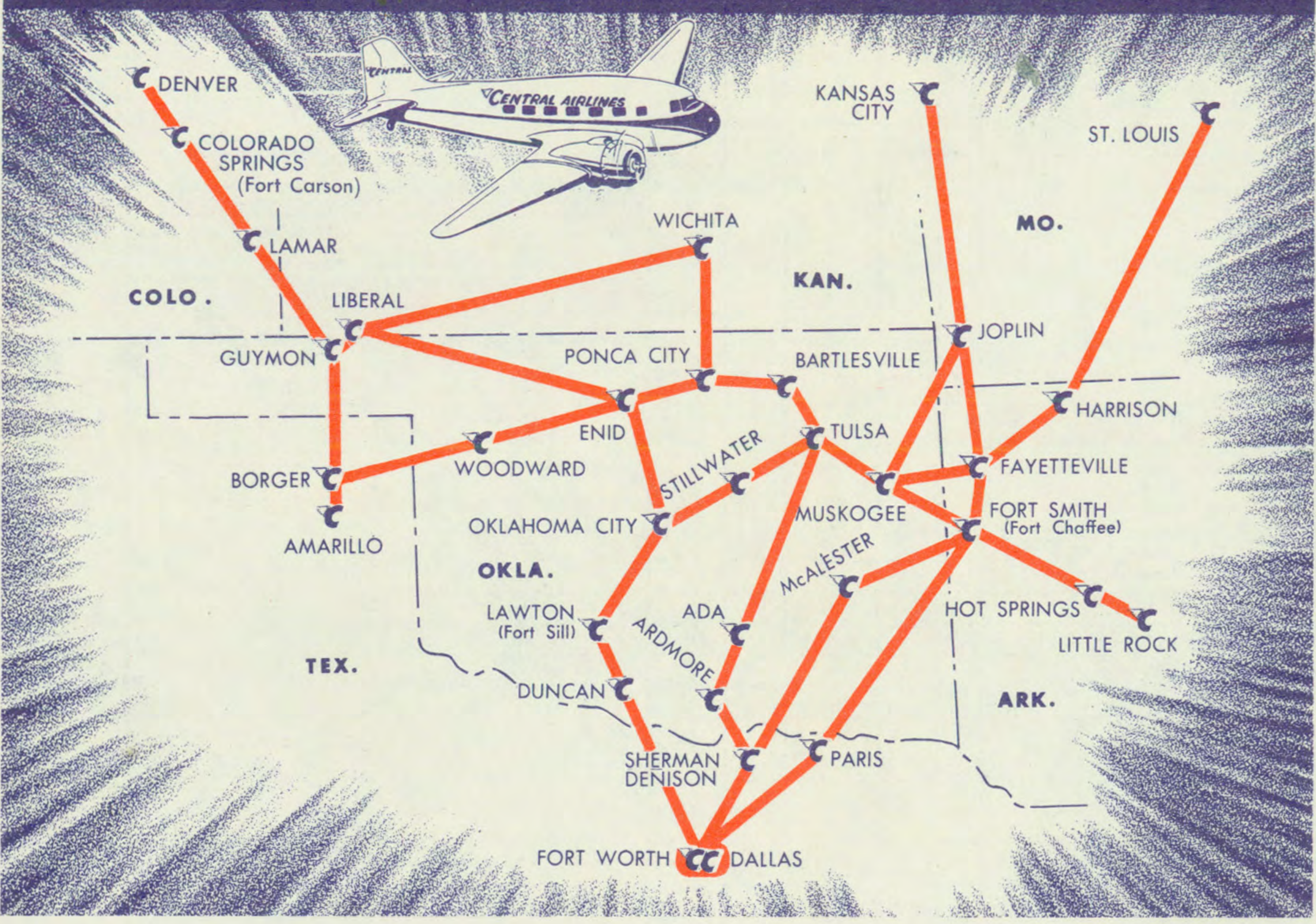

DENVER
Largest city in Colorado, (Population 415,786), situated in North Central Colorado east of the main range of the Rocky Mountains, Denver occupies a series of plateaus 5,280 feet above sea level. The city has 54 parks, 28 located in mountains within driving distance from Downtown Denver. It has the largest concentration of federal government offices in the nation outside of Washington, D. C. Points of interest are: The University of Denver, Galleries of the Denver Art Museum, Elitch Gardens. Denver also is the home of Lowry Air Force Base, and the United States Mint. The city's average mean temperature is 50.04F. The sun shines there on an average of 300 days in the year. Denver was founded in 1858 and named after Territorial Governor Gen. James W. Denver. Originally, the city comprised four communities established by gold-seekers and town promoters from Kansas and Georgia in 1857-58. Denver is distinctively residential, with wide, shady streets and beautiful boulevards.



COLORADO SPRINGS
Colorado Springs, site of the new United States Air Force Academy, is situated in Central Colorado, 75 miles south of Denver. The city lies at the foot of the Rocky Mountains range dominated by Pike's Peak. A trade center of a large mining region, Colorado Springs also attracts tourists because of its fame as a health and resort center. It is famous for such notable scenic features as Garden of the Gods, Cave of the Winds, Seven Falls, and Cheyenne Canyon and Monument Park. The city was founded in 1870 by Gen. W. J. Palmer, president of the Denver and Rio Grande Railway, and was chartered in 1878. Colorado Springs is the seat of Colorado College. The city has a population of 45,472. It has an elevation of more than one mile, 6,037 feet, or more than 700 feet above mile-high Denver.



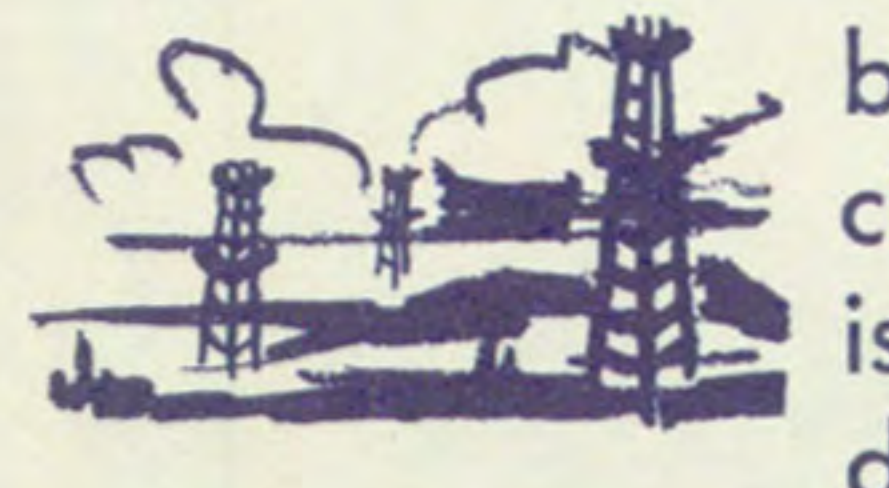

LIBERAL
Liberal, located in Southwest Kansas near the Oklahoma line, sits atop the vast Hugoton Gas Field, considered to be the largest natural gas reserve in the world. The city was incorporated in 1888 and has long been recognized as a trade and shipping center for grain and livestock. Discovery of the mammoth gas reserves promises to make Liberal one of the oil capitals of the world. The city's present population is estimated to exceed 8,500. Shortly after World War II, Liberal's economy was threatened by dismantling of a large U. S. Air Force base. Quick and aggressive action by its citizens, timed with Hugoton production, is credited with Liberal's phenomenal development during the past 10 years.
