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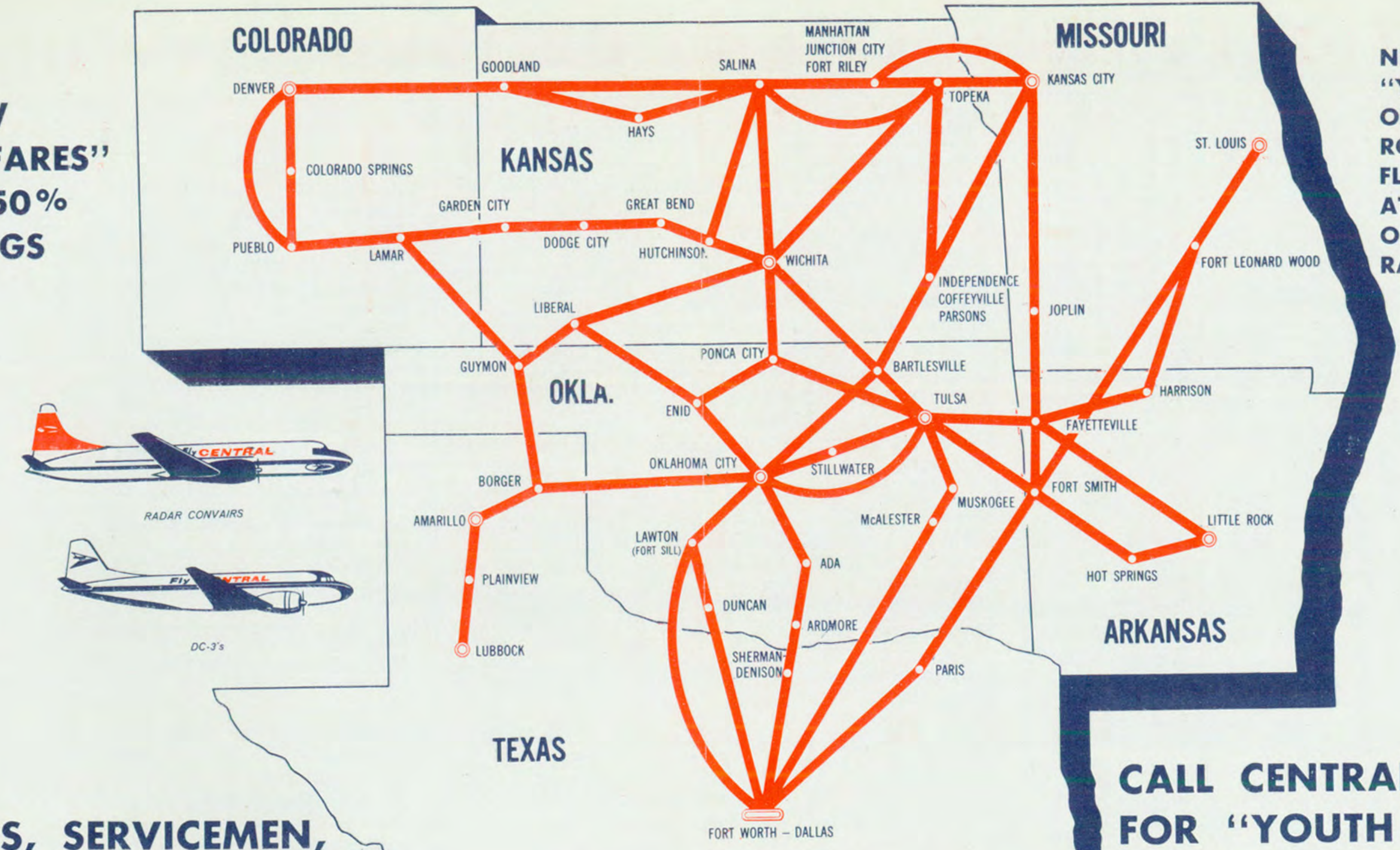

PASSENGER INFORMATION

RESERVATIONS—It is requested that your reservations be made in advance by telephone or at any airline ticket office or travel agency. Reservations are tentative until tickets have been purchased. If a passenger fails to purchase his ticket by the "time limit" agreed upon, the reservation will be cancelled and resold.

CHECK-IN TIME FOR FLIGHTS—In the interest of on-time service to all passengers persons are requested to be at the airport ticket counter 20 minutes prior to published departure time. Persons checking in less than 10 minutes before departure time may be refused passage when accommodating them would delay flight departure.

BAGGAGE—Free allowance within the United States and Canada is 40 pounds including brief case and hand luggage. Excess baggage will be charged for at the rate of 1/2 of 1% of the one way adult fare per pound, subject to a minimum charge of 25c. The liability of the Company for baggage is limited to \$100.00 unless a higher value is declared and additional charges paid therefor in advance.

RECONFIRMATION—When you travel to a city by air or other means and plan to stay overnight or longer, you must call the airline on which you will leave and reconfirm your continuing or return reservations; otherwise, your complete remaining itinerary will be cancelled 6 hours prior to departure. Reconfirma-

tion is not required if time between planned arrival time and scheduled departure time is less than 12 hours.

SCHEDULES AND FARES—Schedules and fares are subject to change without notice. Official tariffs are on file and open for public inspection at any Central Airlines office. Schedules shown are expected departures and arrivals and are not guaranteed. The Company will not be responsible for consequences arising from delays or cancellations or for failure to make connections with other planes of the Company or other transportation lines.

LOST ARTICLES—The loss of any article should be reported immediately to the nearest Central Airlines Ticket Office or to the Lost and Found Department, Central Airlines, Inc., Amon Carter Field, Fort Worth, Texas.

INSURANCE—Trip insurance is available at all airline ticket offices at the airport.

PETS AND ANIMALS—Dogs trained to lead the blind are the only animals permitted in the passenger compartment of aircraft. Other animals may be transported in the cargo compartment under certain conditions. Please see a Central agent for further details.

AIR CARGO—All Central flights carry air mail, air express, air parcel post, and air freight. Consult any Central Airlines office for information on how we can speed your shipment at low cost.
