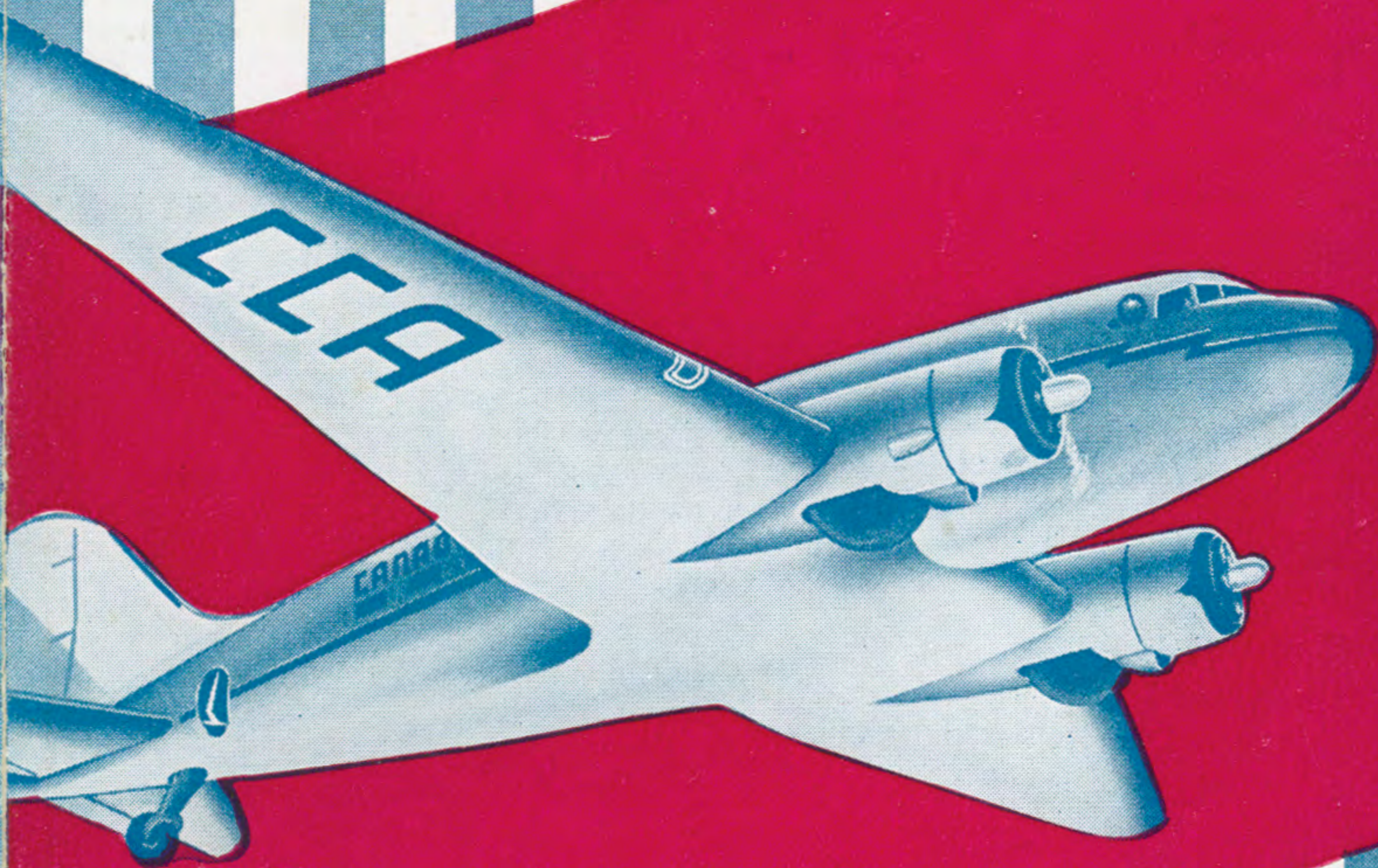

GENERAL INFORMATION

STOPOVERS: are permitted providing arrangements are made in advance.

CANCELLATION: The carrier may cancel any trip at origin or at any point and may omit any schedule stop, its liability in such event being limited to a refund of the unused mileage proportion of the fare paid.

REFUNDS: The carrier will refund the fare upon surrender of unused ticket **three** hours prior to scheduled departure of plane. In event of flight cancellation or interruption, the carrier will furnish refund draft or forwarding transportation via surface means to ticket destination.

TRIP INSURANCE: Trip insurance may be purchased at CCA ticket and airport offices.

BAGGAGE: Forty pounds of baggage will be carried free on each ticket. Baggage in excess of 40 pounds will be charged for at the rate of one-half of 1% of the published one-way fare per pound. Baggage dimension limits are 54 x 24 x 20 or 60 x 24 x 19.

CUSTOMS: Immigration and customs inspection will be made at St. Hubert Airport, northbound, and the Burlington Municipal and New York Airports, southbound. Goods valued at not more than one hundred dollars (\$100.00) and purchased by a person who is a resident and has been in either country more than 48 hours will be free of duty. Entering Canada purchases over \$5.00 must be declared in writing. Entering the U. S. A. the same will apply to purchases over \$25.00. Your Stewardess will gladly assist you.

ENTERING CANADA: Citizens of the United States may enter Canada as freely as they ever did. Citizens of European countries must have passports which have been properly visaed.

ENTERING THE UNITED STATES: Canadians travelling in the United States are now required to have passports. American citizens are not required to have passports for return from Canada, but the State Department suggests Americans carry some document of identification such as old passports, birth or baptismal certificates, naturalization certificates, club cards, tax bills or similar papers.
