WE USE THE SAME TIME YOU DO!

Colonial is pleased to join all other U. S. airlines in publishing timetables in local daylight saving times. We hope you agree that this is a convenience which should be followed by all transportation companies.

EXTRA FLIGHTS WHEN NEEDED

The service shown in this timetable is the minimum operated. Additional flights are flown almost every day of the week as required by reservation requests. For example, Trip 100 to Bermuda departs at 11:00 A.M., another leaves at 9:00 A.M., when required, another at 7:30 P.M., etc. This method enables the same aircraft to carry more passengers by varying the operation with the varying needs of the public for service — and you know that more people want to travel one day than another, even in the same week.

Extra flights also enable us to fly more people to Albany and Glens Falls than can be carried on the plane which is scheduled to go through those points to Burlington or beyond. This permits more seats to be

confirmed to Saranac Lake-Lake Placid and Burlington for example, yet two to five times as many seats made available for nearby cities. Many New York-Montreal non-stop flights are also provided as needed — so thousands of extra passengers can be served instead of being disappointed with "Sorry but that trip is sold out."

The same policy applies to the New York-Burlington-Montreal OWL, that late night economy service which has proven a boon to the bargain-minded and to those few travelers who are best served by a near midnight departure. If you have friends still using surface transportation between these points, tip them off to the idea of an experiment with the very popular OWL.

GENERAL INFORMATION

BAGGAGE AND PERSONAL PROPERTY — 40 pounds of free baggage will be allowed within U. S. A. and between U. S. A. and Canada; 66 pounds of free baggage will be allowed between U. S. A./Canada and Bermuda. The liability of the company for loss of, or damage to, baggage and other personal property is limited to \$100, unless a higher valuation is declared in advance and an additional charge is paid. The company is not responsible for any personal property which is not delivered into its custody.

CUSTOM AND IMMIGRATION — International passengers are subject to customs and immigration examinations.

FARES — All fares are applicable only for transportation between airports, and are subject to change without notice. Ground transportation between airport and city is available at passenger's expense.

RESERVATIONS — All seats are reserved. Advance reservations are welcomed and will be held until time agreed upon for purchase of tickets. Reservations will not be held on flights from stopover points or on return flights originating at points other than where ticket is purchased, unless passenger confirms with airline of departure, his intent to use such reservation at least 6 hours prior to scheduled flight time.

Colonial Airlines may cancel any reservation, if the person holding the reservation has not presented himself at the airport ticket office of Colonial Airlines for the purpose of checking in at least 10 minutes prior to the scheduled departure time of the flight for which reservation was made.

Colonial Airlines may cancel any reservation when such action is necessary for safety or other cause.

SCHEDULE — All flight schedules are subject to change or cancellation without notice.

New York flights arrive and depart from Gate 15, Domestic Terminal, La Guardia Field.

INSURANCE — Airline Trip insurance may be purchased from vending machines in city and airport ticket offices in units of \$5,000 at \$.25 per unit.
