GENERAL INFORMATION

EQUIPMENT: Air New Orleans operates modern executive cabin class twin engine commuter aircraft.

RESERVATIONS & TICKETING: For reservations or information call Air New Orleans, at 1-800-535-2643 or call your travel agent.

CHECK-IN TIME: Ticketed passengers are requested to be at the airport ticket lifting points at least 30 minutes prior to scheduled departure time. Reservations may be cancelled and the space resold, if the passenger has not checked-in at the ticket lifting point at least 10 minutes before scheduled departure time.

CREDIT CARDS: Air New Orleans honors American Express, Master Card and Visa Credit Cards.

STANDBY: Air New Orleans encourages passengers to stand-by 30 minutes prior to scheduled departure time as seats become available due to last minute cancellations.

CHILDREN: 2-11 years of age, if accompanied by an adult, will be charged 75% of the adult fare. Children under two years of age, that do not occupy a seat, will be transported free of charge when accompanied by a fare-paying passenger.

BAGGAGE LIABILITY: Liability for loss, delay or damage to baggage is limited to \$750 per passenger, based on proofs of loss, unless a higher value is declared in advance, and additional charges paid.

FREE BAGGAGE ALLOWANCE: 30 pounds, 50 pounds space available.

EXCESS BAGGAGE: \$.40 per pound.

CARRY-ON BAGGAGE: FAA regulations require that all articles carried onboard commercial aircraft will be searched.

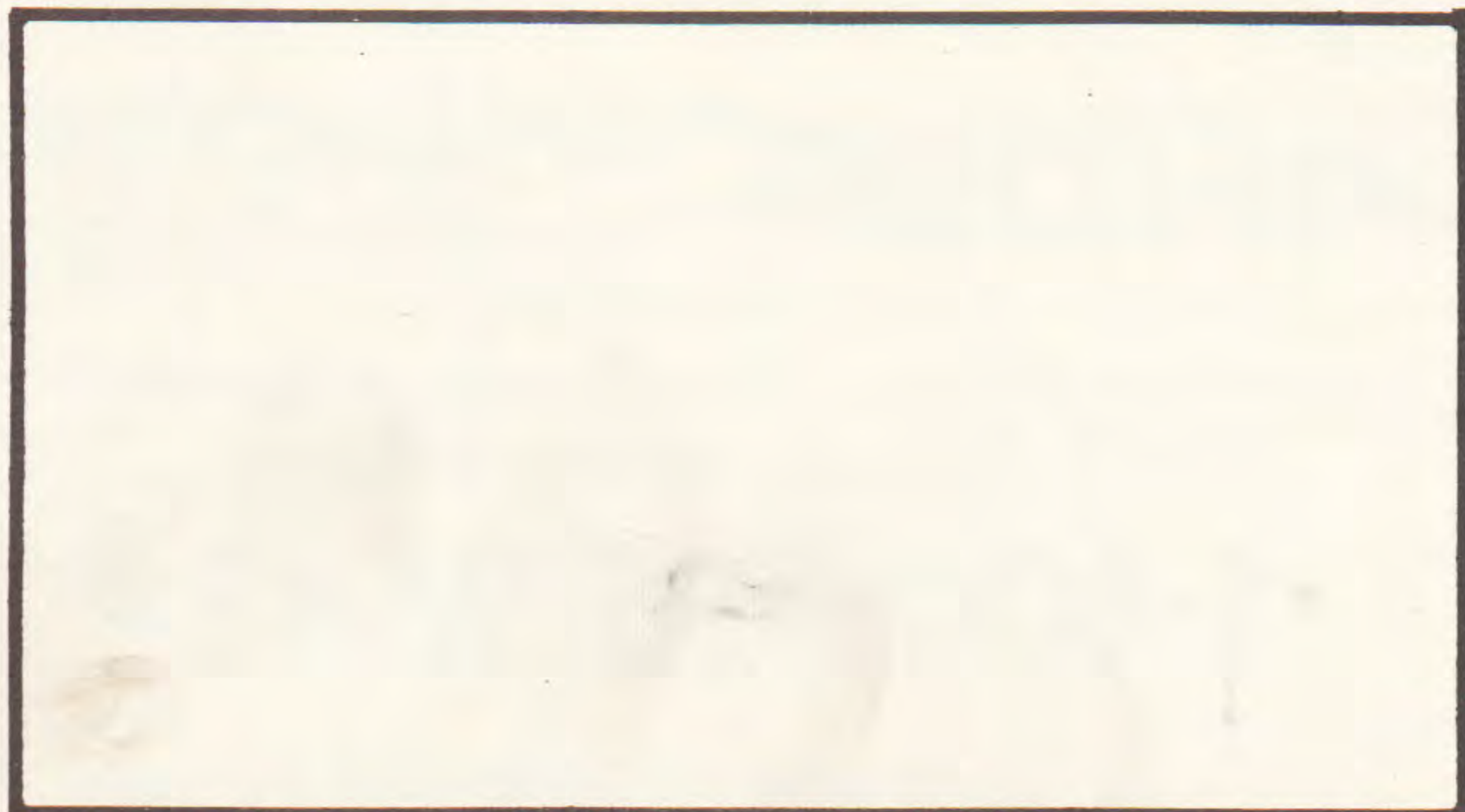
RESTRICTED ARTICLES: Acids, matches, lighter fluid and other items classified by the Department of Transportation as hazardous materials, i.e., explosives, flammable solids and liquids, oxidizing materials and irritating materials cannot be carried as checked baggage. Firearms may be carried only in checked baggage and an oral declaration must be made to Air New Orleans that firearms are unloaded.

IDENTIFICATION: Air New Orleans requires that baggage loaded aboard its aircraft be properly labeled with the passenger's name and address.

PETS AND ANIMALS: Small dogs and cats and other animals properly crated may be carried subject to advance arrangements with Air New Orleans ticket reservation department.
