PASSENGER INFORMATION

RESERVATIONS Reservations may be made between the hours of 6 AM and 8 PM. In Conn., call 203-377-2772, elsewhere call 800-243-9830.

BAGGAGE The maximum baggage allowable is 35 pounds or two suitcases. Additional baggage will be carried if space is available, and will be subject to a charge of 50¢ per pound. All baggage is insured to a maximum of \$250 per passenger, and the burden of proof of liability rests with the passenger. Baggage valued at more than \$250 is carried at the owner's risk.

CHECK IN All passengers are requested to check in at least twenty minutes prior to scheduled departure time. Atlantic Air reserves the right to cancel reservations of passengers who have not checked in ten minutes prior to scheduled departure time.
