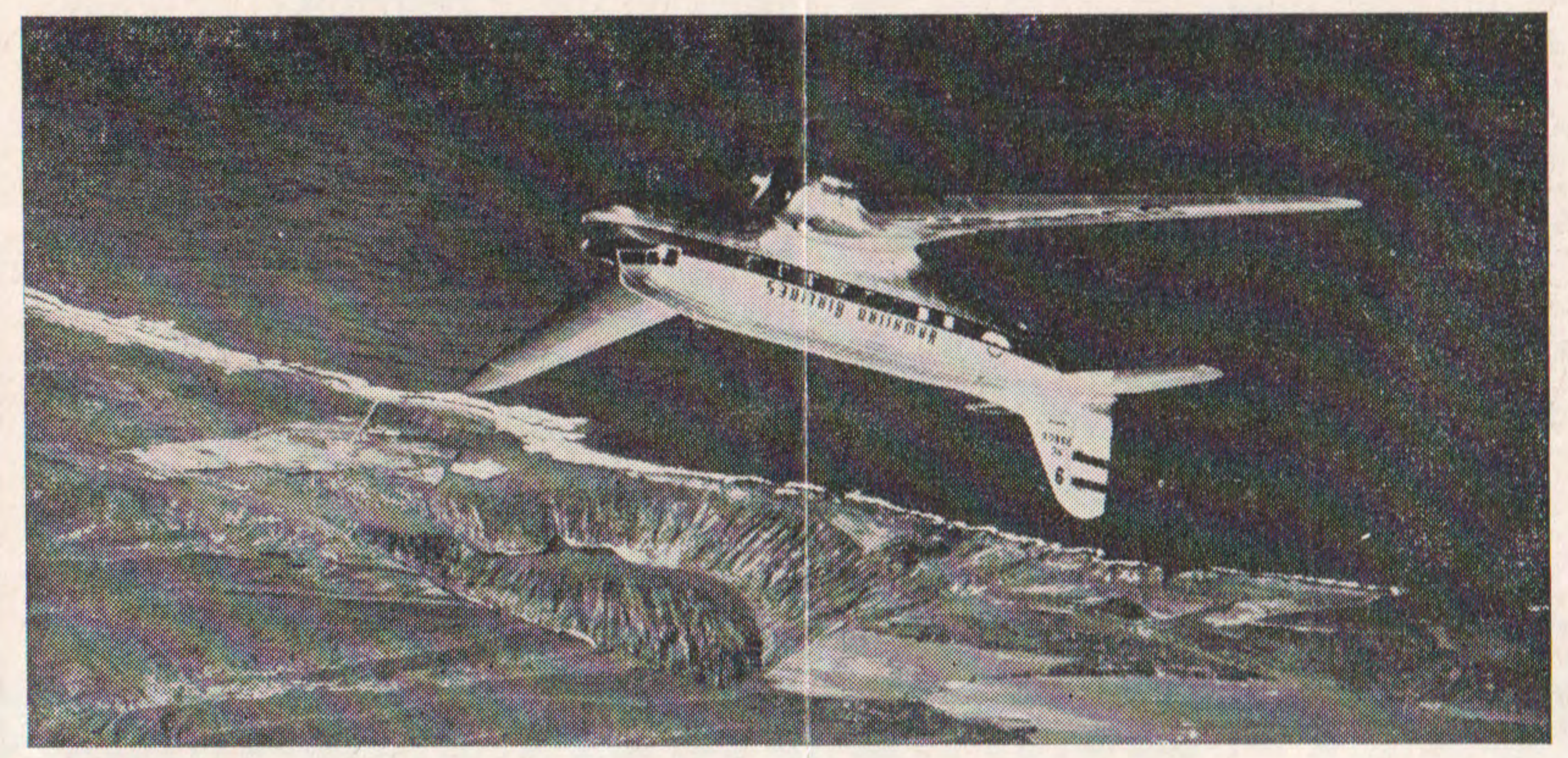

Hawaiian was the first airline in the United States to operate scheduled air cargo planes and is now carrying millions of pounds of cargo annually. Since 1934 it has been carrying the U.S. air mail as the most southerly of American routes. Hawaiian has won the complete confidence of Hawaii's people. It operates between 50 and 60 scheduled flights daily, increasing to over 100 daily as traffic requires. Ten Douglas two-engine DC-3 transports are used for scheduled passenger service between the islands.



Hawaiian Airlines began operation November 11, 1929, on regular scheduled islands of the Hawaiian group. Since that time it has transported nearly two million passengers. It has flown millions of miles between the islands and established such a record of safety and dependability flying that the National Safety Council voted it a "special Award of Honor for Distinguished Service to Safety" and this year awarded it a special citation for having the all-time safety record.

Molokai

Known as the "Friendly Island," Molokai lies about 60 miles southeast of Honolulu. Contains two large pineapple plantations.

Oahu

Governmental, educational and financial center for the territory. As locale of Honolulu, the island is the principal port of call for trans-Pacific planes and ships. Waikiki Beach • Nuuanu Pali • Diamond Head.

Lanai

Contains 141 square miles. Owned by Hawaiian Pineapple Co. for use as a tremendous pineapple plantation. Highly productive.

Maui

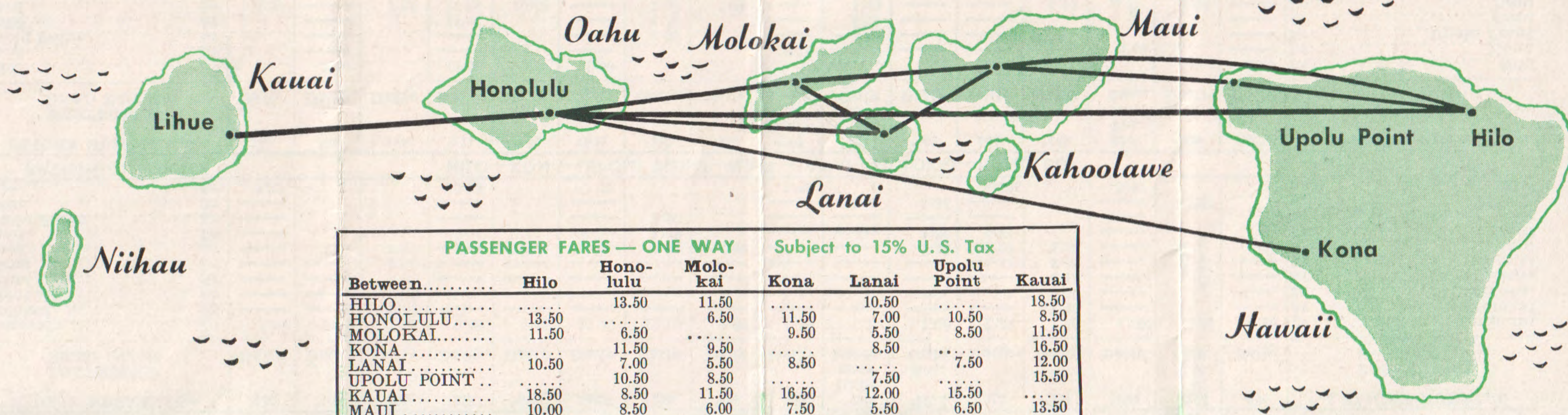
Second largest island of the archipelago. Maui basks in her own special beauty. Here is Haleakala, largest inactive volcanic crater in the world. Here, at Lahaina, is Islands' original capital. • Lovely Hana • Iao Valley.

Kahoolawe

An "island of death." Used as target by fleet and bombers. Covered with unexploded shells. No one is permitted to go ashore.

Hawaii

Largest island of the group, its 4,030 square miles are filled with endless variety... warm weather, cold weather; tropical beaches, lush jungle growth; ginger bordered highways, age-old forests; lava wastes, fertile plantations; Christian churches, remains of ancient pagan temples; active volcanoes, snow-crowned mountains.
