**General Information**

**CREDIT CARDS**—Midway Airlines will accept American Express, Master Charge, BankAmericard/VISA, Carte Blanche, Diners Club and Air Travel Cards.

**PASSENGER CHECK-IN PROCEDURE**—Midway Airlines requests that passengers purchase their tickets and have them validated/confirmed at the ticket counter. Reservations of passengers presenting themselves at the Midway Airlines boarding gate less than ten minutes before scheduled departure of a flight will be subject to cancellation.

**REFUNDS—LOST TICKETS**—When a passenger loses his ticket, or a portion of his ticket, he will be required to purchase another ticket at the appropriate fare before transportation will be furnished between the points covered by the lost ticket. Requests for refunds of lost tickets must be made in writing to Revenue Account, Midway Airlines, 5700 S. Cicero, Chicago, IL 60638. There will be a 120 day processing period and a surcharge of \$20.00. Additional restrictions apply.

**AIRCRAFT**—Midway Airlines utilizes DC-9 jets with seating for 86 passengers.

**ON-BOARD SERVICE**—Midway Airlines serves complimentary coffee, juices and cold drinks on all flights. All alcoholic beverages are \$1.00 on all flights. Peanuts are complimentary.

**NO SMOKING**—Sections are provided on all Midway aircraft for non-smokers. Generally, the forward portion of the aircraft is reserved for non-smokers. Signs are posted in the cabin designating the no smoking sections.

**SECURITY**—For your security all passengers and their hand-carried items must be inspected in accordance with the government-sponsored security program. Passengers should proceed through security inspection at least 20 minutes prior to departure time.

**HAZARDOUS MATERIALS**—Federal regulations restrict carriage on aircraft of items classified as hazardous materials. These materials include, but are not limited to, flammable gasses—liquid and solid, non-flammable compressed gas, explosives, poison, corrosives, oxidizing agents, radioactive material, etiologic agents, and magnetized materials.

**BAGGAGE**—Checked baggage should be locked. Regulations require name identification on outside. Name labels are available at Midway ticket counters. Do not place money, jewelry or other expensive personal items in baggage which is to be checked. Fragile articles and perishables are accepted as checked baggage only at the passenger's own risk. Checked baggage is subject to inspection and passengers may be required to present identification.

- A. Free baggage allowance—For each ticketed passenger, Midway allows three free checked pieces.
- B. Excess baggage—\$7.00 for each piece in excess of the three free.
- C. Carry-on baggage—limited to items which will fit underneath the passenger's seat. All items not needed in flight should be checked.
- D. Midway Airlines' liability for lost, damaged or delayed in delivery of personal baggage is limited to \$750 per fare-paying passenger. Excess valuation may be purchased for \$1.00 per additional \$100 valuation.
- E. Claim—Damaged or lost baggage must be reported, in person, within four hours of passenger's arrival at destination.
- F. Animals—Midway Airlines accepts dogs and cats as excess baggage provided passengers furnish their own air-worthy kennels. Combined weight of pet and kennel should not exceed 40 pounds. Pet must accompany passenger and will be checked and carried in a pressurized, air-conditioned baggage compartment. There will be a charge of \$20.00.
- G. Sporting Goods—Sporting goods is to be included in free baggage allowance and to be carried at passenger's own risk. In excess of three free, \$7.00 additional charge. Exceptions: Bicycles—\$12.00 each. Scuba Gear—\$7.00 each piece.

**HOLIDAY CANCELLATIONS**—Certain flights will not operate during holiday periods. Contact Midway Airlines for details.

**CHILDREN**—One child under two (2) years of age, not occupying a seat, will be carried free with a passenger paying the applicable adult fare.

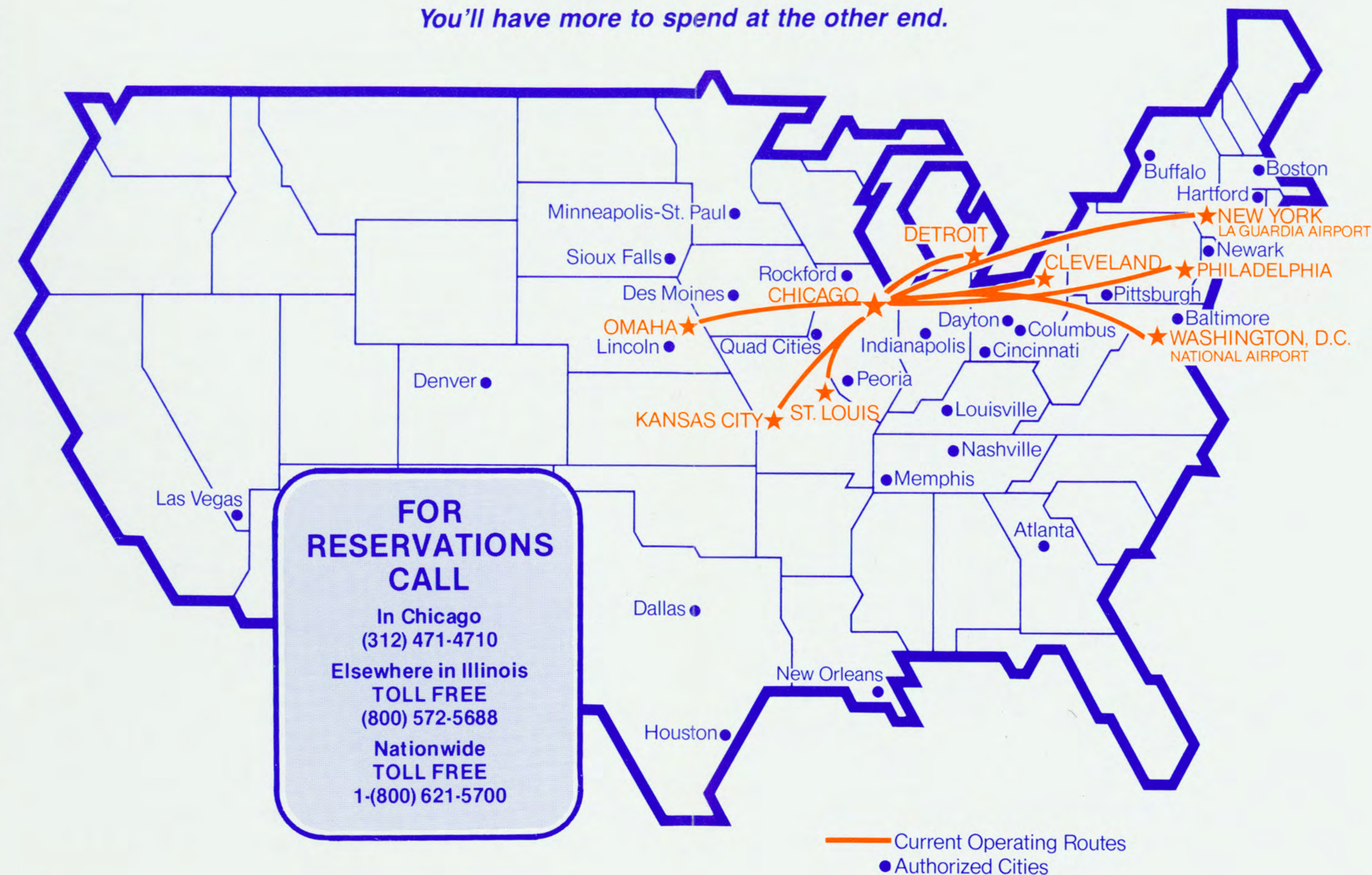
