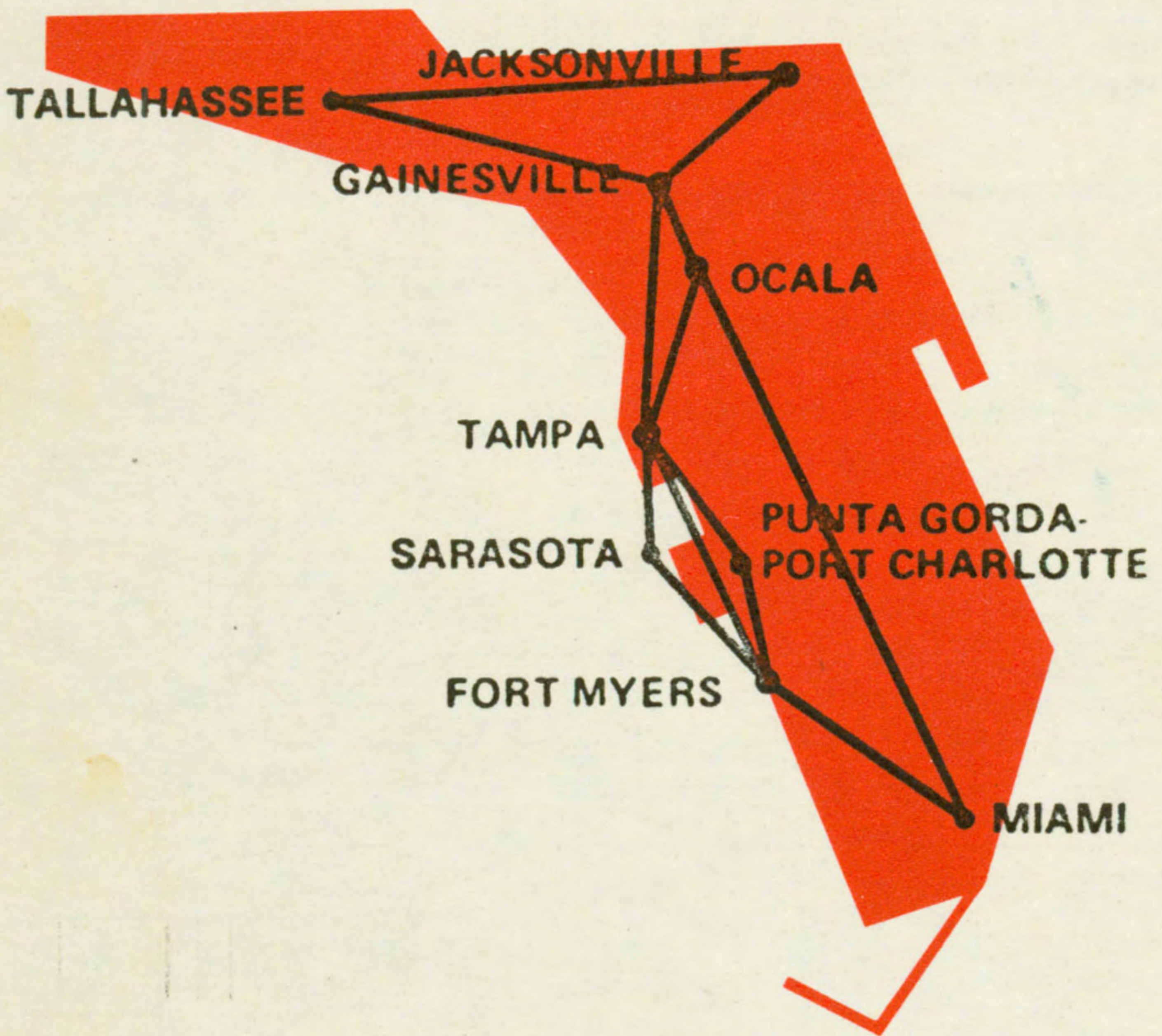

# GENERAL INFORMATION

## RESERVATIONS AND TICKETS

You may make your reservations for any flight through your travel agency or by contacting any Florida Air Lines office. When you make your reservations, you will be asked to pick up your ticket 24 hours in advance of departure time. If you plan to purchase your ticket immediately before your flight, you must arrive at our ticket counter at least 45 minutes before flight time or your reservation will be cancelled. If you have purchased your ticket ahead of time, you should plan to be at the airport at least 30 minutes before flight time. Reservations for ticketed passengers will be held until 15 minutes before flight time. If you have not presented your ticket at the boarding gate by this time, your reservation may be cancelled and made available to someone else. To allow us to serve you better, please advise us at least 24 hours ahead of departure time of any local telephone number where you may be reached.

## BAGGAGE

All Florida Air Lines passengers are allowed the following amount of luggage:

1 bag, not to exceed 62 dimensional inches and 1 bag, not to exceed 55 dimensional inches (Dimensional inches = length + height + width). A charge will be made for any luggage in excess of these limits and such excess baggage will be carried on the first flight with space available. In cases where the next flight with space available is not the same flight the passenger is traveling on, it will be the passenger's responsibility to pick up such luggage at the airport when it arrives. Excess baggage charges, along with other rules and regulations concerning the transportation of luggage, are included in tariffs which are available for public inspection at all Florida Air Lines offices.

## RESPONSIBILITIES FOR MEETING SCHEDULES

Florida Air Lines makes every effort to meet all scheduled arrivals and departures. Because weather and other factors sometimes affect our operating conditions, we cannot guarantee that we will meet every schedule as listed in this timetable. For the same reasons we cannot accept responsibility for damages due to failure of flights to arrive or depart as scheduled or for the resulting failure of passengers to connect with flights of this or any other airline.

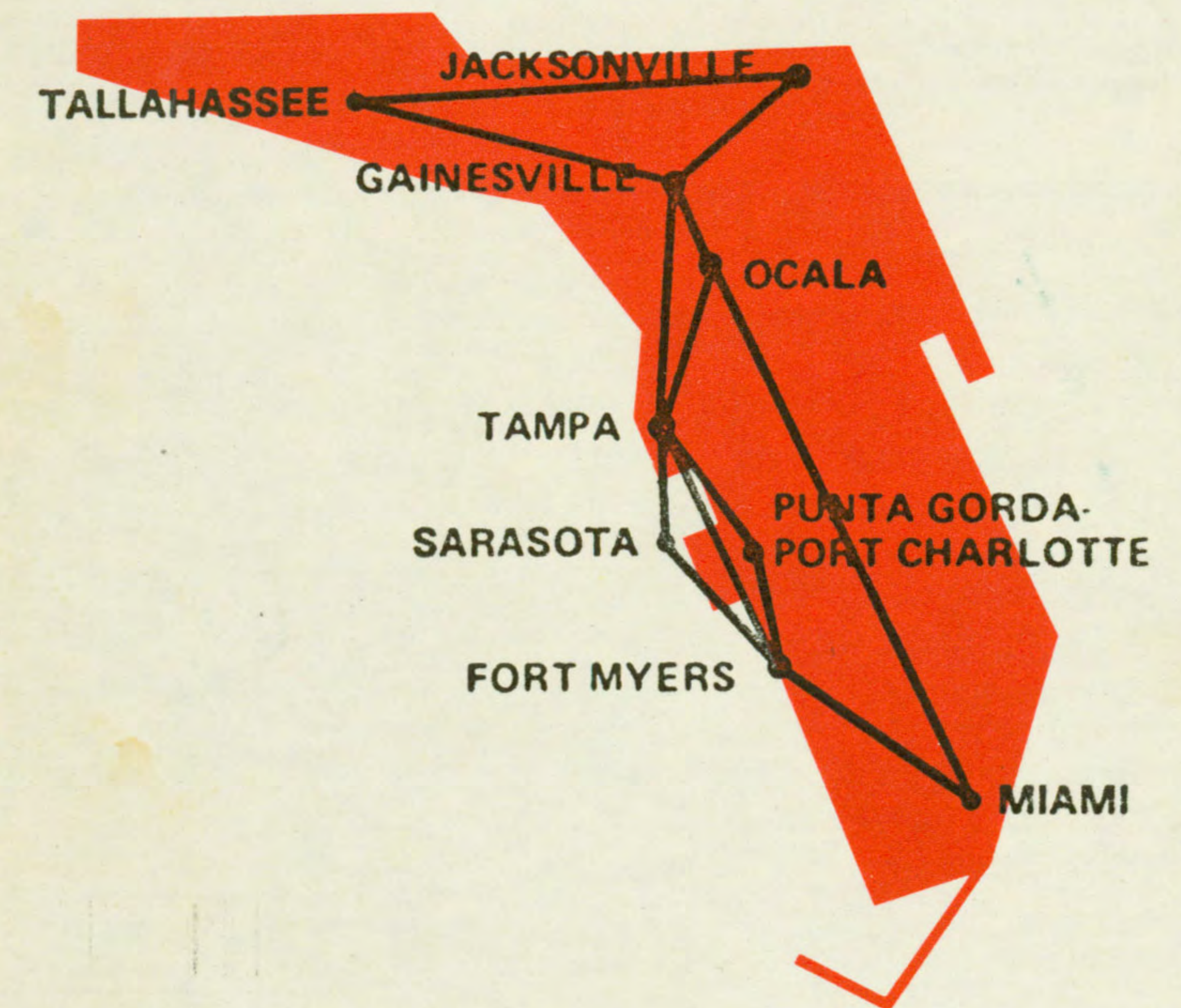

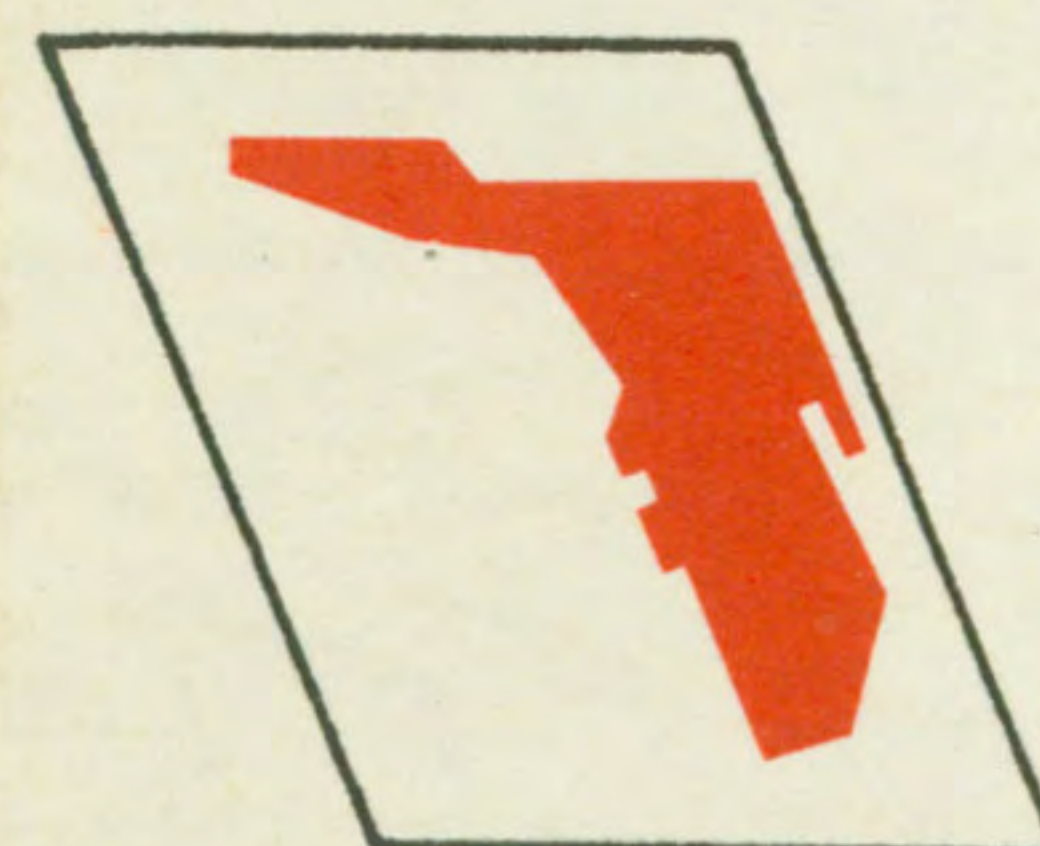
