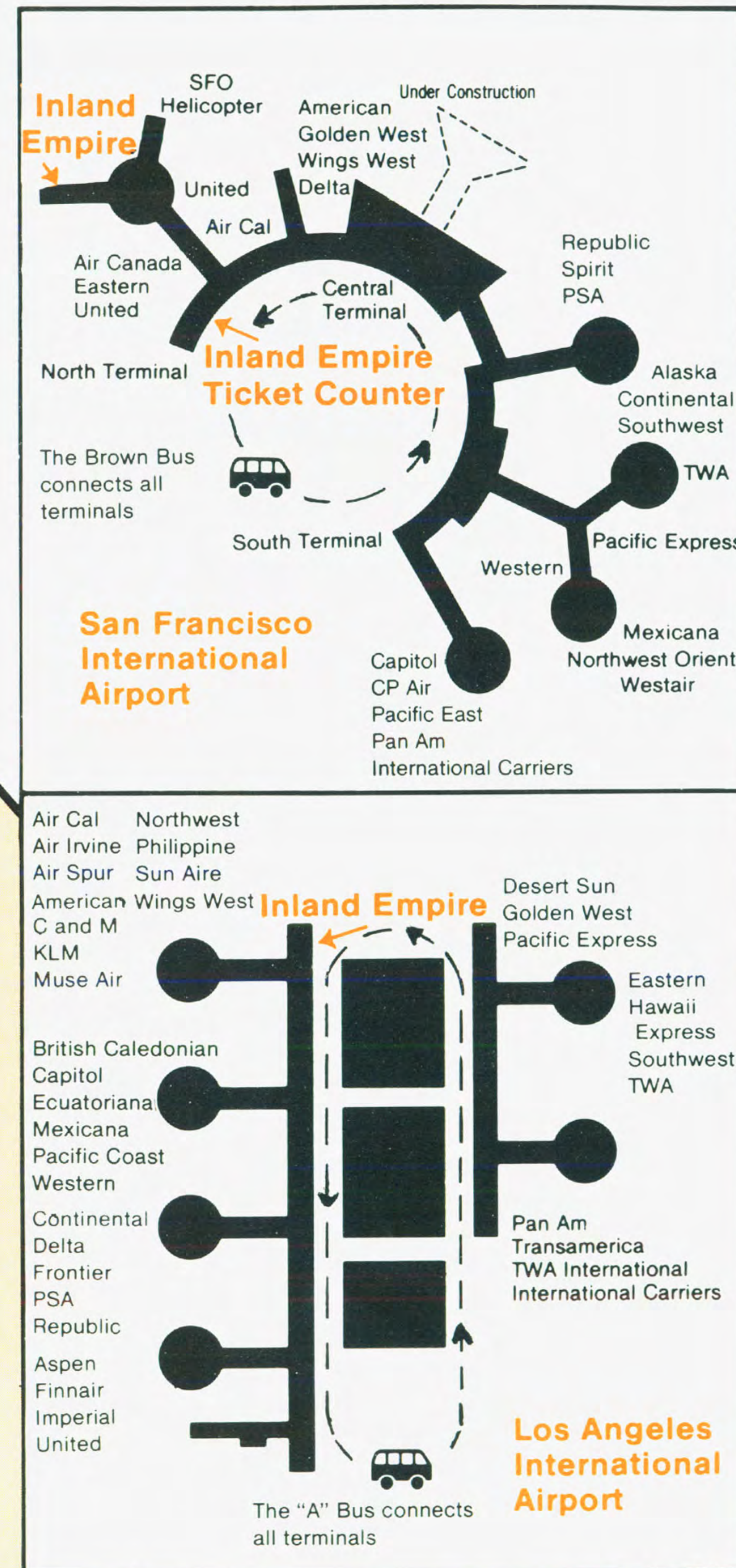

## PASSENGER INFORMATION

**CHECK-IN TIMES:** Check in at least 30 minutes before departure (45 minutes if you do not have your ticket). If you check in at the gate of departure less than 15 minutes prior to departure your space is subject to cancellation.

**BAGGAGE:** All checked baggage must have identification attached to the outside. Free allowance for each ticketed passenger is one bag with total linear dimensions (length + height + width) not over 62 inches, one bag not over 55 inches and one bag not over 45 inches. The third piece may be carried on board provided it fits under the passenger's seat or the carry-on rack. However, such space is limited. No piece may weigh over 70 pounds. Always lock luggage. Never pack valuables, important documents, car keys, medications, passports, fragile or perishable articles in checked baggage; carry them in hand luggage.

**RESTRICTED ARTICLES:** Acids, matches, flammable liquids, poisons, tear gases, explosives, munitions, fireworks, flares, oxidizing materials (such as bleaching powder and peroxides) radioactive materials, compressed gases, and other hazardous articles must not be packed in baggage. AM and FM radios, TV receiver and other electronic devices must not be used on board aircraft in order to avoid disturbance of the aircraft's electronic navigational equipment. Portable electronic devices such as voice recorders, hearing aids, heart pacemakers and electric shavers will be permitted.

**RESERVATIONS:** IEA flights may be overbooked to compensate for persons holding and NOT utilizing reservations. To insure passage, passengers are requested to check in early.

**CREDIT CARDS:** IEA accepts VISA, Diners, Master Charge, American Express Cards and UATP.

**CHILDREN:** Children under two years of age, accompanied by an adult, will be carried free. Children between two and eleven, when accompanied by an adult, will be charged 75% of the full fare.

**CLAIMS:** Written notice must be made to the general offices address listed below within 30 days of the incident and legal action must commence within one year.

**SECURITY:** Government regulations require that all carry-on baggage/articles including gift wrapped items be inspected or processed through detecting devices. Firearms in checked baggage must be declared and unloaded.

**EXCESS BAGGAGE:** Baggage exceeding the baggage size and weight above will be charged according to company tariffs. Excess charges will also be made for bicycles, surfboards, scuba diving equipment and kennels.

**EQUIPMENT:** Swearingen Metro Jet Props on all regular flights.

**LIABILITY:** For baggage is limited to \$750 per fare paying passenger for domestic checked baggage loss, damage, or delay, unless a higher value is declared and additional charges paid in advance. Inland is not liable or responsible for (1) unchecked baggage, (2) jewelry, cash, camera equipment or other similar valuable items, (3) any delay involving perishable articles and (4) any damage involving unsuitably packed fragile articles. International travel or on domestic portions of international travel Inland's liability limit is \$9.07 per pound for checked baggage or \$400 per passenger for unchecked baggage unless a higher value is declared and additional charges paid. Inland's excess valuation charge is \$.75 per \$100.

**RESPONSIBILITY:** Inland will use its best efforts to carry the passenger and baggage with reasonable dispatch, but times shown in timetables and elsewhere are not guaranteed and are subject to change without notice. Inland will be responsible for transportation only over its own lines. Safety is our primary consideration and schedule times published include allowances for variations in weather and traffic conditions to assure arrivals within 15 minutes of published schedules 85% of the time. Schedules do not allow for abnormal air traffic and ground delays which can not be forecast in advance. Inland may, without notice, substitute alternate carriers or aircraft and if necessary may alter or omit stopping places shown on the ticket. Inland is not responsible or liable to make connections or to operate any flight according to schedule, or for changing the schedule of any flight.
