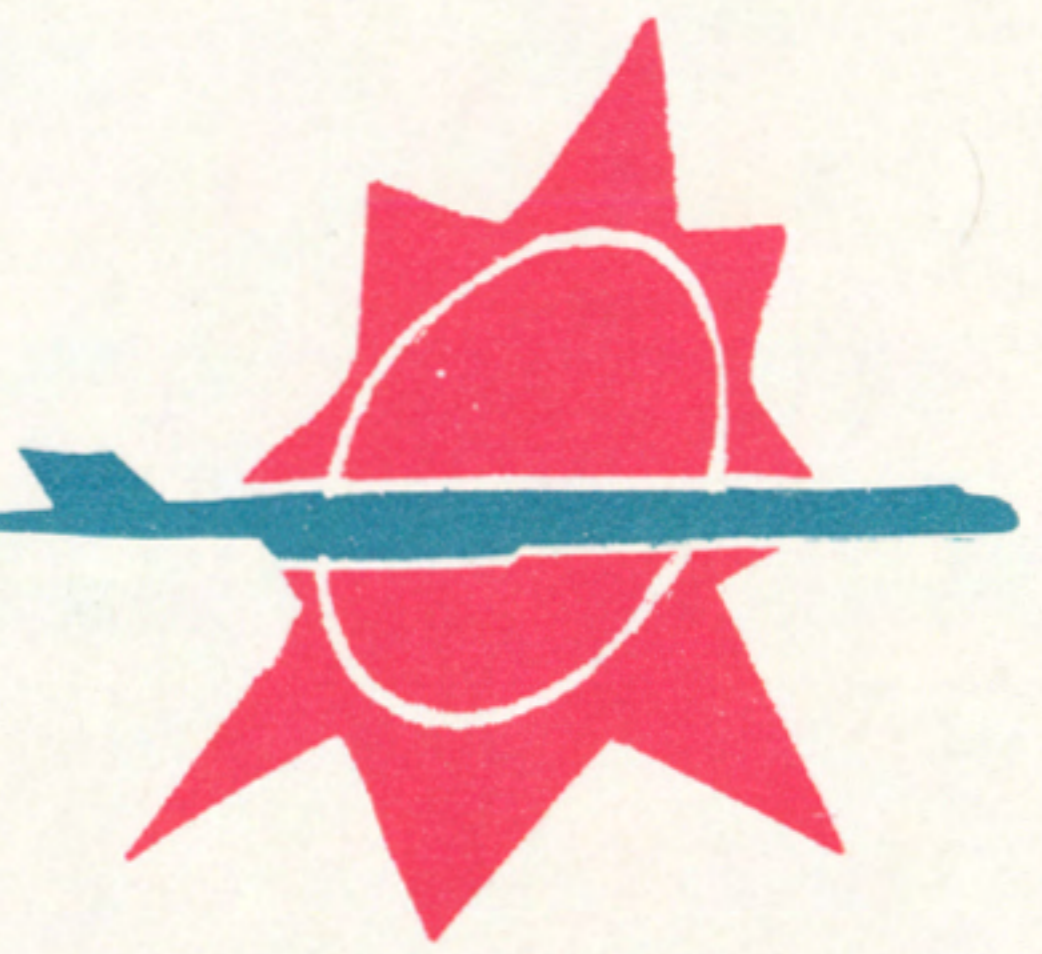

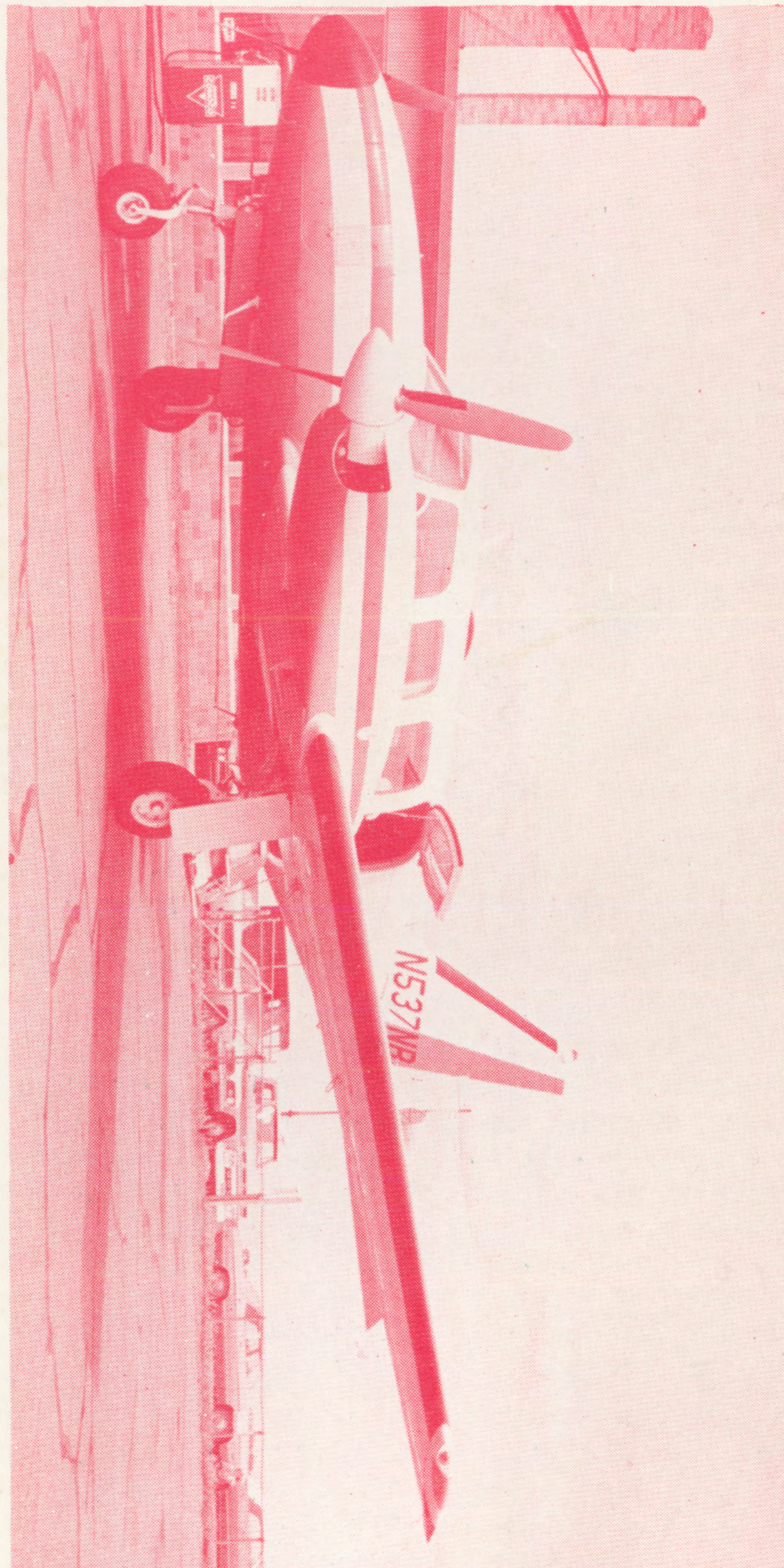

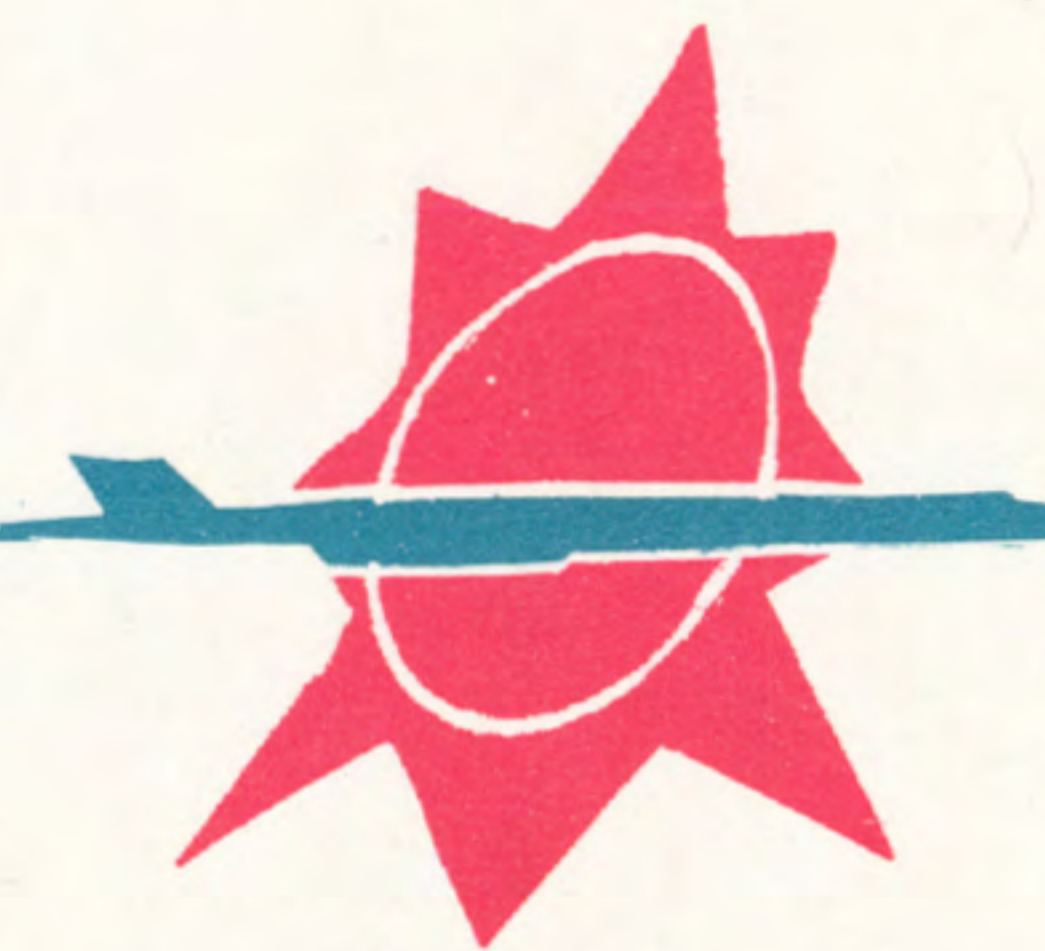

## PASSENGER SERVICE

One Way Adult Fare	\$18.00
Round Trip Adult Fare	\$36.00

Children's Fare: Children, 2 thru 11, accompanied by a farepaying passenger at least 12 years old, will be charged 50 per cent of the full adult fare. Unaccompanied children, 5 thru 11, will be charged full adult fare. Accompanied children, 2 or under will be free. Unaccompanied children under 5 will not be accepted.

Youth, Clergy, and Military Fares: Youth, 12 thru 21, military personnel on authorized leave, and ordained ministers may travel standby for a one way fare of \$12.00 and a round trip fare of \$24.00. Standby passengers must present themselves at least 15 minutes prior to departure time.

All prices include 8 per cent Federal Transportation Tax.

### TICKETING AND RESERVATIONS

Tickets may be purchased and reservations made at New Ulm Travel Service or at Air New Ulm at the New Ulm Airport. If you plan to fly with us round trip, purchase your ticket and make your reservation for the return portion, before your departure. If your plans for return change from your reserved time, you must notify Air New Ulm by calling 507-354-8127. A reservation is tentative until the ticket is purchased. Reservations not claimed ten minutes before departure time, are subject to cancellation.

For departure from Minneapolis you may check with our counter in the commuter air carrier center in the green concourse.

Our service in Minneapolis is to Gate 37 — The Green Concourse. In St. Paul — To the St.

Paul Downtown Airport Terminal.

Maximum free baggage allowance will be two pieces — additional baggage will be assessed at \$4.00 per piece. When disembarking in Minneapolis, please claim your baggage and when arriving in Minneapolis on another airline, claim your baggage and bring it to Gate 37. We do not transfer baggage.

Air New Ulm will not be responsible for consequences arising from delays or cancellations or from errors in the printed schedule. We reserve the right to make changes in fares and times shown on schedule without prior notice.

Air Freight is carried on all flights. Refer to our Air Freight section folder or call Air New Ulm at 507-354-8127.

### AIR FREIGHT RATES

Minimum charge is \$10.00 for shipments up to 120 lbs. and 8 cents per pound for weight in excess of 120 lbs.

### SHIPMENTS EXCEEDING 250 CUBIC INCHES PER POUND

Charges for shipments with overall measurements exceeding 250 cubic inches per pound will be assessed on the basis of one pound per each 250 cubic inches or fraction thereof. Measurements will be based on greatest rectangular dimensions.

### LIMIT OF LIABILITY AND DECLARED VALUE

The carriers liability is limited to the declared value of the shipment or the actual value if such actual value is less than the declared value. If no value is declared by the shipper, shipments are deemed to have a declared value of \$50.00. When the declared value exceeds \$50.00 an additional transportation

charge of \$.30 for each \$100.00 to \$1000.00. Any value more than \$1000.00 will be assessed at a rate of .10 per \$100.00.

### C.O.D. SHIPMENTS

C.O.D. shipments must have the letters C.O.D. and the total amount to be collected on delivery legibly and durably marked on each piece thereof. Credit will not be extended on the amount of the C.O.D., no privilege of examination or trial will be given prior to collection and no partial delivery of C.O.D. shipments or partial collection of the amount of the C.O.D. will be made.

C.O.D. pieces will not be accepted on the same airbill with pieces not moving C.O.D. Only pieces covered by one C.O.D. bill will be accepted on one airbill.

The following shipments will not be accepted C.O.D.

1. Shipments requiring prepayment of transportation charges.
2. Shipments to be stopped in transit to complete loading or partial loading.
3. Shipments on which the total C.O.D. amount exceeds \$50,000.00.

### STORAGE

Shipments will be held without charge for 24 hours after arrival at destination. The carrier will assess nominal storage charges at the expiration of the free time period.

### TAX

As of July 1, 1970, the United States Federal Government has imposed a 5 per cent tax on all air freight shipments. This tax will be assessed on the airbill and covers weight rate and excess value only.

### SIZE LIMITATIONS

Shipment of pieces up to 200 lbs. and 8 feet by 3 feet by 3 feet can be handled. For larger pieces call Air New Ulm at 507-354-8127.
