



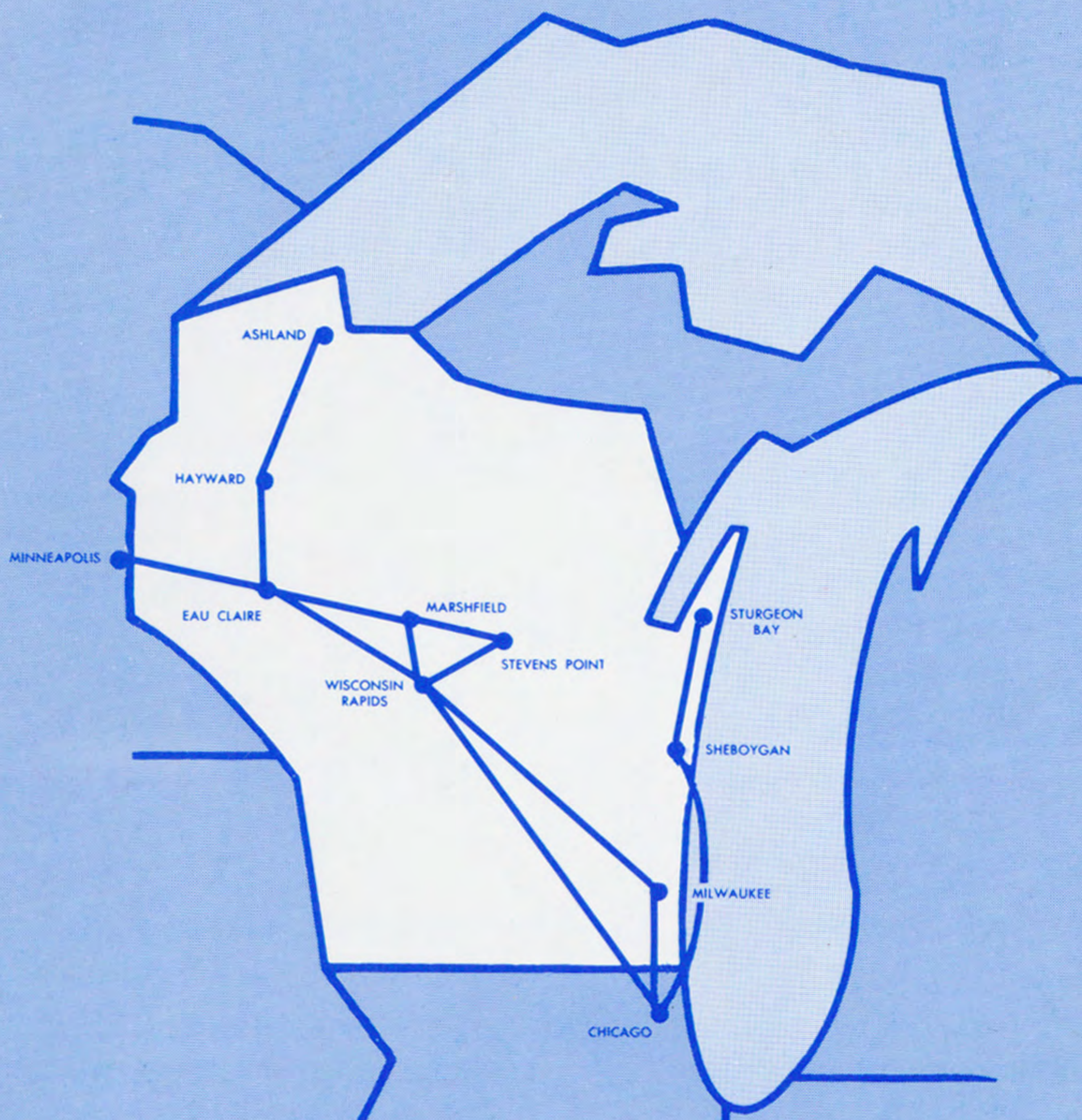

**GENERAL INFORMATION**

**Check In Time:** 30 minutes prior to departure. Reservations not claimed 10 min. prior to scheduled flight time are subject to cancellation.

**Credit Cards:** Midstate accepts American Express, BankAmericard, Master Charge, and Universal Air Travel cards.

**Baggage:** Fifty pounds of baggage including brief case and hand luggage will be carried free on any ticket. Charge for excess baggage will be 10c per pound. Maximum baggage liability per passenger is \$250.00 unless excess valuation is declared and paid for prior to trip departure.

**Re-Confirmation:** Please re-confirm your reservation after a stopover of more than 12 hours. Re-confirmation is necessary at least 6 hours before departure in order to assure your reservation.

**Rental Cars:** Available at all stations.

**O'Hare Ticket Counter:** Midstate operates from the A-Concourse located adjacent to the International Terminal.

**Milwaukee** passengers check in with United Airlines.

**CHARTER** service available. Ask for free brochure.

**INTERLINE AGREEMENTS:** American - Air Canada - Braniff - Continental - Delta - Eastern - Flying Tiger - North Central - Northwest - Ozark - Trans World - United - Western - Allegheny - SAS - Southern.

**MIDSTATE AIR CARGO SERVICE**

**Passenger Aircraft:** Air freight is accepted on a space available basis. Live animals accepted only after completing prior arrangements. NOTE: For all purposes of this tariff LIVE ANIMALS are defined as: All Mammals (other than humans), birds, fish, crustacea, shell fish, insects, reptiles, worms and amphibia.

**Charges for Weight:** Transportation charges for Air Cargo will be assessed on which ever is greater, the gross weight of the shipment, or the cubic dimensional weight, measured on the greatest dimensions (Height, Width and Length). Cubic dimensional weight is based one pound for each 250 cubic inches, except 266 cubic inches for cut flowers or nursery stock.

**Air Freight Rates:** Minimum per shipment \$10.00; 10c per pound over 100 pounds; \$80.00 per one thousand pounds.

**Excess Valuation Charges:** A shipment shall have a declared value of no more than \$50.00 unless a higher value is declared and so indicated on the airbill.

Excess value charges are 10¢ for each one hundred dollars, or portion thereof of declared value over the free valuation of \$50.00.

**Exceptions to General Commodity Rates:** Live animals and human remains are charged at 200% of the general commodity rate, i.e., 200% x 10c = 20c per pound or \$20.00 per one hundred pounds. The minimum charge per shipment remains at \$10.00.

**Assembly or Distribution Service:** Both assembly and distribution service cannot be performed on the same shipment. Written instruction must be given to the carrier not later than receipt of shipments. CHARGES: 50¢ per addressee; minimum \$2.00. Complete details are available on request from your MIDSTATE AIRLINES agent.

**C.O.D. (Collect on Delivery) Shipments:** The shipper is solely responsible for entering the amount of the C.O.D. on the airbill, and the carrier shall not be liable for failure to collect the C.O.D. amount when it is not so entered by the shipper. The shipper must also have the letters "C.O.D." and the total amount to be collected on delivery, legibly and durably marked on each piece of C.O.D. shipments. C.O.D. fee 10¢ per one hundred dollars or portion thereof.

**Unusual Shipments:** Unusual shipments may require special packaging. Consult MIDSTATE reservations for information.

**Pick-up and Delivery Service:** The following rates apply at these Wisconsin cities served by MIDSTATE. For cities not listed, arrangements can be made by contacting your MIDSTATE agent.

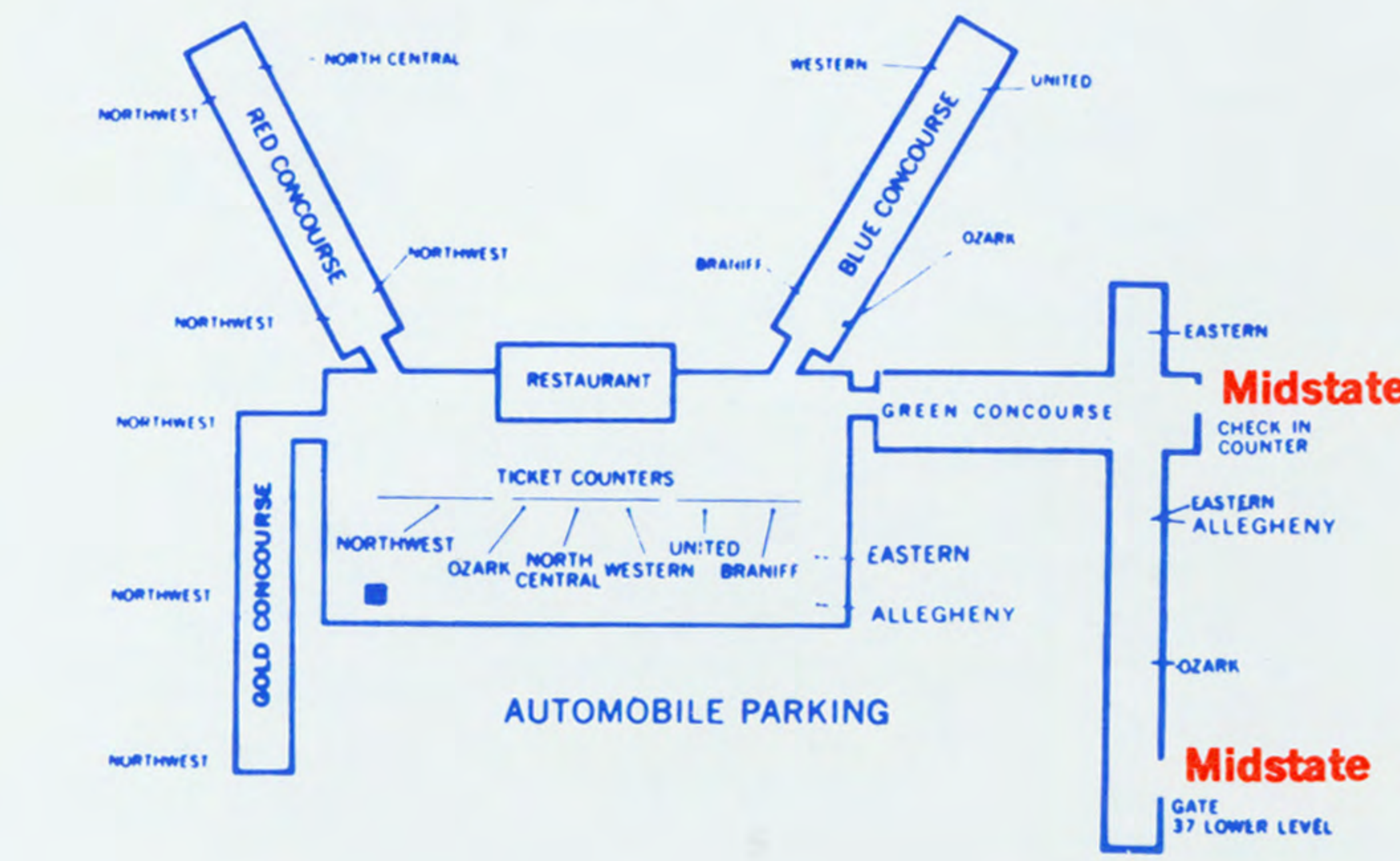

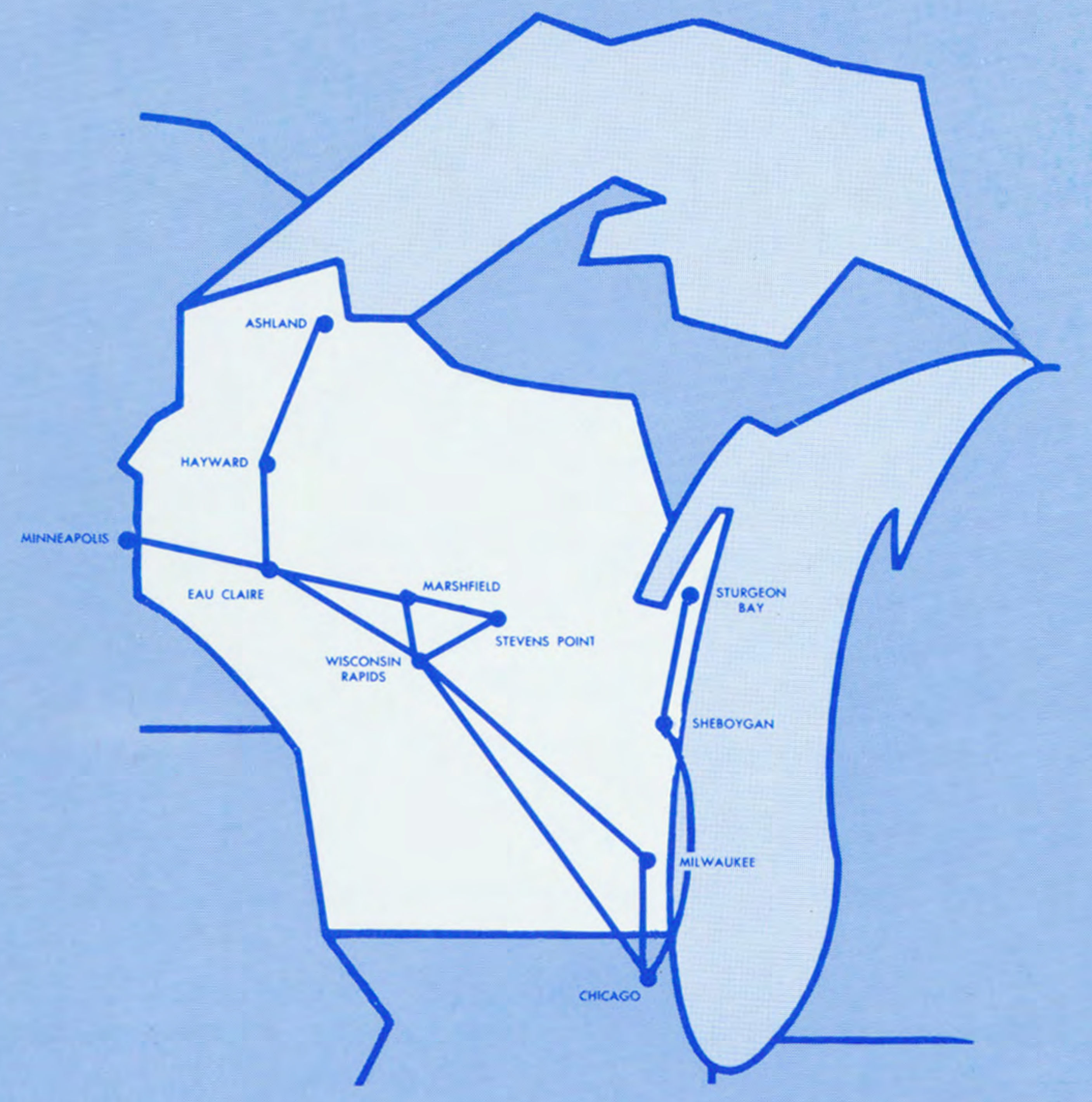
