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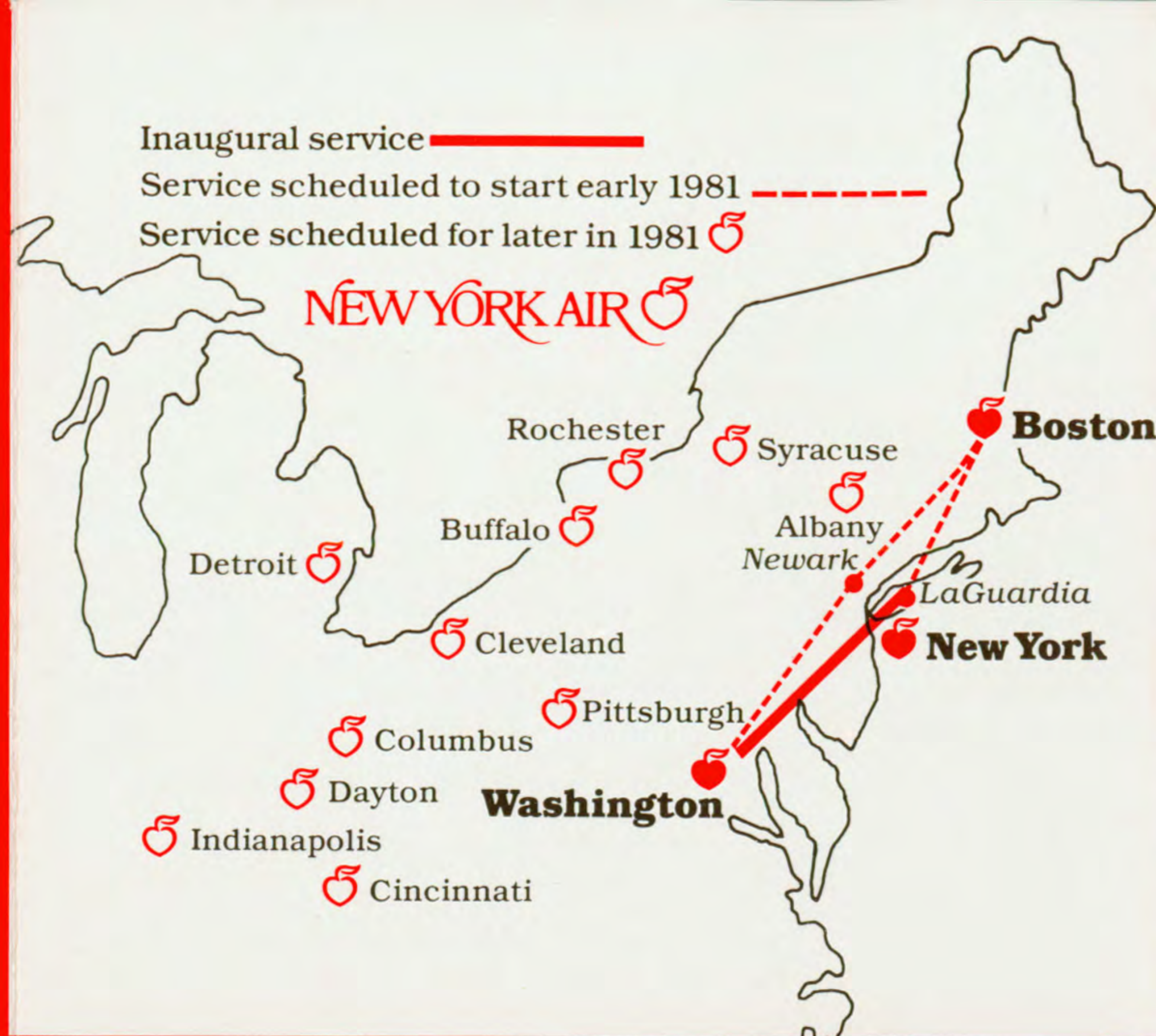

Small package air delivery

There's no quicker express route for your small package than one of our direct flights between New York and Washington.

Just drop your package off at our ticket counter 30 minutes before flight time and we'll jet it ahead so it arrives within the next hour. You can call ahead with the flight number and have the package picked up at the destination ticket counter.

Packages must measure no larger than 90 inches total, adding length + width + height, with no single side greater than 48 inches.

Weight: up to 50 lbs.

Maximum declared value: \$500 per package.

No perishables, please.

## GENERAL INFORMATION

### CREDIT CARDS

New York Air will accept American Express, Master Charge, Bank Americard/VISA, Carte Blanche, Diners Club and Air Travel Cards.

### PASSENGER CHECK-IN PROCEDURE

New York Air requests that passengers purchase their tickets and have them validated/confirmed at the ticket counter. Reservations of passengers presenting themselves at the New York Air boarding gate less than ten minutes before scheduled departure of a flight will be subject to cancellation.

### REFUNDS—LOST TICKETS

When a passenger loses his ticket, or a portion of his ticket, he will be required to purchase another ticket at the appropriate fare before transportation will be furnished between the points covered by the lost ticket. There will be no refund for a lost ticket.

### AIRCRAFT

New York Air utilizes DC-9 jets with seating for 115 passengers.

### ON-BOARD SERVICE

New York Air serves complimentary coffee, juices and cold drinks on all flights. Alcoholic beverages are complimentary on normal fare peak period flights. On off-peak and weekend flights, alcoholic beverages are available at a charge of \$2.00. Beer and wine are available on these flights at a charge of \$1.00.

### NO SMOKING

Sections are provided on all New York Air aircraft for non-smokers. Signs are posted in the cabin designating the no smoking sections.

### SECURITY

For your security, all passengers and their hand-carried items must be inspected in accordance with the government-sponsored security program. Passengers should proceed through security inspection at least 20 minutes prior to departure time.

### HAZARDOUS MATERIALS

Federal regulations restrict carriage on aircraft of items classified as hazardous materials. These materials include, but are not limited to, flammable gases, liquids and solids, non-flammable compressed gas, explosives, poison, corrosives, oxidizing agents, radioactive material, etiologic agents, and magnetized materials.

### BAGGAGE

Checked baggage should be locked. Regulations require name identification on outside. Name labels are available at New York Air ticket counters. Do not place money, jewelry or other expensive personal items in baggage which is to be checked. Fragile articles and perishables are accepted as checked baggage only at the passenger's own risk. Checked baggage is subject to inspection and passengers may be required to present identification.

- Free baggage allowance—For each ticketed passenger, New York Air allows two free checked pieces.
- Excess baggage—\$7.00 for each piece in excess of the two free.
- Carry-on baggage—Limited to items which will fit underneath the passenger's seat.
- Unless excess value is declared and charges paid at time of check-in, New York Air's liability for lost, damaged or delayed in delivery personal baggage is limited to \$500.00 per fare-paying passenger.
- Claim—Damages of lost baggage must be reported, in person, within four hours of passenger's arrival at destination.
- Animals—New York Air does not accept animals as checked baggage. For the comfort of all passengers, cabin pets are not permitted.

### HOLIDAY CANCELLATIONS

Certain flights will not operate during holiday periods. Contact New York Air for details.

### CHILDREN

One child under two (2) years of age, not occupying a seat, will be carried free with an adult passenger paying the applicable fare.
