ROUTE OF THE AIR CHIEFS



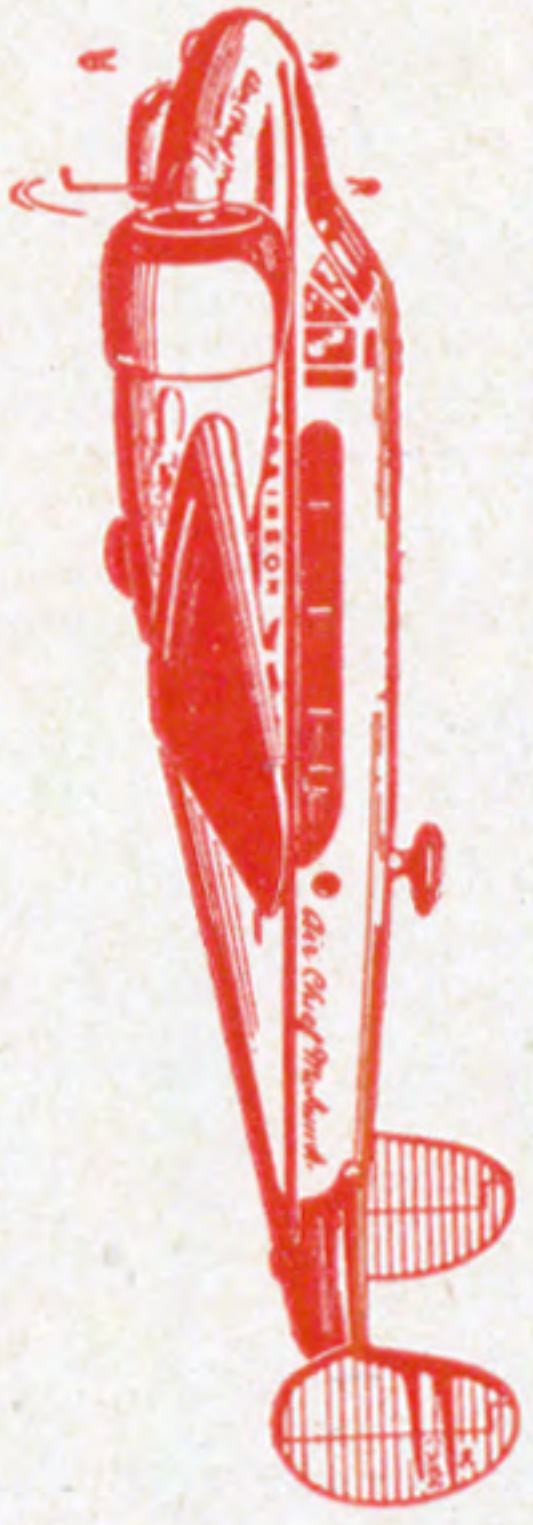

GENERAL INFORMATION

EQUIPMENT—Twin-engine, 9-place, 1946 model Beechcrafts, fully equipped for instrument flight and manned by Captain and Copilot, are operated on all flights.

TYPE OF SERVICE—Robinson Airlines is a scheduled intra-state carrier operating solely within New York State boundaries. No interline tickets are issued or accepted.

AIRPORT CONNECTIONS—Company limousine service is available between Roosevelt Field and the Lincoln Hotel at 45th Street and 8th Avenue in New York City. Limousine or taxi service is pre-arranged and available for Robinson Airlines passengers at all terminals.

RESERVATIONS—Your reservation is tentative only, is not "firm," until you have purchased a ticket or exchange order covering your trip. The Company reserves the right to cancel any reservation if the holder has not presented himself at the pre-designated Robinson Airlines ticket office or pick-up point at least 10 minutes before scheduled departure of the flight or surface transportation for which the reservation is held.

CONFIRMATIONS—If making a round trip or stopover, your reservation for the return portion is subject to cancellation unless you communicate with a Robinson Airlines reservation office, located at the stopover or turnaround point, at least 3 hours before scheduled departure time of flight. If you purchase a ticket for transportation in one city and

commence in another city, your reservation is subject to cancellation unless you communicate with the reservation office, located in the city where you are to board your plane, at least 3 hours before scheduled departure time.

CANCELLATIONS—The Company reserves the right to cancel bookings before passage or enroute any time such action is deemed advisable or necessary. In any event, the passenger's sole recourse shall be the recovery of that portion of the fare equal to the distance untraveled.

CHILDREN'S FARES—When under two years of age, children not occupying seats will be carried free.

SCHEDULES AND FARES—Shown in tables above are for information only and are subject to change without notice. The Company will not be responsible for consequences arising from delays or errors in the printed schedule.

BAGGAGE—Each passenger will be allowed 20 pounds of baggage free on any ticket. Baggage in excess of 20 pounds per passenger will be carried at 10c. per pound subject to availability of space.

AIR PACKAGE SERVICE—Is available from airport to airport. Rates may be obtained from any Company ticket office, or authorized travel agent.
