GENERAL INFORMATION

EQUIPMENT—Twin engine Air Chiefs, manned by Captain and First Officer and Stewardess, are operated on all flights.

TYPE OF SERVICE—Robinson Airlines is a scheduled carrier serving New York State and Northern New Jersey operating on air mail Route 94. Interline tickets are issued and accepted.

AIRPORT CONNECTIONS—Limousine service is available in all cities between airport terminal and downtown ticket offices and leading hotels. Ticket office in New York City is located at 367 Lexington Avenue at 41st Street.

CONFIRMING RESERVATIONS—

1. Your reservation is tentative only until you have purchased a ticket.
2. Your reservation may be canceled unless you appear at the airport or designated pick-up point 10 minutes before departure.
3. Even though you have your ticket, you must again confirm your space in person or by phone at least three hours before departure.
4. Even though you hold a round trip ticket, *your return space may be canceled unless* you contact a Robinson office in your stop-over city, at least three hours before scheduled flight departure.

5. If you buy your ticket in one city and plan to board your plane in another, *your space may be canceled unless* you contact a Robinson office in the city where you board your plane, at least three hours before scheduled flight departure.

CANCELLATIONS—The Company reserves the right to cancel bookings before passage or enroute any time such action is deemed advisable or necessary. In any event, the passenger's sole recourse shall be the recovery of that portion of the fare equal to the distance untraveled.

CHILDREN'S FARES—Children under two years of age, not occupying seats, carried free. Children two to eleven carried at half fare.

SCHEDULES AND FARES—Shown in tables above are for information only and are subject to change without notice. The Company will not be responsible for consequences arising from delays or errors in the printed schedule.

BAGGAGE—Each passenger will be allowed 40 pounds of baggage free on any ticket. Baggage in excess of 40 pounds per passenger will be carried at the established rate subject to availability of space.

AIRCARGO

SPEED—All Robinson Airlines' flights carry Air cargo. Frequent daily schedules insure prompt dispatch of shipments to supplement the speed of air transportation.

PICK-UP AND DELIVERY service is available in all cities served by Robinson Airlines. The speed of air shipping is combined with the convenience of door to door handling.

INTERLINE SERVICE—Robinson Airlines, through interline arrangements with other certificated air carriers, provides through service to all parts of the United States and Canada.

ECONOMY—Aircargo is an economical way to ship. The rates are low. Air shipping requires lighter, less expensive packing. Aircargo saves time and money.
