## IT'S *Easy* TO TRAVEL BETWEEN CANADA AND THE UNITED STATES

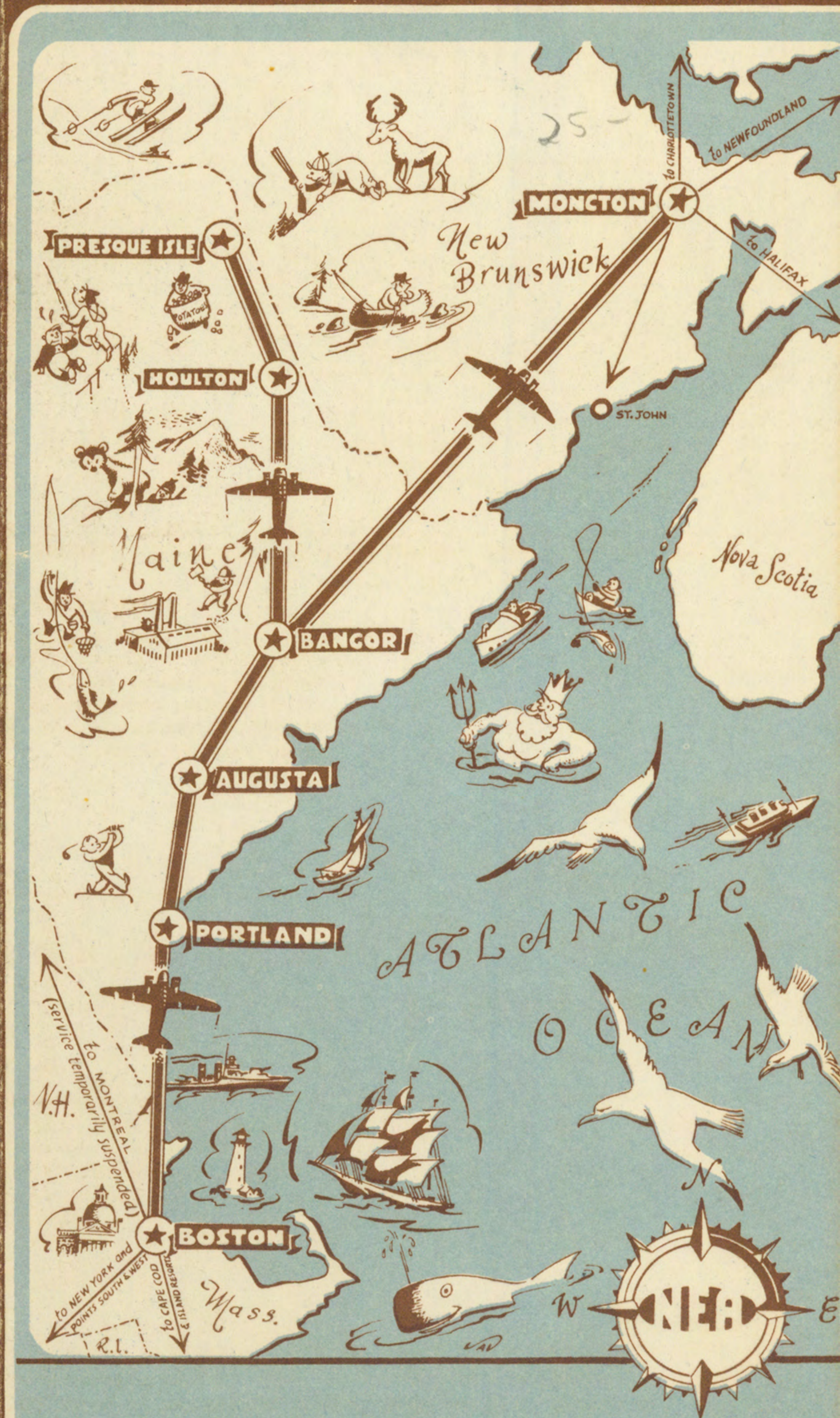
U. S. CITIZENS need only to carry birth certificates or other evidence certifying citizenship.

CANADIAN CITIZENS (born in and residing in Canada) may enter the U. S. for visits of 29 days or less upon presentation of birth certificate with a photograph of true bearer properly attached.

OTHER CANADIAN CITIZENS who hold valid passports may secure Border Crossing Identification Cards at Bangor Airport during regular plane stop by submitting 3 additional passport photographs. All Canadians must also secure Form H from local bank and, over 16 years old, must secure Labor Exit Permit or Exemption Certificate.

NOTE: Canadians are now allowed \$150.00 (plus air tickets purchased in Canada) for spending in the U. S. on pleasure or business—or \$75.00 for each of two trips in one year.
